- **1. INTREPIDE DES BOIS -** Runner-up in last 2, most recently a 2425m Class F at Sainte-Mariedu-Mont earlier in the month. In superior company this time around and others easier to back
- **2. INFIEL -** Made the frame in 3 of last 4, latterly 3rd to INDIAN PACIFIC (8) in a 2875m Enghien Class D 2 weeks ago. Not a leading contender but can still pick up a slice of the pie
- **3. INDIC -** Hard to fault at present, most recently runner-up to INDIAN PACIFIC (8) in a 2875m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago. Denied a run that day and can turn the tables if David Békaert keeps him out of trouble
- **4. INFERNA DE HOUELLE -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently a 2875m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago. Is not the biggest fan of Vincennes but has previously won over 2700m here and could pleasantly surprise
- **5. HOUSTON DE JOUDES -** Disappointing since returning from his break, latterly last but one in a 3025m Class F at Montier-en-Der 2 weeks ago, and has no possible chance
- **6. IMAGE D'ATALANTE -** 5th behind IZIA DE MONGIVAL (9) in a 2725m Pornichet Class F on 25 July. Hind shoes off for the first time but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **7. INKY PERRINE -** Made it 2 straight sanctions when faulting in a 3000m Class F at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre 2 weeks ago. Has ample ability but will first need to re-establish her credentials
- **8. INDIAN PACIFIC** Impressive winner of a 2875m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago. Seldom disappoints when barefoot and focused, and has a realistic chance of doubling his money
- **9. IZIA DE MONGIVAL -** 3rd of 10 in a 2725m Pornichet Class F late last month. Seldom disappoints at Vincennes these days and will be no pushover

Summary: Winner at La Capelle before running [an unlucky] 2nd to INDIAN PACIFIC (8) across town a fortnight ago, INDIC (3) is capable of exacting revenge, provided he is afforded a run this time. Solid as a rock since the spring, IZIA DE MONGIVAL (9) enjoys a good entry and has already won under these conditions this season. INFERNA DE HOUELLE (4) has won 2 of her last 3 and, with application, can again figure prominently.

- **1. JOKER DE FROULAY -** Has gone from strength to strength lately, most recently 2nd of 7 in a 2875m Enghien Class D a week ago, but takes a hike up the category-ladder and others preferred
- 2. JASON DU CONROY 10th of 11 behind JASPER DES CHARMES (8) in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class A 2 weeks ago. Races barefoot for the first time this season and should not be written off
- **3. JUNE -** Left a good impression on re-entry 3 weeks ago, coming 3rd, a place behind JAZZ IN MONTREUX (7), in a 2775m Class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne. Consistently acquits herself honourably and will be competitive for a place on the podium
- **4. JASPERS TURGOT -** 7th of 10 in a 2700m Graignes harness Class D conditioner early August. Makes first monté start for over 2 years and best to monitor
- **5. JUST FOR BACK -** Excellent servant under the saddle with 2 conditioners under his belt, most recently last of 11 behind JASPER DES CHARMES (8) in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class A a fortnight ago. Barefoot this time and no pushover
- **6. KAPAULA DE L'EPINE -** Sanctioned when prepping for this in a 2875m Enghien harness Gr.3 early last month. Worth remembering her 2 Gr.2 victories during the winter meeting and, reverting to a proven formula, will not be far from the action
- **7. JAZZ IN MONTREUX -** Serious trotter that ran 2nd in a 2775m Class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne 3 weeks ago. Won this race as a 4yo and, in current condition, is very easy to like. Chance
- **8. JASPER DES CHARMES -** Gr.1 winner that has not had it easy this term. Reassured with success in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class A a fortnight ago and, on good behaviour, can make this his own

Summary: Superb at 4, JASPER DES CHARMES (8) struggled for much of 2024 before winning a decent Cabourg harness event earlier this month and, entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for the occasion, can produce the goods and win this. A force when barefoot and focused, JAZZ IN MONTREUX (7) will be no easy touch if Nathalie Henry keeps him trotting. JUST FOR BACK (5) will be fit by now, appreciates Vincennes, and will be expected to finish close.

