# C1 - PRIX D'AMFREVILLE - 2450m (a1m 1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 18,500

- 1. LATINO BEJI Set off no fireworks in qualification last summer but if fitted with 4 pads first time out, gets a Mathieu Mottier ride, and may well prove the principal danger to LINGKO THELOIS (10)
- **2. LEOPOLD DU CLOS -** Half-brother to the progressive Kenneth Du Clos, who qualified without fanfare last November. Has been prepared for this code and can get straight down to business. Place chance
- **3. L'AS DES VENTES -** Faulted in a 2225m Vire harness Class F on 11 December. Changes code for the first time but others still preferred
- **4. LANCELOT DETOUSSAC -** Sanctioned, when unsupported, in the Caen race of reference and can again expect to remain lonely in the markets
- **5. LET'S GO BARBES -** Promising type but sanctioned in both monté starts to date, most recently the Caen race of reference. Benjamin Rochard takes over in the saddle though and will not be far off the mark if he can assure his initial strides
- **6. LOOK DES ECUS -** Disqualified in 2 harness starts, latterly a 2800m Cholet Class F on 3 March. Guillaume Martin onboard for monté debut but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- **7. LEO DE MIL** 7th of 8 finishers, at 52/1, in the Enghien race of reference. In less-exalted company this time but still has more to find
- **8. L'AS DE COEUR -** Sanctioned under the saddle last week before coming last of 7 in a harness Class E over course and distance on Monday. Just front pads fitted this time but is still biting off more than she can chew
- **9. LOVE CHASER -** Left a good impression when 4th of 9 finishers, on monté debut, in a Class F over course and distance a week ago. Returns to the venue, with morale intact, and can play a more prominent role
- **10. LINGKO THELOIS -** Trotted 5th of 8 finishers in a 2250m Enghien Class D on 8 March, first time out. Is clearly better than that and, given the company, looks a leading proposition
- **11. LAST KINGDOM** Sanctioned in a 2250m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago. Takes a big dip in category and, on good behaviour, should be able to make his presence felt

**Summary:** Full-brother to Ginkgo Thelois, LINGKO THELOIS (10) will have come on for his recent Enghien debut and, in this field, has every chance of getting off the mark. Mathieu Mottier has accepted the ride on the untried, and padded, LATINO BEJI (1) which must say something about his prospects. LOVE CHASER (9) looked a different horse after switching codes last week and must be taken more seriously this time around. The well-related LEOPOLD DU CLOS (2) has been given time to come into himself and debuts under the saddle with legitimate ambition.

- **1. LA DIVINE ECUS** Qualified nicely last year but has twice failed to get around unscathed, latterly in a 2300m Argentan Class F last month. Fitted with front pads this time and can make a big splash if Lebourgeois keeps her trotting
- **2. LADY DE GREZ -** Unplaced, on re-entry behind LADOTA PRIOR (13), in a Class F over course and distance a fortnight ago. Has a lot of ground to make up and is not about to influence the outcome
- **3. LOVELY CHENEVIERE** Difficult character that failed for the 3rd time in a row to stay in stride, most recently in a 2825m Cordemais Class F 3 weeks ago. Front pads fitted this time but others still preferred
- **4. LILY DE L'AUNAY -** Acquitted herself well, although sanctioned, in a 2150m Vire Class E on 3 March. Is still somewhat green but will be competitive if more manageable this time
- **5. LADY DE FOUQUE -** Sanctioned, for the 3rd time in a row, in a Class E over course and distance 10 days ago. Has evident talent, sports pads this time, and can begin to redeem herself
- **6. LORINEA CUT -** Unlucky when sanctioned in 11 March race of reference but is still not up to the task set for her this time and can be ruled out
- **7. LETTY DE BEYLEV** Would have finished in the money had she not faulted in a 2225m Mauquenchy Class E a month back. Unlikely to impose but can still make the first 5

- **10. LAGUARDA DU BOCAGE -** Quickly sanctioned in a Class E over track and trip 10 days ago. Is not without ability but others still easier to trust
- **11. LITTLETON LANDING -** Qualified in 1'16"6 at Le Mans mid-February before romping in a 2275m Nantes Class F on debut 12 days later. Is clearly a filly for the future and will be expected to confirm
- **12. LOUBIANA DU BOURG -** Qualified well last September and duly confirmed with victory in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 10 March. Has considerable untapped potential and can give LITTLETON LANDING (11) a run for her money
- **13. LADOTA PRIOR** Good 3rd of 16 in a Class F over course and distance a fortnight ago. Will not be available at 35/1 on this occasion and can even make the frame

**Summary:** Sensational on her career debut late last month, LITTLETON LANDING (11) takes on a better bunch here but is still capable of doubling her money. She will however be up against LOUBIANA DU BOURG (12) who similarly won first time out, and the tricky, but first-time padded, LA DIVINE ECUS (1) for whom Yoann Lebourgeois has been drafted in for the occasion. Well-in here, LADOTA PRIOR (13) gave a surprisingly good account of herself here 2 weeks ago and looks more a place chance this time around.

