1. EOLE DU PRIEURE - Thrashed on comeback in a 2825m Vire Class E on 3 March. 4 pads fitted and will have nothing to offer

2. IDOLE OF LOVE - Won 6 from 7 before being sent for a break. 6th of 11 in a 2650m Bordeaux Class C on comeback, but is barefoot this time around and, from the front row, can figure prominently

3. HEXODE DE FELLIERE - Steps up in category after trotting 2nd in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago. Unlikely to impose but can still pick up a first-5 cheque

4. GAI MATIN - Going decently when sanctioned in a 2900m Amiens Class F 2 weeks ago. Raffin reining this time but others still preferred

5. FLOCON DIGEO - Evidently capable but struggling of late, latterly 10th of 18, behind GAMIN DE MAHEY (7), in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E on 27 February and is unlikely to make his presence felt

6. HOCHE - 8th of 15, on his return to competition, in a 2850m Laval Class E last week. Is barefoot for his first objective of the new year and can bring home the bacon

7. GAMIN DE MAHEY - Got back in the game when 3rd of 18 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 3 weeks ago. Lebourgeois takes over in the wagon and will be competitive for a place in the frame

8. FAUBOURG DU PERCHE - Returns to the harness code after faulting in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D last week. Ideally-engaged but still not easy to like

9. HERADAMES - Sanctioned on comeback in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 2 March. Will have come on for the run and, even from the 2nd row, will be no soft touch if David Thomain keeps him trotting

10. GRAAL DU TRESOR - Classy trotter making his first appearance since finishing 5th in a 2850m Vincennes Class B mid-December. Just front pads fitted and not an obvious choice this time around

11. EMENCOURT D'AZIF - Never at his ease when sanctioned in a 2825m Croisé-Laroche Class D 11 days ago. Shoes back on and will have other priorities

12. HALICIA BELLA - 7th of 15 in a 28235m Cordemais Class D earlier this month when still being conditioned. Shoes on again and can be ruled out

13. FUNKY D'ALB - Decent, but beaten, 4th in a 2825m Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche 11 days ago, but a repeat seems improbable

14. GAZ D'OCCAGNES - Failed to confirm his Toulouse victory after faulting in a 2850m Vincennes Class D mid-December. Has not been seen out since and will need the run

15. INVICTUS MADIBA - Excellent since back from his break, most recently trotting 2nd in a 2450m Caen Class D earlier in the month, and can expect to be well-supported. Claim

16. FALCO DES ROCHERS - Sanctioned when going respectably in a 2900m Amiens Gr.3 a fortnight ago. Drops back in class, sports front pads this time, but still no more than a minor place chance

Summary: A veritable steamroller when barefoot and focused, HOCHE (6) starts on the front row and, if fully-fit, can make this his own. He will be opposed by the in-form, and unshod-in-front, INVICTUS MADIBA (15) who has been knocking at the door lately, and who has the capacity to defy the handicap. GAMIN DE MAHEY (7) produced an excellent effort at Mauquenchy 3 weeks ago and, in similar form, can again make the frame. HERADAMES (9) has nothing to prove at this level and, with fine right-handed references, must be considered a player.

3. JESABELLE DU JOUR - Sprang a pleasant surprise when securing a 2800m Cholet Class F on 3 March. Unbeaten with Lebourgeois reining and, from the front row, can play a leading role

4. JULIANA BREIL - 5th of 8 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F on 18 February. Front shoes off this time but still looks out of her depth

5. JAINA D'ESSARTS - Delicate mare making her first appearance since winning a 3125m Granville Class F last August. Breaks from the front but stays shod for comeback and best to hold off

6. JAM DES LANDES - 7th of 11 in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago. Shoes off this time but others still easier to back

7. JETHAN DE MONGOCHY - Makes his first appearance since coming 9th of 10 in a 2550m Reims Class E late-October and will need the run

8. JERRY DE BELLANDE - 9th of 15 in a 2550m Reims Class E on 25 February, first start back. Is barefoot this time and, from the front row, can give this a good go

9. JACKPOT BOOSTER - Has taken particularly well to racing barefoot, latterly 3rd of 11 in a 2600m Nancy Class D 10 days ago. Benefits from a good entry and should be capable of making the first 5

10. JOY D'OURVILLE - Unseen since finishing last of 10 in a 2850m Vincennes Class E last November and, from the 2nd row, has no realistic chance

15. JASMINE DE GREZ - Sanctioned in a 2450m Caen Class E 9 days ago. Is plainly in excellent condition though and, on good behaviour, can win this from the 2nd line

16. JOUR D'ERABLE - Sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Class D a month back. Has had time to freshen up, is confirmed right-handed, and will be dangerous if David Thomain keeps him trotting

Summary: JASMINE DE GREZ (15) has been struggling to express her form lately but has nonetheless been catching the eye. She left a good impression on her lone start at the venue and, with application, can finally get that maiden monkey off her back. Guillaume Martin will still be keeping a keen eye on the fine JAVADA DU MONT (14) who has won her last 2 right-handed starts. Recent Cholet winner, JESABELLE DU JOUR (3) has a 25m head-start, is barefoot for the occasion, and is reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois who won with her last October. JOUR D'ERABLE (16) has been in cracking form for some months and will not be going home empty-handed, provided he stays in stride.

