- **1. FLOCON MONTJEANAIS -** Confirmed his Ploërmel performance when 4th of 9 in an 1800m Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago. Unlikely to win this but is still capable of getting a look-in
- **2. HUNADORA -** Returns to the amateur division after finishing last of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E late last month. Is proven in the category, well-positioned behind the car, and with front pads fitted for the occasion, can pick up a cheque
- **3. GINGER DE BRASSE -** Reassuring 5th of 10 in a 2850m Class E at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne late last month but already looks out of her depth
- **4. EMIR SPEEDHYCAT -** Sanctioned in 3 before coming last of 9 in a 2725m Grenade-sur-Garonne amateurs Class G mid-August and can expect to remain friendless
- **5. GIAC JOLI -** Switches to the amateur division after finishing 7th of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes claimer a fortnight ago and, in spite of a good draw, still looks an outsider
- **6. HOPE YOU CAN -** 3rd of 14 in a 2725m Evreux Class H on 1 September. Is proven under these conditions and, from the front row, can make a big splash
- **7. FILOU DE PAM -** 4th of 14, a place behind HOPE YOU CAN (6), in a 2725m Evreux Class H on 1 September. Seldom disappoints in the amateur division and will have his chances
- **8. FASHION DE VAL -** Last but one in a 3100m monté Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre on 1 September. Has won twice at this level but faces a much stiffer test on this occasion
- **9. FRANKLIN STAR -** Disappointing 8th of 9 in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago. Has otherwise been in excellent shape and is not to be overlooked
- **10. FEAR FACTOR -** 2nd of 12 in a 2925m Dozulé amateurs Class H mid-August. Takes on a better bunch this time though and chances limited
- **11. HEMILIO PIERJI -** Won at Laval before coming 4th of 14 in a 2950m Le Mans amateurs Class F a week ago. Has never delivered here but is in excellent condition and must be taken seriously
- **12. FEE D'AMARO -** Unexceptional mare that finished 7th of 14 in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 10 days ago and has no possible chance
- **13. HARPIE DE JED -** Took some time to come to hand this summer but ran 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2650m Class G at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 12 August. Takes a dip in category and, in similar form, will be competitive for a place on the podium
- **14. HAPPY HERO -** Easy winner of a 2900m Amiens amateurs Class G 11 days ago. Has never been beaten with Nicolas Post reining and despite the difficult draw, still looks the horse to beat
- **15. HOPE -** Sanctioned in a 2150m Cagnes Class F 3.5 weeks ago. Out of the picture in last 3 and is not about to cause an upset

16. GALTON SAINT BAR - Unremarkable 5th of 8 in a 1609m Argentan Class F early last month. Seldom lets the side down in this category but the draw will do him no favours

Summary: In his element in the amateur category, and winner of his last 5 at this level, HAPPY HERO (14) has not pulled the best of draws but he excels with his driver of the day and should garner the lion's share of support. They will be opposed though by the reconfigured front-line-starter HOPE YOU CAN (6) who is clearly close to his race. - **3. LION DE BEAUMEE -** Sanctioned in both starts to date, most recently Châteaubriant race of reference. Front pads fitted this time but others still easier to trust
- **4. LOTUS BLEU -** Qualified respectably earlier in the year but faulted in a 2725m Evreux Class H on 1 September, first time out, and can be passed over
- **5. LITTLE GANGSTER -** Yet to show any aptitude for the game, most recently sanctioned, when unsupported, in a 2400m Châteaubriant Class F 10 days ago, and will have little to offer

Summary: Simply terrific since the start of the year, which includes 3 wins over course and distance, IVOIRE DU CEDRE (9) is shod to preference for his return to the venue and should logically make it 7 on the trot. Leading the opposition is INITIALE LILA (5) who has won 2 of her last 3, and HAND DES ELIES (7) who has done little to disappoint this summer. A good, consistent crusader, GAROU BEJI (4) has never won at the venue but is barefoot for the occasion and his recent Vincennes effort bodes well for his prospects.

- **1. HAPPY DE LA COTE** Disappointing in last 2, most recently 10th of 16 in a 2550m Dieppe Class F, on 2 September. Hind shoes off though and it is only a question of time before he gets back in the game
- 2. HIBISCUS DE LATOM Quality element that can be considered unlucky for faulting in a 2800m Vire Class F a fortnight ago, and Alexis Collette will be loathe to let the same thing happen again. Claim
- **3. HAURORE -** Good, consistent mare that finished 4th of 12, behind GENTLEMAN PIYA (7), in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 2 September. Unlikely to shake things up but can still finish in the mix
- **4. GALINETTE BLEUE -** Enjoyed a rich vein of form before losing her way. 9th of 15 in a 2950m Vichy Class E 3 weeks ago and, despite the good draw, will have little to contribute
- **5. HAS DE CAMBES -** Pleased at Le Mont-Saint-Michel before finishing 10th of 13, behind HOTEL MYSTIC (14), in a 2500m Reims Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that though, has won here this year, and must be respected
- **6. HARDY DES LANDES -** Sanctioned in a 2650m Alençon Class D earlier this month. Has done nothing of note for some time and is not about to change his ways
- **7. GENTLEMAN PIYA -** In the frame in 2 of last 3, latterly 3rd of 12 in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 2 September. Starts in front, has won twice at the venue, and in current form is very hard to ignore
- **8. HISTORIC DAY -** Has not put a foot wrong since the spring, most recently 3rd, a place behind HOTEL MYSTIC (14) in a 2500m Reims Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Debuts at the venue, and starts wide, but still looks a contender
- **9. HESCORT LOVE -** Has 3 conditioners under his belt, latterly 9th of 12 in a 2700m Graignes Class F 3 weeks ago. Races barefoot for first objective of the season and, confirmed at the venue, will have his chances
- **10. GRAHIKA -** Surprisingly sanctioned in a 2850m Carentan Class F mid-August. Is clearly in form but races shod and will have other priorities
- **11. HELIOS D'EURVAD -** Surprise 2nd of 14 in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 10 days ago, but a repeat seems rather unlikely
- **12. HARABICA -** Steps up in category after being sanctioned in a 2625m amateurs Class H at Saint-Jean-de-Monts 11 days ago and can be confidently passed over
- **13. GLAMOUR YOMA -** Produced a brace of good efforts before finishing a modest 10th of 12 in a 2400m Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne last week and other options available
- **14. HOTEL MYSTIC** 2nd of 13 in a 2500m Reims Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Won his only start at the venue and, barefoot this time, will be no easy touch
- **15. HAKIM DES CHAMPS -** Sanctioned in last 3, most recently on comeback in a 2800m Vire Class F 2 weeks ago. Is not devoid of ability but others still easier to trust

16. GROUPIE DU QUENNE - 8th of 12 behind GENTLEMAN PIYA (7) in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 2 September and the draw only compounds matters

Summary: Already twice a winner this summer, HIBISCUS DE LATOM (2) would have finished close last time had he not faulted; he reverts to a proven configuration and, with application, can make this his own. Alexis Collette will still be justifiably wary of HESCORT LOVE (9) who is barefoot and entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, and the less-favourably-drawn HOTEL MYSTIC (14) who has finished runner-up in 3 of his last 4. HISTORIC DAY (8) finished 3rd to him at Reims and will be shod to preference for the occasion.
