- **1. LAQUILA WOOD -** Moves to the monté discipline after 2 straight sanctions, latterly in a 2750m Class F at La Ferté-Vidame early last month. 4 pads fitted this time but still not an obvious choice
- **2. LITTLELOU MATIDY -** Would have finished in the money had she not faulted in the final stages of a 2175m Vincennes Class D 12 days ago. Hails from a yard firing on all cylinders and is very much in the running for a spot on the podium
- **3. LIVIA DES LANDES -** Yet to show much aptitude for either code, most recently sanctioned in a 2300m Bernay Class E 4 weeks ago, and can be written off
- **4. LAURIANA BELLA -** Has evident talent but sanctioned in 4 of 5, latterly a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 23 August. Adrien Lamy gives her another go but others still preferred
- **5. LAHORA DES FORGES -** 5th of 9 in a 2800m Moulins harness Class F last Sunday. Yet to finish a monté race unscathed and is not about to break the mould

- **11. KEOPS DU BUHOT -** Off the boil this term despite having shown early promise, most recently 7th of 10, a place behind KATSUKI (15), in a 2100m Vincennes Class D a month back. Shoes on and no danger
- **12. KRYSTAL DU RUEL -** Did not enjoy the best of trips when sanctioned in a 2550m Cherbourg Class B a month ago. Is shod this time, has references at a superior level and, even from the 2nd line, must be respected
- **13. KART HAUFOR -** Quality element starting for first time since coming 2nd of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class D last March, and will need the run
- **14. KOUROUX -** Got back in the game at Vire earlier this month, coming 3rd of 9 in a 2800m Class E. Is clearly on the way up and has the wherewithal to fight out the finish here
- **15. KATSUKI -** Unthreatening 7th of 13 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E on 12 September. On back line again and chances limited
- **16. KANAK DU BOCAGE -** Honest sort making first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class C early-June and, shod for the occasion, will not pose a threat

- **17. KRONOS D'ERPION -** Kicked the year off well before losing his way, latterly 11th of 13, behind KATSUKI (15), in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 9 days ago, and needs to reassure
- **18. KRACKSMAN -** Unraced since winning a 2200m Vincennes monté Class D on 9 April. Has other priorities and can be passed over

Summary: A relatively open event with 2 in particular standing out, and each forced to start on the back line. KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (10) has taken his game to a new level since starting to race barefoot and is plainly close to his race. KOUROUX (14) made up at Vire for his Cabourg blip and, re-configured with Benjamin Rochard at the helm, will not go down easily. Ideally-engaged on the front line, KORIOLIS DE ZIETTE (9) may not have been seen out for 2 months but he has solid right-handed references and can get straight back in the game. Rewarded with victory last time out, KINGSTON DES HAYES (8) steps up in category and deserves to take his chances.

- **1. I LOVE JAM Modest** individual that came in 11th of 15 in a Class E at Le Touquet 3 weeks ago and can be confidently disregarded
- **2. HARABICA -** Races barefoot after finishing last of 13, when preparing for this, in a 2200m Class D here on Wednesday, and backs up with nothing to offer
- **3. ICE DREAM ROYAL** 12th of 14 in a 2525m Les Andelys claimer 3 weeks ago. Has been out of sorts since January and, even with shoes off, has no possible chance
- **4. ILLICO D'ORME -** Returns to racing unshod-behind after coming 4th of 9 in a 2450m Jarnac Class F early this month, however a repeat seems improbable
- **5. ILTON BEAUREGARD** Less sharp since imposing at Abbeville 2 months back, latterly 7th of 10 in a 2800m Tours Class F 3 weeks ago. Front pads fitted this time but others still preferred
- **6. ICARE DES HAYES -** Not the most dependable but came 3rd of 10 in a 3200m Landivisiau Class E 3 weeks ago. Takes on many better horses here and not an obvious choice this time
- **7. IDAHO D'ACADIE -** Unraced since faulting in a 2650m Avignon Class F 4 months ago and can be ruled out
- **8. ITAC DE PICDOM -** Sanctioned in 2 before finishing 7th of 10 in an 1800m Class F at La Capelle on 4 September and is is unlikely to generate much interest
- **9. INDY FOUTEAU -** 7th of 11, when preparing for this, in a 3000m Châteaubriant amateurs Class G 2 weeks ago. Races barefoot for first time this season and, from the front row, is unlikely to let the side down
- **10. ITON DES LANDES -** Oddly out of sorts when last but one in a 2550m Dieppe Class F on Wednesday. Sports a revised configuration for the occasion, is ideally-engaged, and must be afforded respect
- **11. HERCULE DE L'OISON -** 9th of 12 in a 2800m Class E at Villedieu-les-Poëles last weekend. Shoes back on and will have few takers
- **12. HORACE DU VIVIER -** Made it 5 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2750m Pornichet Class F mid-August and is not a concern
- **13. IRMINIO KILY -** 5th of 14 in a 2775m Craon Class E earlier this month. Went close last time here and, in the hands of his trainer, is not going to be far off the mark
- **14. INCA -** Comfortably won a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche 12 days ago. Pleased on lone start with Benjamin Rochard and is not incapable of confirming
- **15. HIBISCUS NORMAND -** In the frame in 3 before finishing 6th of 13 in a 2950m Vichy Class E last Saturday. 25m worse off on this occasion but at this level could pleasantly surprise
- **16. IN PETTO -** Debuts at the venue after trotting 3rd of 8 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F a month ago. Has references racing clockwise and, in this company, will have his chances
- **17. IGUAL BLUE -** Serious sort that finished a solid 3rd of 8 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F early-August. Entrusted to Lebourgeois for first time and can finally open his 2024 account

18. IDEAL DU BOUILLON - Last but one in a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago. Has otherwise been in decent shape, but has little love for the venue and a minor place chance at best

Summary: Held back for this excellent entry after a convincing performance at La Rochelle, IGUAL BLUE (17) will be reined by Yoann Lebourgeois for the occasion and, runner-up in both of his Caen excursions, he looks the pick of the lot. He will be opposed though by the rejuvenated and reconfigured INCA (14) who has already won at the venue, and IN PETTO (16) who produced a reassuringly-good performance at Cherbourg a month ago. IRMINIO KILY (13) has been acquitting himself well over recent months and his handler takes over the reins this time.
