- **1. ILA D'OR DU VINOIS -** Did not manage to confirm her Villedieu performance when last but one in a 3100m Savenay amateurs Class H a month back and can be passed over
- **2. HOURAGAN DANGUY -** Imposed at Le Touquet a fortnight ago before faulting in a 2650m Portbail amateurs Class H last Sunday, and backs up with a realistic chance of making first 5
- **3. HOBBY DE L'EVRE -** Faithful servant in the amateur division, sports a new configuration for the occasion, and will be expected to make up for his 9th of 13 in a 2725m Pornichet Class G last week
- **4. HARPER DE BANVILLE -** Returns to the amateur division after trotting 6th of 13 in a 2725m Pornichet Class G a week ago. Could well have imposed here last month had he not faulted and, with application, can make amends
- **5. ISIS D'ERAH -** Off the boil since late-April, most recently 11th of 13 in a 2850m Bréhal Class F on Monday, and backs up with little to no chance
- **6. GOLD GEDE -** 6th of 11, behind IMOKO DU BOUILLON (11), in a 2300m amateurs Class G at Châteaubriant last Friday. Has a much better entry this time and looks principal threat to IMOKO DU BOUILLON (11)
- **7. INSTIGATEUR -** Useful sort dropping back in category after coming 3rd of 10 in a 2900m Dozulé Class F last week, but shoes back on here and best to wait
- **8. HACKER DE MAHEY -** Disappointing in 3 since winning at Abbeville 3.5 weeks ago, most recently 6th of 8 in a 3150m amateurs Class H at the same venue on Sunday and, even though reverting to a previous formula, is unlikely to influence the outcome
- **9. FANNY CAT -** Failed to pull off the hat-trick when sanctioned at Les Sables-d'Olonne but reassured when 3rd of 10 in a 2875m Enghien amateurs Class F 11 days ago. 25m worse off this time but still looks competitively well-in
- **10. HEROINE DARCHE -** 4th of 10 in a 3450m Class F at Agon-Coutainville 2.5 weeks ago. Incurs the penalty but at this level, looks a decent place prospect
- **11. IMOKO DU BOUILLON -** 2nd of 11 in a 2300m amateurs Class G at Châteaubriant last Friday. Has been in fine form this term and looks the pick of the field

Summary: Very useful when focused, IMOKO DU BOUILLON (11) made up for a brace of sanctions when 2nd to a very good horse on his return to the amateur division last week and, with application, should be able to wrap this up. 6th that day, but 25m better off this time, GOLD GEDE (6) will have his chances, as will 2nd-line starter FANNY CAT (9) who has already won twice at this level over the summer. HEROINE DARCHE (10) got back in the game at Agon-Coutainville recently and even though shod and starting with the handicap, she still looks a player.

- **1. LINO DU HENNEQUIN -** Debuted nicely at Carentan before faulting in a 2825m Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe 2.5 weeks ago. Has evident ability but others still easier to back
- **2. LAIKA DU LEARD -** Failed to confirm her Erbray victory when 7th of 11 in a 2850m Bréhal Class E on 29 July, and already looks outclassed
- **3. LET IT BE -** Stylish winner of a 2425m turf Class H at Rochefort-sur-Loire early-August. Should take well to Meslay conditions and must be afforded significant respect
- **4. LOUXOR DANICA -** Professional-looking sort that has shown excellent aptitude for the game, latterly winning a 2425m Class H at Sainte-Marie-du-Mont earlier this month. In better company this time but can still double his money
- **5. LOOK REBEL -** Has progressed well, most recently winning a 2700m Vittel Class H 3.5 weeks ago. Leading driver reining this time and the double is still on the table
- **6. LESDY MAGODA -** Picked up where she left off following the break, coming 3rd of 9 in a 2600m Montignac Class E 3 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run but, in this category, will struggle to leave her mark
- **7. LUCRECE DE CORDAY -** Won at Vichy late-June before getting on the wrong side of Lady Luck in a 2150m Class E at the same venue on 3 August. Has masses of untapped potential though and, on good behaviour, can impose

Jacques Bruneau will still be keeping a keen eye on the capable LUCRECE DE CORDAY (7) who was not the most fortunate at Vichy, and the progressive LET IT BE (3) who opened his account just 11 days ago. Capable going both directions, LOOK REBEL (5) similarly lost his maiden tag last time out, and the engagement of Gabi Gelormini will do his prospects no disservice.

