- **1. MADE IN FIVE -** A two-year-old filly by Fighter Smart out of Bettina du Bocage who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **2. MAESTRO DE FORGAN -** A two-year-old colt by Un Charme Fou out of Algua de Forgan who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **3. MYLEY ELDE -** A two-year-old colt by Gotland out of Caline Elde who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **4. MACLANDER -** Disqualified on his debut at this course on 7 September. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **5. MOOREA DE CHANLECY -** Finished 8th on debut in Class F at this course over 2200m on 7 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. MONA D'AVRIL -** Finished 6th on her debut in Class F at Arras over 2400m on 18 August. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- **7. MYRTILLE MARBOULA -** Has not shown much so far and was 6th last time out in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 9 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: Trained by Matthieu Abrivard, MADE IN FIVE (1) has been well prepared ahead of her debut race and the betting will obviously tell us more. MY NAME IS BOND (10) finished 2nd to a subsequent winner at Vincennes last time out and lost nothing in defeat. MALDIVE DE TILLARD (9) was also a promising runner-up first time on track at Villereal and will come on a lot for the experience. MYLEY ELDE (3) is a newcomer that has qualified well for racing and should be closely monitored.

- 2. JOKER WIC Much improved of late and he has won his last two starts, with the latest being in Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre over 3100m on 15 September. Can complete the hat-trick
- **3. JACOBIN DU GOUTIER -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 September. Capable of better and could make the frame
- **4. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX -** Unreliable and was 11th last time out in Class E at Vire over 2800m on 4 September. Capable of an upset on best form
- **5. JEUDI DES RACQUES -** Has struggled of late and was 11th last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 6 September. Capable of better but others are preferred

- **2. JOYEUSE ENTREE -** At the top of her game and won for the second time in a row, with the latest being in Class F at Cabourg on 6 August. Can pull off her hat-trick
- **3. JUNON DES ROSES -** Very consistent and was third last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 23 August. Should fight out the finish yet again
- **4. JUST AN ARTIST -** Battling to regain best form and was 6th last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 13 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. JAZZ MELODY -** Disappointing recent form and was 8th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 13 September. Capable of an upset on best form

- **2. KIMBRA DJOC -** Finished 7th in a class D at Divonne-les-Bains over 2675m on 16 August. Reverts to barefoot and has been prepared for this race
- **3. KOLENA -** Finished 6th in a class E at Divonne-les-Bains over 2650m on 22 August. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- **4. KEEPSAKE MOSSA -** Disqualified in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 7 September. Unproven on right-hand tracks. Capable of improvement
- **5. KOOPLES DE LARRE -** Disqualified in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 5 September. Remains barefoot. Must be wise to have a say
- **6. KARAOKE -** Fourth in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 September. Others are preferred in this line-up

KEEPSAKE MOSSA (4) boasts good credentials but has never raced on a right-handed course before. KENZO DE CLOPEAU (7) has shown a rebound of form recently and warrants some consideration too.

- **2. LASCO D'URZY -** Finished 6th in a class E at Feurs over 2225m on 1 September. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **3. LORENZO DU SERAN -** Ran third in a class E at Feurs over 2225m on 1 September. Improved effort in the latest and must confirm that
- **4. LAUREL LA RAVELLE -** Finished 8th in a class E Harness race at Laval over 2850m on 16 September. Tackled for the first time and this should appeal to outsider pundits
- **5. LONDON BRIDGE -** Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 10 September. Better suited to the right-hander and can bounce back
- **6. LOLLIPOP STAR -** Fifth in a class E at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 18 August. Others are preferred in this line-up

LUCIFER D'ORPHEE (10) is a smart trotter but has not run since May. It would be risky to write him off though. LEADER DES RIOULTS (9) has not run a bad race in three starts in this code and has to be respected too. LONDON BRIDGE (5) is better than his last start suggests.

IMPACT DE COLMINE (6) has a lot of early speed and can go close on his return on French soil. FUNKY BERRY (5)'s last run is too bad to be true.
