- **2. KEY TO THE HIGHWAY -** Unreliable and was 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 30 October. Remains barefoot and is capable of contesting the finish
- **3. KEDEA DE GINAI -** Very consistent and was third in class D at Feurs over 2050m on 29 October. Has won on five occasions this year and is not out of it
- **4. KAROLINA DI SEMBLE -** Unreliable and was disqualified in class E at Chartres over 2825m on 4 November. Barefoot and can bounce back to score

- **3. KARABOUDJAN -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in class E at Amiens over 2400m on 15 November. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. KEEPSAKE MOSSA -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 16 November. Won well in October and is capable of being competitive once again
