- **3. BIENNE -** A regular in Parisian handicaps and has acquitted herself well in defeat recently finished 4th in 1100m Chantilly handicap on 3 October. Keep safe

- **8. CREMA CATALANA -** Made no impression on debut (last of 8) at Pompadour before finishing 4th in a 1600m turf claimer at Royan on 15 September. Others preferred
- **9. QUIET WIFE -** Belied her inexperience to finish an encouraging 4th on debut at Tarbes over 1500m on 23 September and should have more to offer. Winning chance

FUSEE DE PORCHE (1), after an eye-catching 4th at Tarbes recently, has the form and experience to challenge those rivals, with the shortlist completed by last-start winner MARVELOUS BY NIGHT (10) and improving KIM WHITE (12).

- **2. SHANGRI LA -** Consistent performer in Spain and didn't go unnoticed when last seen on French soil, finishing 4th in a 1900m handicap at La Test on 28 July. Attractive outsider
- **3. ODIN -** Honest hard-knocking handicapper with sound references/form credentials. Ran well in defeat (6th) at Dax over 1200m 29 September dark horse
- **4. UNTITLED -** Soundly beaten/unplaced in both recent comeback appearances, the latest (10th) over 1200m at Dax on 29 September. Others preferred
- **5. LA FIBRE -** Inconsistent performer on turf (since May) but is efficient on PSF and has sound references over course and distance in handicaps of this nature. Respected despite finishing 8th at Royan on 15 September
- **6. SUPER CUTE -** Unreliable but has sound references in handicaps at this level/venue, including several 1600m wins on this track, albeit with blinkers fitted. Reassured when 5th in a 1600m Toulouse handicap 25 September
- **7. BEYOND MY DREAMS -** Soundly beaten in both comeback outings last month after a 16-week absence, the latest (12th) over 1200m at Dax on 29 September. Others preferred
- **8. MALLORCA SUN -** Out of sorts at present but will appreciate reverting to PSF and should fare better as a result. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his failure (13th) over 2100m on turf at Dax on 7 September keep safe

Summary: RICHMOND (9) caught the eye several times last winter on this course and recent performances/results on the turf aren't a true reflection of his ability, so it could be worth siding with him on his return to this surface for the first time since March. MALLORCA SUN (8), another PSF returnee, is dangerous off a reduced mark and could threaten the selection. LA FIBER (5), at ease on this track, and SUPER CUTE (6), even without blinkers in which she is most effective, have podium aspirations.

- 2. KATALINA Unreliable but boasts sound references in handicaps at this level/venue and retains sufficient means. Confirmed as much by finishing 2nd in a 1200m turf claimer at La Test on 30 August needs to confirm
- **3. ARFAN -** Soundly beaten (unplaced) in both handicap appearances, albeit off a higher mark on both occasions. Finished 4th at Cavaillon in a 1600m conditions race on 22 September dropped another 1kg, beware
- **4. LOUIS SKI -** Inconsistent but undeniably capable handicapper. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th in a 1600m Toulouse handicap on 25 September and shouldn't be underestimated off a career-low mark
- **5. ITALO -** A model of consistency in handicaps, especially on the PSF never worse than 3rd in 6 outings at Pau. Runner-up in a 1600m turf handicap at La Teste on 30 August and will prove hard to beat here

- **8. RAFALE -** Rarely seen on PSF and has struggled in the handicap category, albeit off considerably higher marks. Dropped another 1m5kg after finishing 6th in a 1400m turf claimer at Dax on 8 July watch for now

- **14. YSSINGEAUX -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 2nd in a 1600m turf claimer at Pompadour on 20 July. Absent since so is best watched for now

- **15. JELIEL -** Has regained momentum after 2 pleasing comeback/handicap appearances off this mark finished 4th in both, the latest on turf at Compiegne over 1400m on 25 September. Attractive outsider, even on PSF
- **16. VIRIMOON ETOILE -** Continues to blow hot and cold but her efficiency/competitiveness in handicaps at this track is beyond doubt. Caught the eye when a reassuring 3rd over 1900m at Cazaubon-Barbotan on 30 September

Summary: ITALO (5) finished on the podium in all 6 visits to this course, albeit over further. That experience stands him in good stead and he gets the nod in the 'Lucky Last' ahead of FULL GAIN (1) whose aptitude for this track is also not in question. ARFAN (3), judged on his best references and racing off a lower mark, and VIRIMOON ETOILE (16), dropped to a dangerous rating with the benefit of an apprentice allowance, appeal most of the remainder.