- **1. KEMILLA DE BRION -** Takes a massive leap in category after winning a 2625m Class D at La Rochelle late last month and while clearly capable, does not look up to the task
- **2. KOSANOSTRA -** Has taken her game to a new level this year, most recently 3rd of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class C 9 days ago. In exalted company this time though and appears to be biting off more than she can chew
- **3. KOTKIE -** Won her 2nd of the year in a 2150m Cagnes Class B on 22 July. Takes on a serious bunch this time though and chances slim
- **4. KANAKA DE BUSSET -** Unexceptional 6th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class B a week ago and is not about to influence the outcome
- **5. KOUFRA IRIS'EYES -** 4th to KOKOTE (8) in a 2150m Enghien Class C on 10 July. Takes a leap in category but is a game filly and can get a look-in
- **6. KEMIA DU CHENE -** 3rd to KELLE BEAUTE (10) in Gr.2 Prix Guy le Gonidec before winning a 2100m Class C here late-June. Has never disappointed when unshod and is not about to start. Place chance
- **7. KEEN WINNER -** Makes first foray into Gr.2 territory after trotting 8th of 14 in Gr.3 Prix de Milan over 2150m at Enghien a month ago. Raced better that day than the result would suggest and is not to be underestimated
- **8. KOKOTE -** Consistent campaigner stepping back up in category after coming 4th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class B 3 weeks ago. Has never tackled 2175m but on current trajectory, looks a player
- **9. KIARA DE VANDEL -** 4th of 9, on return from a spell, in a 2875m Enghien Class B a week ago. Will have come on for the run but still looks out of her depth
- **10. KELLE BEAUTE -** Beat a number of these in Gr.2 Prix Guy le Gonidec early-June before being sanctioned, when shod, in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 earlier this month. Shoes off this time and can claim her 2nd Gr.2 victory
- **11. KABAKA DE GUEZ -** Respectable 5th of 9 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 a fortnight ago. Has done nothing noteworthy at this level since last autumn and is unlikely to spring any surprises

Won on that occasion by the improving KELLE BEAUTE (10), she races barefoot and should again have the edge over runner-up, the unshod KANA DE BEYLEV (14) who can boast a good turn of foot. Third that day before winning over 2100m here 3 weeks later, KEMIA DU CHENE (6) will again have her chances, but may first have to defer to a barefoot KEEN WINNER (7) whose recent Enghien result belied the impressive nature of her finish.

- **2. LILI DRY -** Never far from faulting but has ample talent, most recently 2nd of 8 in a 2875m Enghien Class B last weekend. Arguably better under the saddle though and can be passed over
- **3. LIPANGA DE GUEZ -** 5th of 7 finishers, behind LAKARA (1), in a 3000m Class B at Rochefort-sur-Loire 12 days ago. Shod to preference this time but still appears to have too much to do
- **4. LOVE LETTER -** 4th to LUSH LIFE (5) in a 2875m Enghien Class A 3 weeks ago. Entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for first time and should be competitive for a place in the frame
- **5. LUSH LIFE -** Put a brace of sanctions behind her when 2nd of 10 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class A 3 weeks ago. Has never delivered in this category however and chances appear limited
- **6. LA FEE DU NOYER -** Runner-up in both return runs, most recently to LONDON (9) in 2700m Gr.3 Prix d'Istres at Vincennes on 7 June. Just front pads fitted for the first time and although unseen for over 2 months, must not be overlooked
- **7. LITTLE STRAWBERRY -** Pleasant 5th of 9 in a 2800m Bernay Class B 3 weeks ago, on first start for 6 months. Just front pads fitted for first time but may still need the run
- **8. LILAS CASTELLE -** Faulted in last 2, latterly when prepping for this in a 3000m Class B at Rochefort-sur-Loire 12 days ago, and must get her house in order
- **9. LONDON -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently the 2875m Gr.3 Prix de Berlin at Enghien a fortnight ago. Would have finished 3rd that day had she stayed in stride and, with application, will have an important role to play here
- **10. LADY -** Respectable 4th of 8 finishers in 2875m Gr.3 Prix de Berlin at Enghien 2 weeks ago. Has references at this level and looks a decent first-5 chance

JMB will still be keeping a keen eye on the complicated but talented LONDON (9) who showed her form across town recently, and LOUISIANE DE BOMO (14) who consistently fires on all cylinders. LOVE LETTER (4) gets a top pilot this time around and will justifiably generate interest.