- 2. KARIOLA DE LOU Flattering 5th of 14 in a 2300m Châteaubriant Class F 9 days ago and will struggle to make her mark here
- **3. KAPELLA FABULET -** Unlucky 7th of 13, behind KITTY PIYA (5), in a 2750m Cabourg Class D a fortnight ago. Change of driver this time and looks a respectable first-3 candidate
- **4. KITA MESLOISE -** Clearly useful but sanctioned in all 3 this term and will first need to reestablish her credentials
- **5. KITTY PIYA -** Drops marginally in category after coming 4th of 13 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D on 2 August. Paul Ploquin takes over in the wagon and will be expected to finish in the mix
- **6. KOPAZE DE HOUELLE -** Modest 7th of 9 in a 2625m Class D at La Rochelle late last month. Is proven in this configuration and, with application, can play an active role

- **2. INCENIA DE HOUELLE -** Comes to Meslay after posting 6 straight sanctions, most recently a 3150m Granville Class F on 6 August and, modified configuration or not, can be confidently passed over
- **3. IBIZA PACHA -** 5th of 10 in a 2725m Class F at Pornichet 2 weeks ago. Is presently in fine shape, gets on well with Arnaud Desmottes, and will be competitive for a place in the frame
- **4. IASELMA -** Has done nothing of note for some time, latterly 7th of 10 in a 2725m Pornichet Class F 3 weeks ago, and is unlikely to shake things up
- **5. IN LOVE WITH PUCH -** Sanctioned in a 2450m amateurs Class H at Sainte-Marie-du-Mont earlier this month. Has nothing to prove in this category though and, if behaved, can play a leading role

- **3. KADRO D'ARIANE -** Last of 7, on comeback, in a 3000m Class E at Rochefort-sur-Loire 11 days ago, and will not be troubling the judge
- **4. KOOL LUDOIS -** Lost his maiden status [at 15th time of asking] when courageously winning a 2725m Pornichet Class F 2 weeks ago. In better company this time but should nonetheless acquit himself competitively
- **5. KENZO DE CLOPEAU -** 5th of 9 in a 2475m Royan Class E late last month. Is better than the result would suggest and looks a decent place prospect this time around
- **6. KOMAN -** Got back in the game when 3rd of 10 in a 2800m Vichy Class E 12 days ago. Sports the same configuration and will be worth monitoring
- **7. KATUDI -** Sanctioned in a 2400m Amiens Class E a fortnight ago. Blows hot and cold but is an excellent servant when focused and is not incapable of losing his maiden tag
- **8. KARTING BOY -** Has not been seen out since winning a 2700m Vincennes monté Class E late-December. Hind shoes off for re-entry but will have other priorities

Summary: After getting off the mark at Laval last month, KAISER VRIE (1) encountered interference at Pornichet next time, but there is no question regarding his form and can play a leading role if Henri Touvais keeps him out of trouble. That being said, the complicated KATUDI (7) is no slouch when focused, as he showed when reined by Matthieu Abrivard at Angers earlier in the year. KENZO DE CLOPEAU (5) has been progressing this term and the inclusion of Jean-Philippe Monclin into the equation will only spice things up.

- **3. HIT PERRINE -** Showed improvement when 4th of 8 in a Class E under these conditions on 30 July, but will struggle to repeat
- **4. HARRY DE MIENNAIS -** 5th, a place behind HIT PERRINE (3) in a Class E over course and distance late-July. Has already won 5 this year and, while unlikely to make it 6, should nevertheless acquit himself competitively

HARFAN DES GRANGES (8) must be forgiven his recent Enghien blip and can get straight back in the game. HALL BLACK MESS (9) seldom gets his nose in front but is consistently in the thick of things and unlikely to disappoint.
