- **2. WHAT A FAIR FOOT -** Holding her form well and was third last time out in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 6 July. Can contest the finish gain
- **3. LOU MARINA -** Yet to win a race but is very consistent and was third again last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 2 July. Be right there at the finish once again
