# C1 - PRIX DU MINERVOIS - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 19,000

- **1. JUNIOR DU MANOIR -** Disqualified in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Has major disqualification issues and can easily be overlooked
- **2. JESSICA TURGOT -** 6th in class E at Vichy over 2800m on 18 May. On a long losing streak and is best left out against this bunch
- **3. JHA -** 11th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Unreliable since victorious in July and needs to reaffirm at present
- **4. JONQUERA MARBOULA -** 8th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 20 November. Needs to raise her game significantly to play a role
- **5. JINGLE DU TRIO -** Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 September. On a long losing streak and cannot be given any consideration
- **6. KING MAKER -** 4th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 10 October. Has every chance on the back of this effort
- **7. JAZZ DE MONGOCHY -** Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 24 October. Well-entered and can make amends
- **8. JET D'ARJEANC -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Has major disqualification issues since March. Others are preferred
- 9. JOSELITO PHIL 8th in class F at Feurs over 2850m on 29 October. Has a good record over the course & distance and can be in the shake-up
- **10. KANARDO FOR CLARA -** 6th in class F at Feurs over 2850m on 29 October. Placed three times in previous four attempts. Place chance
- **11. JALIENORTH GAME -** 10th in class A at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 9 November. Unreliable and is not easy to fancy
- **12. KARLSON PASS -** 8th in class D at Enghien over 2875m on 7 October. Holds the best credentials and can bounce back anytime
- **13. JACKPOT MATH -** 8th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Won twice this year and will have every chance once again

**Summary:** KING MAKER (6) was a good fourth in a competitive event over the course & distance last time and looks to have every chance in this line-up. He jumps off the front row and will surely take a power of beating. JACKPOT MATH (13) shaped up nicely under harness last time out for this contest and should be a huge player too. KARLSON PASS (12) holds the best credentials in the race and warrants serious consideration. JONQUERA MARBOULA (4) is an intriguing candidate.

- **1. GONDOR -** Unreliable and was 6th in class D at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 27 October. Well positioned at the start and has a place chance
- **2. HARDE DESTINEE** Disappointing of late and was 10th in class D at Nimes over 2750m on 1 November. Placed three times this year and can show a rebound of form
- **3. HERMES DE CLOPEAU -** Finished fourth in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 27 October. Won well in October and in similar form ought to be a big player
- **4. GRAINE D'URZY -** Disappointing form of late and was 8th in class D at Nimes over 2750m on 1 November. Won well back in May but is not the most reliable trotter
- **5. HASIR -** Victorious in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 29th October. Won twice this year and can repeat here down in grade
- **6. GALLIA DU LINAIS -** Disappointing last run when 9th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. Victorious in September and is barefoot this time. Can contest the finish
- **7. GET UP DE VAUVILLE -** Finished 8th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 27 October. Has little room for maneuver but can stake a claim
- **8. HELLO BOY DU PIC -** Showed soem improvement when fourth in class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 19 October. Not ideally placed at the start but can make his presence felt
- **9. HALTESS GRIFF -** Unreliable and was 11th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. On a long losing streak and others are preferred

- **13. GLAIEUL DE JOUX -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in class E at Feurs over 2850m on 29 October. On a long losing streak and needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** HASIR (5) was a sound winner of a better class of event at Feurs a fortnight ago and should prove hard to oppose once again. The win-form HERMES DE CLOPEAU (3) ships a long way for this race and should be closely monitored. GALLIA DU LINAIS (6) registered her last success at this venue and runs barefoot today so is best to keep on the shortlist. GONDOR (1) can make his presence felt from a good berth behind the autostart.

- **1. LIBERTY BOY** Unreliable and was third in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 October. Yet to win and more is needed to win this race
- **2. LULLY DES IRIS -** Finished 7th in class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 4 November. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched fro now
- **3. LOVE ME DE CERISY -** Hard to trust and was 6th in class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 10 October. Unreliable and others are preferred
- **4. LEVIATHAN SANTMIXO -** Only modest of late and was 6th in class B at Saint-Galmier over 2625m on 5 November. Might play a minor role
- **5. LIBERTY DU MORTIER -** Disappointing last run when 8th in class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 10 October. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **6. L'AMBASSADEUR -** In good shape and was third in class B at Saint-Galmier over 2625m on 5 November. Has a winning chance

- **3. INGALLS -** Only modest of late but was 6th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. IBIS DU LYS -** Disqualified in class F at Divonne-Lees-Bains over 2675m on 22 August. Has major disqualification issues and needs major improvement to win
- **5. ISCO DE JOUDES -** Disappointing last run when 7th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3025m on 20 October. Better judged on penultimate start and is not out of it
- **6. INDRA DE FORGES -** Finished 8th in class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 3 November. Won twice in 66 career attempts and is best watched for now
- **7. IDEAL WESTERN -** Disappointing last run when 11th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 23 July. On a long losing streak but is capable of earning some money
- **8. ICARINO DU CHOQUEL -** Finished 14th in class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 25 October. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

