- **1. LULO DE SUHARDIERE -** Unraced since finishing last of 9 in a 2825m Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe last May. Has shown little aptitude for the game and can be ruled out
- **2. LISA MONA BLUE -** Flattering 5th of 10 in a 2200m Vincennes Class E on 5 October, and will have nothing to offer here
- **3. LOVA BLUE -** 4th of 13, at 70/1, in a 3000m Nantes Class B 10 days ago but, in this company, is unlikely to repeat
- **4. LUTIN DE REUX -** Ran 3rd at Vincennes before coming 4th of 15 to LILAS CASTELLE (12) in a Class B over track and trip on 1 November. Has ground to make up on Gelormini's filly but still looks the main threat
- **5. LOOK AT ME LULU -** Sanctioned in 3 of last 4, latterly a 2625m Class C at La Rochelle last weekend. Breaks in front but first needs to right the ship
- **6. LOTI SOLO -** Last of 15 when being conditioned in race of reference. Shoes on again and can be passed over
- **7. L'AS DESBOIS -** Has 2 races in him since the break, latterly 6th of 13, behind LOVA BLUE (3), in a 3000m Nantes Class B 10 days ago. Means business in this configuration and the excellent entry will only work to his advantage. Chance
- **8. LIZY JOSSELYN -** Takes a dip in class after finishing last but one, behind LAKARA (10), in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 8 days ago. Is reconfigured, entrusted to Matthieu Abrivard this time, and can make first 5
- 9. LASH PERRINE Placed in a Gr.2 last winter but below-par since, latterly 12th of 15 to LILAS CASTELLE (12) in a Class B over track and trip on 1 November. Remains shod and best to hold off

- **12. LILAS CASTELLE -** Winner of her last 2, most recently a Class B under these conditions with ease, a fortnight ago, and the hat-trick is well within her capacity

Summary: Back at the top of her game after a rollercoaster of a summer, LILAS CASTELLE (12) flew up over course and distance on 1 November and even though stepping back up in category, can make this his own. Gabriele Gelormini will still be wary of front-row starters, LUTIN DE REUX (4), who finished 4th that day, and the well-entered L'AS DESBOIS (7) who is fitted with pads after a brace of conditioners. 6th here before running 4th in a Vincennes Gr.3, the padded LAKARA (10) will be unavailable at 39/1 this time.

- **2. IDYLLE PIYA -** Sanctioned in both starts since the break, latterly a 2875m Enghien Class D a month ago, and can be confidently disregarded
- **3. IZZIE D'ERONVILLE -** Courageous 2nd of 16 in a 3000m Nantes Class F 10 days ago. Takes on another decent bunch but, on current trajectory, will not be far off the mark
- **4. IRMA DU VIVIER -** Made up for some below-par efforts when 3rd of 14 in a 2150m Enghien Class E on 10 October. Breaks in front and, freshly-configured, can play a leading role
- **5. ITALIA JADOR -** Back under harness after running 4th of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Has placed just once in 7 Laval appearances and is not about to change her ways
- **6. HOTESSE D'HAUFOR -** Last of 9 in a 2050m Class F at Divonne-les-Bains late-August. Has done nothing noteworthy all year and, even racing barefoot, will not be influencing the outcome
- **7. IROMEE -** Last but one in a Class E over course and distance 8 days ago. Out of sorts for some time and must first reaffirm
- **8. INTOUCHABLE -** By no means disgraced when 5th of 11 behind INDIGO PIERJI (10) in a 2700m Vincennes Class A late last month. Is confirmed here and should finish closer this time
- **9. IVANOF -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Machecoul Class E a fortnight ago. Thrives with the day's driver though and must be considered a player
- **10. INDIGO PIERJI -** Good, consistent type that ran 2nd of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Class A late last month, and a similar effort would see him win this
- **11. FURIEUSE PURPLE -** 11th of 14, a place behind IVANOF (9), in a Class D over track and trip on 26 September. Shoes back on and no threat
- **12. INDY DE JYR -** 5th of 15 in a 2575m Agen Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Is highly-consistent, races barefoot this time, and again represents a decent first-5 chance

IVANOF (9) is reunited with Eric Raffin and, even though incurring the penalty, will still be expected to put his latest results behind him.

- 2. KRONOS ZEN Made up for Vincennes sanction when 2nd of 11 in a 2850m Meslay Class B on 2 October. Comes here fresh and, plainly in competition-mode, will be dangerous if focused
- **3. KING TEJY -** Surprise 8th of 15, a place behind KARMA POWER (10), in a Class B over course and distance a fortnight ago. Useful in both codes and, although not a priority, can still takes advantage of his front-line break
- **4. KOUSINE CARISAIE -** 9th of 11, on return from a spell, in a 2100m Vincennes Class C 3 weeks ago. Fitted with 4 pads this time but still not easy to recommend
- **5. KINDY PERRINE -** Last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 18 October. Barefoot this time but has little else going for her here
- **6. KILLER DE CAHOT -** Reassuring 2nd on turf before running 3rd of 15, a place behind KARMA POWER (10), in a Class B over course and distance a fortnight ago. On front row again, races barefoot, and should be competitive for a first-5 cheque
- 7. KEPI DU HOME 8th of 15 in a 2750m Class B at Les Sables on 21 October. Shoes on again and best to hold off

- **2. JIANFRANCO -** Comfortable winner of a Class D over course and distance on 5 October. Is never far from faulting but, if applied, will have a good chance of repeating
- **3. JEDUISANT -** Sanctioned, on 2nd start back, in a 2700m Vincennes Class B mid-October. Remains shod and can be passed over
- **4. JAVA DES CAILLONS -** Not once out of first 2 in last 5 starts, latterly 2nd of 13 in a 2875m Enghien Class D 3 weeks ago. Races shod this time though and best to keep one's powder dry

JAPPELOUP TURGOT (11) has been going good-guns recently, running 2nd under these conditions just 2 weeks ago, but Matthieu Abrivard can again expect to feel the heat from a reconfigured JEWEL DE BANVILLE (9) who finished a place behind him here.

