- **1. LAVIABELLA VRIE -** Tricky filly making first appearance since winning a 2475m Royan Class F on 21 July. Takes on a tougher bunch this time but is still worth keeping an eye on
- **2. LA COMTESSE MADRIK -** 5th of 13, at 158/1, in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle 3.5 weeks ago. Is unlikely to repeat but it would be foolhardy to ignore her entirely
- **3. LOUISIANE -** Would have finished in the money at Vincennes on 20 September had she managed to keep trotting in a 2700m Class E. Entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for first time and can make a big splash
- **4. LAPONIE D'EMMA -** Won 2 on the trot before faulting, when clearly going well, in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 20 September. Will appreciate this more even surface and will be expected to redeem herself
- **5. LADY VICTORY -** Pleasant 4th of 12, behind LICORNVERASPERANZA (15), in a 2450m Caen Class E on 21 September. Flopped on lone appearance here but a repeat of her latest effort would see her get in on the action
- **6. LOKIE KADESH -** Starts for first time since coming 4th of 10 in a 2150m Class E here late-July. Steps up in category and may be a race shy
- **7. LINAYA DU CHATELET -** Met no opposition in either victorious start to date, most recently making short work of a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 13 September. Steps up in category but has a leading driver in the bike and can pull off the hat-trick
- **8. LILY POM MIX -** Placed twice going right-handed before running 7th of 9 finishers in a 2150m Class D here last week. Shoes back on but others still preferred
- **9. LOVELY FACE -** Handy element making first start since finishing 4th of 10 in a 2150m Class D here late-June. Has bags of potential and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **10. LEEDS -** Made up for her Vincennes blip when 3rd of 13 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E a fortnight ago. Is new to the venue but will appreciate these conditions and should logically finish in the mix
- **11. LAROZE DU GERS -** Quality filly that has yet to get into her stride this term, latterly sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class D on 13 September. It is only a question of time though
- **12. LUTELLIA MONNERIE -** Has not been seen out since finishing 5th of 7 in a 2475m Royan Class D mid-July, and is unlikely to shake things up
- **13. LUNA DE MALAC -** Makes first appearance in the capital after coming 4th of 9 in a 2300m Borély Class D late-August. May find the going just too tough this time around though
- **14. LOUNA D'OR -** Showed promise earlier in the year before losing her way, most recently last but one in a 2700m Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche a fortnight ago, and can be ruled out

15. LICORNVERASPERANZA - Quality filly that ran 2nd to a very good horse in a 2450m Caen Class E on 21 September. Sports 4 pads again and Yoann Lebourgeois will be reining a decent first-5 prospect

Summary: Unbeaten in 2 public appearances, LINAYA DU CHATELET (7) will be partnered by Eric Raffin for the first time and has every chance of maintaining her perfect status. Leading the opposition is the complicated but progressive LOUISIANE (3) who, sporting front pads for the first time, will be no pushover if Alexandre Abrivard keeps her trotting. LOVELY FACE (9) may not have been seen out since June but she will have freshness on her side and, if fit, will have a claim on a place in the frame. LAPONIE D'EMMA (4) missed out on the 3-timer last month but should be more suited to the Enghien profile, and can finish close.

- **2. JACKPOT DE JUMILLY -** Pleasant 4th of 9 in a 2775m monté Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne early last month. Enjoys a good entry, with Pierre-Yves Verva reining, and is unlikely to be going home empty-handed
- **3. JACK FOULONIERE -** Encouraged in a claimer over course and distance before running 8th in Le Croisé-Laroche race of reference. Good spot in front but others still easier to back
- **4. JYPSON KALOUMA -** Has 2 races under his belt following a long absence, latterly 12th of 15 in a 2700m Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche a fortnight ago. Shod this time, but has form at a superior level, and should not be written off
- **5. JUGEMENT D'AVE -** Fine servant that ran 3rd of 9 in a 2050m Laval Class E 3 weeks ago, making up for Vire clinker. Has good speed and gets a 2nd chance to crack the Enghien code
- **6. JIM CADE -** Sanctioned in a 2050m Laval Class E 3 weeks ago. Won under these conditions for Eric Raffin last season but is shod this time and latest form does little to impress
- 7. JOURNAL INTIME Made it 2 victories on the trot when winning a 2150m Vichy Class E on 21 September. Is new to the venue but has been too impressive of late not to garner the lion's share of support
- **8. JAMSHIR -** Ran 3rd at Vincennes before coming 4th of 9 in a 2050m Laval Class E 3 weeks ago. Gets a leading driver here and, despite the wide draw, still looks competitive for a place in the frame
- **9. JOKER WIC -** Won 2 in a row before running 3rd of 7, behind JOURNAL INTIME (7), in a 2150m Vichy Class E on 21 September. Thrives with Benjamin Rochard and will be no easy touch if he takes to new profile