- **1. KANTO AVIS -** Honest colt that finished 5th behind KNOCKONWOOD (3) in 2150m Gr.3 Prix de Milan at Enghien on 20 July. Has otherwise been in fine shape and is not about to go home empty-handed
- 2. KHAL'S FELLA Unraced since coming 5th behind KOCTEL DU DAIN (10) in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Jules Thibault here on 8 June. Shod for competition but not an obvious choice on this occasion
- **3. KNOCKONWOOD -** Like a new horse since starting to race in the day's configuration, most recently winning 2875m Gr.3 Prix de Genève at Enghien a fortnight ago. Has never delivered at Gr.2 level but this nevertheless looks an ideal opportunity. Claim
- **4. KARLITO -** Returned successfully to competition 2.5 weeks ago, winning a 2850m Meslay-du-Maine Class B. Back at a track he likes, with morale intact, and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **5. KEEP GOING -** Won Gr.3 Prix Raymond Fouard late-June before finishing 3rd, a place behind KNOCKONWOOD (3), in 2150m Gr.3 Prix de Milan at Enghien a month ago, and will be expected to run him close again
- **6. KRISTAL JOSSELYN -** 10th of 14, after faulting at the start, in 2150m Gr.3 Prix de Milan at Enghien a month ago. Has placed just once in 8 this term and will need to find considerably more
- **7. KSAR -** 2nd in Gr.2 Prix Jules Thibault before coming 5th of 8 to KEEP GOING (5) in Gr.3 Prix Raymond Fouard over course and distance late-June. Is not about to win this but nonetheless has the wherewithal to make first 5

That being said, KEEP GOING (5) came a fast-finishing 3 behind him in the Gr.3 Prix de Milan and is not incapable of turning the tables. By some margin the wealthiest horse here, KOCTEL DU DAIN (10) has never disappointed under these conditions, sports a new configuration, and is similarly a serious contender. Barefoot for the first time after imposing on comeback last month, KARLITO (4) is most certainly one for the short-list.

- **2. JOCONDE SIBEY -** Did not enjoy the best of trips, finishing 8th behind JAMIN DE BRION (3) in a 2150m Enghien Class B earlier this month. Is confirmed at Gr.2 level, races barefoot this time, and can play a small part
- **3. JAMIN DE BRION -** 2nd of 13 in a 2150m Enghien Class B 9 days ago. Beat a number of these in Prix Jean le Gonidec in June, and will be no easy touch
- **4. JUST A MIDI -** Has done nothing but improve since returning to competition, most recently winning a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 early last month. Ran 4th in Prix Jean le Gonidec and will have his supporters
- **5. JANGO VICI -** Makes first appearance since coming 2nd of 14 in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3 on 23 June. Just front pads fitted this time and can be passed over
- **6. JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL -** Serious trotter that was denied a run on comeback 2 weeks ago, finishing 2nd of 11 in a 2750m Cabourg Class A. Has been a revelation since last autumn and has every chance of making the frame here
- **7. JAG STRYCK -** 7th behind JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (6) in a 2750m Cabourg Class A on 2 August. Not as sharp as he was earlier in the season and will not be troubling the judge
- **8. JACK TONIC -** 2nd to JAMIN DE BRION (3) in Gr.2 Prix Jean le Gonidec before trotting 3rd, a place behind JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (6), in a 2750m Cabourg Class A a fortnight ago. Clearly in excellent shape and can make first 5
- **9. JOYNER SPORT -** Last but one in a 2950m Saint-Malo Gr.3 10 days ago. Stays shod and will have other priorities
- **10. JUSTIN BOLD -** 5th to JUSHUA TREE (13) in 2875m Gr.2 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère at Enghien 3 weeks ago. Won a Gr.2 for Yoann Lebourgeois last time at the venue and will be justifiably well-supported
- **11. JOSH POWER -** 4th of 10, when prepping for this, in a 2700m Graignes Class D earlier in the month. Has excellent references in this class of race and looks main threat to JUSHUA TREE (13)
- **12. JUST LOVE YOU -** Complicated but talented mare making first appearance since faulting in Gr.2 Prix Jean le Gonidec over course and distance early-June. Shoes on and best to hold off
- **13. JUSHUA TREE -** A veritable powerhouse that made short work of 2875m Gr.2 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère at Enghien 3 weeks ago. Is unbeaten over 2175m and will be expected to make this his own

