C1 - PRIX CHALDAEA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class B Race - Mounted - EUR € 52,000

- **1. LA STORIA DE LOU -** Alexandre Abrivard partners this filly (by Excellent out of Bellissima De Lou) on debut for trainer/owner Laurent-Claude Abrivard. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **2. LILY GINYU** Disqualified on debut and soundly beaten (unplaced) in 3 subsequent outings all 4 starts in the harness category, the latest (9th) over 2850m at Laval. Best watched for now switched to the mounted code
- **3. LOZEN DE BANVILLE -** Disqualified in 4 of 7 appearances, all in the harness category the latest over 2100m at this venue earlier in the month (11 June) but showed enough when avoiding disqualification to warrant respect in her first start under the saddle
- **4. LOBELIE DE GODREL -** Has made significant progress in two starts with this shoe fitting confirmed the improvement of her 2nd at Laval last month with an encouraging 3rd over 2175m in her Vincennes debut on 21 May. Keep safe

Summary: LOVELY CHENEVIERE (8) proved a tricky customer on several occasions earlier this year - disqualified in 5 (three harness; two mounted) of her first 7 starts) but has significantly improved her form and application/efficiency since reverting to this code in her last 3 outings. She has finished 2nd in both starts with this shoe fitting and needs only to perform to the level she did on this course last time to open her account. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER (7) has sound references under these conditions (at this level and venue) and should make life difficult for the selection. LOBELIE DE GODREL (4) and newcomer LA STORIA DE LOU (1) complete the shortlist.

- 2. JET DE CANVILLE Has made no impression in each of his 8 outings this year, the latest (disqualified) at Arras over 2900m on 9 June
- **3. JIPSY ROYALE -** Proven performer in the claiming category and shouldn't be hastily condemned for her last-start faux pas (disgualification) over 3035m at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains on 2 June
- **4. JOMOLUNGMA -** Finished 2nd at Orléans on her reappearance in April but has lost her way since and was disqualified in 2 consecutive recent outings the latest at Reims over 2500m on 2 June
- **5. JUMANJI BLEU -** Unreliable but has sound references, including a victory, in the claiming category. Finished 12th (shod) at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 9 June but ought to fare better here racing fully unshod

- **3. LABEL DE TILLARD -** Delicate colt, disqualified in 4 of his 6 appearances, but did finish 3rd in his only completed outing under the saddle. Dark horse
- **4. LOUXOR DE JOUB -** Progressive last-start scorer who bounced back from his previous start (disqualification) with a win overt 2450m at Caen on 29 May
- 5. LEON DU CLOS Has revealed obvious means/ability in 4 appearances, all under the saddle the latest (3rd) at this venue over 2850m on 4 June
- **6. LANCELOT PLATANES -** Caught the eye when finishing 4th at this venue over 2850m in his first appearance under the saddle on 4 June. Open to improvement
- 7. LOVE D'AUTHISE Last-start winner who improved in this (plated) shoe fitting to open his account over 2175m at this venue on 15 May. Keep safe

- **4. KANELLE DE TILLARD -** Consistent filly with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 30 May. On the shortlist

- 2. FAVORI JET Sparked signs of improvement when finishing 6th over 2800m at Pontchâteau on 6 June. More needed here
- **3. FANTOMAS DU VAL -** Consistent veteran trotter in the harness category but lacks references under the saddle. Finished 6th in a 2200m harness race at Caen on 10 June
- **4. HAMISH** Boasts proven form references/credentials under the saddle and in this (barefoot) configuration. Showed his form and well-being with a good 4th over 2800m at Pontchâteau on 6 June

- 2. LOUIS VITTON MIJO Has revealed considerable ability in his 3 completed races (4 starts), finishing 2nd on each occasion the latest at Nantes over 2275m on 9 May
- **3. LONDON JONES -** Opened his account at just the second attempt over 2625m at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle last month and confirmed that improvement by finishing 3rd over 27600m at this venue on 14 May. One to beat
- **4. LOUISDOR DECHAMBOU -** Disqualified in 3 of his 5 appearances but did win both completed races during April. Not taken lightly despite his latest sanction at Beaumont on 25 May

- **2. LIBERTY PAT -** Eye-catching debut winner over 2850m at Maure-de-Bretagne on 4 June. Would've gained from that experience so is likely to improve could be worth following
- **3. LOUISIANE KAT -** Blotted her copybook when disqualified over 2200m at this venue on 11 June but has revealed sufficient means to play a leading role in a race of this nature, if remaining wise. Question of wisdom
- **4. LISA MONA BLUE -** Has got back on the right track recently and confirmed as much by finishing 4th over 2850m at Laval on 5 June. Place chance
- **5. LA ISLA BONITA -** Tricky customer (disqualified in 2 of 5 appearances) but has the means to make her presence felt if bouncing back from a disappointing last start (13th) at Enghien over 2150m on 2 May

- **3. HUMBERSTON -** Returned to form with an encouraging 3rd over 2700m at Graignes on 13 June in his first unshod outing. Could confirm that improvement racing fully unshod once more
- **4. IVORINO D'ECHAL** Disqualified in each of his last 5 starts and hasn't been seen since the latest of those on 6 December over 2700m at this venue. Best watched for now
- **5. IMOKO DU BOUILLON -** Veresatilke trotter with references in both codes, which include finishing 2nd in consecutive recent starts. Runner-up in a 2825m amateur harness race over at Sablé-sur-Sarthe on 9 June

- 7. HERMES DU CHATAULT Consistent performer whose competitiveness at this level and on this course is beyond doubt finished 3rd in a similar contest over track and trip on 17 May. Keep safe
- **8. HARPAGOS RULES -** Last-start winner of a similar course-and-distance event on 4 June. Need only confirm that improvement to win again
- **9. HENRIETT D'AURCY -** Unfavorably positioned at the start but has proven form references/credentials at this level. Candidate for success after an encouraging last-start 4th over 2800m at Rambouillet on 9 June
- **10. HELECHO -** Capable veteran mare with sound references at this venue and at a higher level. Warrants respect on his return to this category after finishing a respectable 8th on this course over 2175m on 8 June
- **11. FRICHTI -** Well-performed veteran with references at a higher level but has lost his way since winning at Saint-Omer in October last year. Disqualified in his latest outing at Mauquenchy on 9 June

HENRIETT D'AURCY (9) has nothing to prove in this grade and returns to Vincennes with legitimate aspirations of fighting for victory. HERMES DU CHATAULT (7), who was 3rd at this level recently, HELECHO (10) and ICK DU VIVIER (1) are contenders for the remaining podium berth.