2. LATITUDE CASTELETS - Put on a good show first time out, when 4th in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 4 March. Gelormini maintains faith and could pleasantly surprise on her right-handed debut

3. LOUNA LA TRIGALE - Surprise 3rd of 10, at 36/1, in a 2275m Nantes Class F a month back. Unlikely to repeat but the Paul Ploquin-factor cannot be ignored

4. LADY DE CORDAY - Capable filly that was sanctioned in a 2550m Reims Class F on 25 February. Hind pads fitted this time but still looks to be biting off more than she can chew

5. LORIANA - Met all kinds of problems when disqualified in a 2450m Caen Class F a fortnight ago, but is a decent trotter in the making and could well have her way if Nivard manages to keep her out of trouble

6. LOTTA LOVE - 9th of 11 on re-entry in a 2450m Caen Class F 2 weeks ago. David Thomain at the helm this time but others still preferred

7. LOLA DU CAMPUS - Has not been seen out since coming 3rd in a 2000m Class F at La Capelle early-November. Eric Raffin drafted in for comeback and must be respected

8. LOUVE DE BAIS - Qualified nicely before trotting 2nd in a 2050m Lyon-La Soie Class F on her 6 February debut. Will have progressed and, even though drawn wide, she will be entrusted to Matthieu Abrivard. Place prospect

3. IMA DU CANET - Unremarkable 8th of 16 in a 2900m Challans Class F late last month and once again appears to be out of her depth

4. IZARA DE CALVI - 13th of 15 in a 2825m Durtal harness Class F on 10 March. Sanctioned on lone monté start and is unlikely to influence the outcome

5. IT'S ME DIESCHOOT - Flattering 4th of 7 finishers in a 2750m Class G at La Capelle 10 days ago and, in this company, will struggle to make his mark

6. JASMIN DE CANCHY - Sanctioned, when joint-favourite, in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago after having won smartly at Challans, and the new shoeing formula can get him right back on track

7. JASMINE DE LYONS - Put 3 straight sanctions behind her when winning a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago, and on similarly good behaviour, can repeat

8. INDIANA D'AMOUR - Encouraging, but never threatening, 4th in a 2850m Class F on monté debut early-February. Takes on some serious horses this time and will have few takers

9. JUST PACHA - Serious sort the came 3rd of 12 in a 2800m Pontchâteau Class E 12 days ago. Seldom lets the side down and is a legitimate candidate for success

10. INAYA DE NILREM - 5th, behind IROISE DE LAVAU (11), in a 2825m Durtal harness Class F a week ago, after having imposed at Saumur. Goes barefoot for the first time and, although not a priority, he will be ridden by Paul Ploquin and must not be overlooked

11. IROISE DE LAVAU - 3rd of 15 in a 2825m Durtal harness Class F, when being conditioned, last week. In better company this time but should be able to hold her own

3. KING MOKO - Finished 5th in a 2700m Cagnes Class C early-February before being disqualified in the stewards' room. Has ample ability though and can pick up a cheque if he stays in stride

4. KANKAN - 8th in the 25 February race of reference. Stays shod and will have other priorities

5. KEEP SECRET - Fantastic winner of a 2875m Enghien Class D early-October. Has not been seen out since though and is unlikely to be given a hard race

6. KUSAERI - Has not been seen out since flopping in a 2700m Graignes Class B mid-October. Will be race-rusty and going shod will do him no favours

7. KORA DE BLARY - Moderate filly starting for the first time since coming 6th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D mid-November and is sure to need the outing

8. KITALIANO ALGREF - 6th, a place behind KASH SNIPER (10), on comeback in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 25 February. Will have come on for the run and, if race-fit, can play a leading role

3. KIRA DE CAHOT - Faithful filly that reassured when 2nd in a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class E on 25 February. Trotted 2nd for Lebourgeois on her last start here and is ideally-positioned to bring the fight to KOSANOSTRA (2)

4. KALINE DJOB - 7th in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a month ago. Returns to a proven configuration and, from the 3-spot, will be no soft touch

5. KALINA STAR - Steps back up in class after finishing a close 2nd in a 2100m Vincennes claimer late-November. Will be a race shy though and others preferred

6. KANDICE DU LOISIR - Sent for a break after trotting 7th of 10 finishers in a 2175m Vincennes Class D late-November. Is first-time barefoot for comeback and not incapable of getting straight back in the game

7. KENZA D'AMOUR - Well-backed but faulted early in a 2875m Enghien Class D last week. Produced an excellent effort on only start here though and is worth keeping an eye on

8. KISS ME DE BELFOND - Clear 3rd of 11 in a 2550m Bordeaux Class E last Saturday. Reliability not her strong suit but Matthieu Abrivard reining this time and will be afforded every chance

9. KISSABELLA - Starts for the first time since faulting in a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 8 January. Won under these conditions during the autumn, makes first start for new trainer, and should not be underestimated