- **3. KAZAN DE VANDEL -** Reassuring 3rd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a month ago. Franck Nivard reining this time and, from 3-spot, is well-placed to trot his way onto the podium
- **4. KASH PRIDE -** Ran 3rd over 2100m at Vincennes before faulting mid-way through a 2850m Class D at same venue 3.5 weeks ago. Is a tough nut when focused however and must not be underestimated

- **3. GENERAL -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a 2450m Caen Class D last Saturday, and will have nothing to offer
- **4. ENJEU DAIRPET -** Lacklustre 9th of 10 in a 2875m Meslay Class D on 2 October. Placed last time here but recent form does little to inspire confidence
- **5. FARCEUR DE MAI -** Returns to the discipline after finishing last of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes harness Class D 3 weeks ago. Has been struggling to make his mark and is not about to change his ways
- **6. GALOPIN DE MARTHE -** Has enjoyed something of a renaissance since switching codes, latterly dominating a 2175m Vincennes Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has yet to deliver at Enghien but excels in this configuration and can play a leading role

MARIE OH FREDLAU (8) got off the mark at the first time of asking and even though in more elevated company this time, she still looks a serious proposition.

- **3. KERIDA DE VIVOIN -** Has improved with every run since switching codes, most recently 4th of 10, behind KISMIE DE MONTFORT (9), in a 2875m Class D here on 28 September. Unlikely to open her 2024 account but can still finish in the mix

- **7. HOLLY SHINE -** 2nd of 11 in a 2600m Morlaix Class F 3.5 weeks ago. Placed on lone appearance at this level and has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque
- **8. IQUITO PLANCHETTE -** Won 7 of last 8 at this level, including twice at the venue, latterly a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class E a fortnight ago. Not ideally-drawn but should nevertheless make this his own
- **9. GOOD DREAM -** Sanctioned, when friendless, in a 2100m Vincennes claimer last week, and will again have few takers
- **10. GOHAKI -** Facile winner of a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F 9 days ago. Has excellent form at this level when barefoot and looks a realistic podium prospect
- **11. HOLLYWOOD TORINO -** Surprisingly-reassuring 5th of 16 in a Class E over course and distance late last month. Has otherwise little love for Enghien but, in this field, can make his presence felt
- **12. GENIALE STAR -** Very disappointing since leaving Corsica, latterly 10th of 14 in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on Monday, and backs up with no realistic chance
- **13. FURIOSO DREAM -** Ran 6th of 18 in a 2675m Cherbourg claimer earlier this month. Hind shoes off this time but still not a very attractive proposition
- **14. GALWAY DU VIVIER -** Failed to confirm his September performance when last of 11 in a 2900m Amiens Class F 12 days ago, and the draw only compounds matters
- **15. FIZZ SAINT GERMAIN -** Showed improvement when 4th of 12 in a 2800m amateurs Class H at Villedieu-les-Poëles mid-September. Takes on a better lot this time though and has pulled a tough draw
- **16. FRICHTI -** 4th to HELECHO (2) a month ago before finishing last but one in a 2700m Class D at La Capelle earlier this month. Handed a tough draw, sports just front pads, but must still be taken seriously

Summary: A veritable metronome in the amateur division, IQUITO PLANCHETTE (8) is forced to break wide but excels at Enghien and Pauline Cavanie knows him well. She will still be keeping a close eye on the reconfigured HELECHO (2) who had his measure across town a month ago, and the fine GOHAKI (10) who got straight down to business after his spell. Also reconfigured, HORSERIS (3) enjoys a good spot behind the car and current condition augurs well for his chances.
