- **1. LOLITA DE SEE -** A 3 Year old filly by Bon Copain out of Comtesse de Sée who makes her debut. Betting is the best guide
- **2. LA FRILEUSE -** She was disqualified on debut in a class G at Vitre over 2200m on 2 June. Must be wise and can improve on the first effort
- **3. LOLLIPOP D'UGGATTE -** Two moderate efforts to date, the latest in a class G at Savigny-sur-Braye over 2525m on 9 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. LORENZA QUEEN -** Well beaten 8th on debut in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 4 June. Others are preferred in this line-up