10. KLARA - Progressive filly making her first start since coming 3rd in a 2700m Vincennes Class D late-August. Shod for re-entry and best to wait

11. KADIJA MESLOISE - Made it 3 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2150m Cagnes Class E on 2 March. Has ability in abundance however, has twice won when shod and, even from the back line, deserves to be taken seriously

12. KARELIA - Solid 2nd in a 2850m Laval Class E 3 weeks ago. Shoes back on though and the draw only compounds matters

13. KANELLE DU VAL - Makes first appearance since trotting 3rd of 9 in a 2175m Vincennes monté Class D in early-December and, even racing with front shoes off, will have few friends

14. KEYPTOWN - Unraced since coming 9th of 14 in a 2150m Enghien Class C last October. Has merit but will be race-rusty. Hold back

Summary: Delicate she may be but KOSANOSTRA (2) is a decent filly with a promising future and can march off with the silverware if Eric Raffin keeps her trotting. Confirmed at Lisieux and clearly in excellent shape, KIRA DE CAHOT (3) starts upsides and is unlikely to disappoint. Arguably trickier than the favourite, KADIJA MESLOISE (11) returns to racing shod and will be dangerous if she stays in stride. KALINE DJOB (4) is better than recent form would suggest and the change of shoeing should prove just the ticket to her redemption.

2. FOLLOW ME DU LUOT - 7th to IMPALA DE VAL (3) in a 2450m Caen Class F 2 weeks ago. Boasts a good Lisieux record though, and breaks from the front, but in this company may struggle to make his mark

3. IMPALA DE VAL - Has won 2 of 3 since starting to race without hind shoes, latterly with authority over 2450m in a Caen Class F a fortnight ago. Takes on marginally better this time but still looks up to the task

4. FAKIR GASCON - Unraced since flopping 9th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D last September. Is not entirely without ability but appears to have too much to do

5. IMAGINE D'ATOUT - Excellent all winter, latterly missing out by little in a 2650m Bordeaux Class C. Excels racing right-handed and makes her Lisieux debut with a realistic chance of imposing

6. FAUST DE BEYLEV - Trotted 5th behind GENIE DES LUCAS (9) before being sanctioned early in a 2875m Enghien Class D 8 days ago. Seldom disappoints when focused and, with application, should be able to finish in the mix

7. FRANKY SATYNE - Returns to the monté code after faulting early in a 2825m Cordemais Class D on 1 March and is unlikely to garner much support

8. ELIXIR - Has not been seen out since coming 7th in a Class E over course and distance last October. Twice a winner here, is barefoot for re-entry, and looks an interesting outside chance

9. GENIE DES LUCAS - Drops in category after trotting 3rd in a 2175m Vincennes Class D on 1 March. Mathieu Mottier could not have asked for a better entry and will be out to capitalise. Chance

4. ISYBOY DE CINGLAIS - Gave a fine account to trot 4th in a 2450m Caen Class D on 4 March. Will be fully-fit by now and, from the 4-spot, can win this

5. GOGO DES MALBERAUX - Fine servant making his first appearance since coming 2nd in a 2700m Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche mid-December. Shoes on but has a good spot in front and can get a look-in

6. HAMILTON FIRST - Tough character but has not been seen out since finishing unplaced in a 2550m Reims Class E on 3 December, and will need the race

7. IMPARTIAL - Won a 3rd straight clockwise start when securing a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class E on 25 February. Not ideally-positioned but must still be considered a leading contender

8. ISEULT FLOWER - An absolute revelation since returning to racing barefoot, most recently a facile winner of a 2875m Argentan Class F on 18 February. Handed a tough draw but should nevertheless figure prominently

9. FREEDOM (NOR) - Quality nordic import that has taken superbly to both French conditions and racing right-handed. 2nd in a 2625m Agen-Le Passage Class D on 12 February and, even though starting on the back row, can make a big splash

10. G.K.JUSTUS - Flattering 7th of 9 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes Class C earlier this month but is clearly better than that and despite the 2nd row draw, still looks a player

11. NYMKE BRIGADOON - Returns to the harness code after 3 straight sanctions, latterly a 2850m Laval monté Class E, and could pleasantly surprise

12. GARDEN OF MEMORY - No slouch on a good day but makes first public appearance since finishing 11th of 12 in a 2700m Segré Class F last October and can be passed over

13. AXIS DI GIRIFALCO - Yet to achieve the level expected of him since leaving Italy, latterly 13th of 14 in a 2875m Enghien Class E on 8 March, and even with Gelormini reining is unlikely to shake things up

14. HISTOIRE THORIS - Unplaced in a 2200m Caen Class D on comeback 9 days ago. Shoes on and will pose no danger

15. ICARE DES VALOIS - Unraced since coming in last but one in a 2100m Vincennes Class B late-September and will not be given a hard race

The Norwegian FREEDOM (NOR) (9) has not put a foot wrong since coming to France and reverts to racing with front pads fitted. Winner of 3 of his last 4, IMPARTIAL (7) is forced to start wide but in current form is difficult to ignore. G.K.JUSTUS (10) is reunited with Pierre-Yves Verva who won with him in Paris, and will be no pushover.