- **3. HENRI DE LA ROUVRE -** Returns to the ridden discipline after finishing 7th of 15 in a 2850m Maure Class F last Sunday. Has previously won here but cannot be considered a priority
- **4. INCROYABLE MORGAN -** Sanctioned in a 2650m Alencon Class F on 6 October. Has otherwise found a new lease on life since switching codes and, if applied, is unlikely to let the side down

INCROYABLE MORGAN (4) should not be too hastily-judged for his Alencon sanction, and should appreciate the new profile.

- **5. IBAN DE KARA -** 9th of 17, on return from a spell, in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E on 1 November. Will have come on for the run and, nicely-positioned in front, can play a prominent role
- **6. INDIANA BUROISE -** Hardy mare that ran 3rd of 9 in a 2825m Vire monté Class F 3 weeks ago. Would be preferred a level down but Paul Buhigné will be eager to take advantage of the draw
- **7. INDIRISS -** Made up for a pair of sanctions when 5th of 15 in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel a fortnight ago. Breaks on front line and, if focused, will have a claim on a place in the frame
- **8. IMPERIALE MIVENCE -** Pleasant 6th of 12, on re-entry, in a 2650m Saint-Malo amateurs Class G a fortnight ago. Forced to start wide and races shod, but is not one to be overlooked
- **9. IRYSKA LESMELCHEN -** 7th of 14 in a 2675m Class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 3 November. Has form in this category though and will not be far from the action if she reproduces her Pornichet performance

- **16. IPANO STAR -** Unplaced in last 3, latterly last of 13 in an amateurs Class G over course and distance 2 weeks ago, and the draw only compounds matters

Summary: Easy winner of an amateurs event at Nantes earlier this month, IRONIE DE CHENU (3) finds herself perfectly-placed behind the car here and, with application, can double her money. IF DE LA COUDRE (1) reverts to a previous formula for the occasion, will not be inconvenienced by the draw, and should be dangerous at the business end of the race. In his category, and with a race under his belt, IBAN DE KARA (5) has been handed a good draw and his fine apprentice will be loathe to let it go to waste. The complicated INDIRISS (7) reassured last time out and will not be far off the mark if young Thomas Viaud keeps him trotting.

- **2. KNOCKANDO -** 4th of 13, on first appearance since March, in a Class F over course and distance a fortnight ago. Will have progressed for the run and, although still shod, nevertheless warrants respect
- **3. KIZIA STAR -** Imposed at Lisieux a fortnight ago before faulting in a 2450m Caen Class F last Saturday. Takes on the boys this time, but pleased here in September and cannot be discounted
- **4. KAZAN BEACH -** Has not been seen out since finishing 7th of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class E last June. Disregard
- **5. KACTUS DE BEAUM -** Won at Amiens before coming 4th of 9 in a 2800m Vire Class E 3 weeks ago. Races left-handed for just 2nd time and, even with 4 pads fitted, still looks out of his depth
- **6. KONG DODVILLE -** Progressive type that ran 2nd of 13 in a Class E over course and distance late-September, on first start since the spell. Comes here fresh and should be able to win this
- **7. KUROKO LAUAR -** Not the most dependable but ran a courageous 5th of 10 in a 2875m Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago and will not be available at 100/1 this time
- **8. KARLA JALLERIE -** 2nd of 8 in a 3250m Saumur Class F, on return from a spell, earlier this month. Tends to show more on turf though and others preferred
- **9. KISS ME CRAZY -** Useful filly making first appearance since coming 2nd of 12 in a Class E under these conditions late-August, and will not be given a hard race

That said, the nicely-engaged KING DE CHOISEL (15) got back to victorious ways at Nantes recently and racing barefoot this time will only enhance his prospects. KUROKO LAUAR (7) makes his Laval bow after a reassuring performance at Enghien and, with form maintained, is unlikely to disappoint. Just €145 from elimination, KID LEA DRIVER (16) defied her odds on comeback and must be taken more seriously.

- **9. MISS IS DU CANET -** 5th in last 2, latterly of 10 in a 2050m Cordemais Class F on 6 October. Pulled a rough draw and will have little to offer
- **10. MADIBA DE BELLANDE -** Put in a good debut performance on 19 October, coming 4th of 8 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class E. Forced to start on 2nd line but will have a lot to offer if Alexis Collette successfully negotiates the start
- **11. MOSTRA DE CHANLECY -** Qualified in 1'18"8 at Meslay last May. Gabi Gelormini gets the nod here and, despite the draw, will generate considerable interest
- **12. MISTER CHARM -** Debuted 5th of 8 in a 2725m Lisieux Class F a fortnight ago. Goes left-handed this time but others still easier to back
- **13. MIDDLE STAR -** Qualified in 1'19"7 here late-May. Has had time to come on over the summer but the draw will do him no favours
- **14. MAGIC LOVE -** Qualified in 1'18"5 here early-July. Benjamin Rochard in the bike and, if as good in competition, can play a prominent role

Summary: Very good second on her debut at Cherbourg early this month, MAFALDA (5) takes on the colts this time but still looks good enough to dominate. The complicated MARBOXIE D'HERIPRE (7) takes a notable dip in class and will be no easy touch if William Bigeon can keep her focused. MADIBA DE BELLANDE (10) showed decent aptitude first time out and will have come on for the run. Third over course and distance before failing to fire at Cabourg, MISTER SALTOR (6) returns to Laval in a legitimate bid at redemption.