- **4. KADO DES MOLLES -** Has disqualification issues but was runner-up in class B at Saint-Galmier over 2625m on 5 November. Hard to trust but could play a minor role if wise
- **5. KLIMT MERITE** Finished 11th in Class B at Saint-Galmier over 2625m on 5 November. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win

- **4. KRACH NONANTAIS -** Unreliable and was fourth last time out in Class D at Feurs over 2050m on 29 October. Not out of it
- **5. KERCHAK -** On a long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class D at Feurs over 2050m on 29 October. Could earn some minor money

- **2. JACOBIN DU GOUTIER -** Complicated but undeniably capable trotter who usually acquits himself well when not disqualified. Last-start winner over 2700m at Lyon-La Soie on 1 November and remains competitive, even at this level
- **3. JAKABINO -** Disqualified in consecutive recent outings the latest over 3000m at Marseille-Borely on 18 October but has sufficient means to acquit himself competitively if applied/remaining wise. Dark horse
- **4. JOLAN BOY -** Ultra-consistent trotter with sound references/form credentials, including a course-and-distance 3rd on 10 October under similar conditions. Keep safe
- **5. JUST BEAUTIFUL -** Confirmed under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration but out of sorts and unlikely to trouble the judge. Disqualified over 2700m at Lyon-La Soie on 11 November
- **6. JAMES DE LA VALLEE -** Tricky customer with sound references under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration, including a last-start 2nd over 2700m at Lyon-La Soie on 11 November. Attractive outsider
- **7. JOBALASKO BLEU -** Complicated but is undeniably capable, especially in this (barefoot) configuration. Finished 6th (shod) at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November and is presented shod for this commitment will be a factor
- **8. JURAE VET -** Experienced hard-knocker with consistent/sound references, including a last-start 2nd with her irons at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 27 October
- **9. JUMANJI SIBEY -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a good 3rd on this course over 2825m on 6 October. Not taken lightly
- **10. JEDI DES BROUETS -** Disqualified in 3 consecutive recent appearances, the latest over 2700m at Lyon-Parilly on 1 November. Others preferred
- **11. JUST D'ERONVILLE -** Consistent performer with references at a higher level and a course-and-distance victory on 25 May. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 9th over 3000m at Salon-de-Provence on 26 October
- **12. JESON BOY -** Ultra-consistent trotter with sound references/form credentials at a higher level, especially under these conditions and in this (barefoot) configuration. Runner-up recently in consecutive course-and-distance races, the latest on 10 October

**Summary:** ESON BOY (12) has been unlucky not to win recently. He should have that consistency rewarded with a winning turn soon. JOBLASKO BLEU (7) is unreliable but is capable of winning. JOLAN BOY (4), consistent overall, is likely to be competitive once again. JUST D'ERONVILLE (11) is consistent and has won over this course and distance so is another to consider.

- **2. IMPULSE JULRY -** Atoned for her disqualification at Marseille-Borely in September with a last-start victory over 2650m at Marseille-Vivaux on 28 October. Keep safe
- **3. HARLEQUIN -** Complicated veteran with sufficient means but is currently out of sorts. Unplaced (9th) over 2650m at Marseille-Vivaux on 3 November
- **4. INCAHUASI -** Thriving trotter who has won 3 of his last 4 starts, including his latest over this course and distance last month (10 October). Candidate for success
- **5. JONGLEUSE DE LUNE -** Classy mare with sound/consistent references at a higher level under these conditions, which include finishing 4th in back-to-back 2700m Quinte+ events at Vincennes the latest on 8 November. One to beat
- **6. INBREED -** Complicated but undeniably capable trotter who usually acquits himself competitively when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th over 3000m at Marseille-Borely on 11 October
- **7. ISTER MAN -** Inconsistent but undeniably capable performer whose references include winning a 2700m Vincennes Quinte+ in late September. Shouldn't be condemned for finishing 9th at Saint-Galmier on 16 October
- **8. FEEL GOOD DESBOIS -** Experienced and versatile hard-knocker with sound references in both trotting disciplines, though most effective unshod. Finished 5th (barefoot) in a 2850m Quinte+ at Vincennes on 26 August watch for now
- **9. GEANT SARTHOIS -** Well-performed veteran with references at a higher level although is most effective racing without irons. Disqualified over 2650m at Hyeres on 13 October and is best watched for now
- **10. EDEN JULRY -** Tricky customer with means but is out of sorts. Finished 8th (plated) at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 October could fare better in this barefoot configuration
- **11. HEROS DES MOTTES -** A model of consistency under these conditions with solid form references/credentials, including a good 5th over 2650m at Marseille-Vivaux on 28 October. Should have a role to play
- **12. FEMTO DE VAUVERT -** Consistent veteran with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a Saint-Galmier Quinte+ over 2625m on 16 October. Remains competitive even with his irons (shod)

**Summary:** JONGLEUSE DE LUNE (5) is a class mare and she has held her form well. She does look the one to be with in this lucky last race. INCAHUASI (4) has been at the top of his game of late and will certainly challenge for top honours. HERO DES MOTTES (11) is consistent and is not out of it. FEMTO DE VAUVERT (12), is a consistent veteran and also has a winning chance.