Summary: After 5.5 months off the track, JMB's extraordinary JUSHUA TREE (13) ran rings around the opposition in the Gr.2 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère across town on comeback, and confidently bids to remain unbeaten under these conditions. Principal resistance comprises the ultra-consistent JOSH POWER (11) who is barefoot following a brace of conditioners, and the reinvigorated JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (6) whose re-entry run bodes well for his chances. JUSTIN BOLD (10) consistently gives his best and although unproven over 2175m here, he reverts to racing unshod-behind and his candidacy warrants respect.

- **2. LOGAN JIEL -** 3rd to LIGHT MY FIRE (3) in a 2875m Enghien Class A on 27 July. Benjamin Rochard reining this time but still not a priority
- **3. LIGHT MY FIRE -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently a 2875m Enghien Class A with ease 3 weeks ago. Has never been tested at this level but can still play a small role
- **4. LITTLE BROWN -** 3rd of 8 to LUCIANO MENUET (9) in 2875m Gr.3 Prix de Berlin 2 weeks ago. Has yet to deliver in this grade of race and will not be springing any surprises
- **5. LUCKY JACKSON -** Won Gr.2 Prix Kalmia before finishing last but one in 2700m Gr.1 Prix Albert Viel on 23 June. Has had time to get his house in order though and is unlikely to be far off the mark this time
- **6. LOULOU DE MYE -** Put in a good effort to run 2nd to LOMBOK JIEL (7) in Gr.1 Prix Albert Viel over 2700m at Vincennes late-June. Has hind pads fitted again and deserves to be taken more seriously this time around

- **2. LIBERO DU DONJON -** 5th behind LERWICK PERRINE (3) in a 2875m Enghien Class D earlier in the month. Is not without merit but will nevertheless need to step up his game
- **3. LERWICK PERRINE -** Runner-up in his last 2, latterly a 2875m Enghien Class D 9 days ago. Is plainly close to his race and the addition of front pads could yet make all the difference
- **4. LOTUS PAULOIS -** 4th behind LERWICK PERRINE (3) in a 2875m Enghien Class D earlier this month. Takes on a tougher bunch this time around though and chances limited
- **5. LAST KINGDOM -** Quality future prospect that came in last of 7, on re-entry, in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class D 3 weeks ago. Comes here fresh and is not to be underestimated
- **6. LYNX D'URZY -** Failed to confirm his Vichy success when sanctioned in a 2850m Class C here in early-June. Shoes on this time but will be fresh and can get a look-in
- 7. LANCELOT PLATANES Returns to the monté discipline after faulting in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class D 3 weeks ago. In this category though, will have little to contribute
- **8. LOCHAN -** A thorough professional since last month's debut, latterly 2nd of 7 in a 2250m Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago. Is going from strength to strength and has a realistic chance of bringing home the bacon
- **9. LITTLE DRAGON -** Back under the saddle after faulting in a 2700m Graignes harness Class B a week ago. Is better than his numbers would imply and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard will do his prospects no disservice
- **10. LOTI SOLO -** Has thrived since embarking on his new vocation, comes here fresh after having run 2nd in a Class D over course and distance late-June, and should be good enough to give LOCHAN (8) a run for his money

Summary: LOCHAN (8) has not put a foot wrong in any of his 3 starts to date and, progressing with every run, has a legitimate claim on the trophy. Anthony Barrier will still want to be wary of LOTI SOLO (10) who is like a horse reborn since switching disciplines, and the promising but tricky LITTLE DRAGON (9) who showed considerable potential during the spring. LAST KINGDOM (5) may have just the one run under his belt but he went into his break on a good note and, front pads fitted with Mathieu Mottier in the irons, looks a decent proposition.