- **2. KRAC NADACA -** Well-beaten 5th of 6 in a Class F over course and distance 10 days ago and is not going to attract much support
- **3. KENNEN JIEL -** Unraced since trotting 5th in a 2200m Vichy Class D last September. Hind shoes off for re-entry and, although not a leading contender, can still claim a small slice of the pie
- **4. KAP ORNE -** Sanctioned early in a 2200m Class F here on 4 March. Has won over course and distance and will not be far from the action if his driver gets him off on the right foot
- **5. KENOBI D'HERFRAIE -** Unplaced, on his return to competition, in a 2200m Class F here on 4 March. Has a lot going for him this time and can begin to set the record straight
- **6. KEV DE JAFA -** Has not been seen out since finishing a distant 5th of 6 in a 2850m Vincennes Class C last April. Barefoot for comeback but is still going to need the run
- **7. KING OF RACE -** Unremarkable 6th of 10 in a 2550m Reims Class E last Saturday. Always gives his best though, reverts to a previous configuration and, in this small field, can make the first 5
- **8. KENZO D'EVA -** Imposed courageously on monté debut, then ran 3rd in a 2875m Enghien Class E a fortnight ago, only to be disqualified. Shod differently this time, has already won for Benjamin Rochard and can do so again
- **9. KRACKSMAN -** Going well when sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class E a fortnight ago. Similarly-shod and, with application, can challenge for the win

**Summary:** Winner at Châteaubriant on monté debut, KENZO D'EVA (8) showed his form at Enghien next time, only to be sanctioned, but sports a new configuration and is marginally preferable to the complicated, but talented, KRACKSMAN (9) who is reunited with Mathieu Mottier. KENOBI D'HERFRAIE (5) has one run under his belt, races first time barefoot and, with his mind on the game, can play a leading role. KAP ORNE (4) won over track and trip during the autumn and will be no easy touch if Alexis Collette can keep him trotting.

- 2. KASSIOPEIA Good but unthreatening 3rd in a 2850m Vincennes Class E a month back. Won her only clockwise start though, drops marginally in category, and can make this her own
- 3. KALINKA ERA Back under harness after faulting in a 2175m Vincennes monté Class D 3 weeks ago. Has merit but never easy to trust and others preferred
- **4. KACHE KACHE -** Re-surfaces 5.5 months after being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class D. Hind shoes off for reentry and, with application, can get straight back in the game
- **5. KIVAOA DU PERCHE -** Sanctioned in both return runs, latterly when going well in a Class F under these conditions a fortnight ago. Entrusted to David Thomain this time and, on good behaviour, can play a leading role
- **6. KALIKA DU CITRUS -** Last of 7 in a conditioning 2700m Graignes monté Class E on comeback mid-February. Will have come on for the run but still not an obvious choice
- 7. KANDY LIFE Last of 9, on re-entry, in a 2100m Vincennes Class E early-February, after having gone into her break on a high note. Front pads fitted on this occasion and, entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for the first time, will be afforded every chance
- **8. KISMIE DE MONTFORT -** Returns to racing clockwise after trotting 5th, behind KASSIOPEIA (2), in a 2850m Vincennes Class E on 20 February. Has previously imposed right-handed and looks competitively well-in
- **9. KILOVE DU GOUTIER -** Handy sort making her first start since trotting 4th of 13 in a 2200m Langon Class D last August and is unlikely to be given a hard race

Principal opposition will come from the ideally-positioned, but returning, KACHE KACHE (4) who has hind shoes off for the first time, and the less-favourably-drawn KISMIE DE MONTFORT (8) who nevertheless showed her form behind the favourite in Paris last month. KIVAOA DU PERCHE (5) is well-placed behind the car and will be no pushover if David Thomain keeps her trotting.

- **2. HARIBO DU SURF -** 7th of 12 in a 2500m Bihorel-lès-Rouen Class F on Sunday. Would have better prospects a level down and is not going to be troubling the judge
- **3. IDEAL D'AVENIR -** 10th of 11 finishers in a 2875m Enghien harness Class E a week ago. Seldom seen under the saddle but has bags of talent, although has yet to deliver for Romain Jajolet. Disregard
- **4. HATHAWAY -** 6th in a 2700m harness Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche on 9 March. Still chasing that elusive first monté win and, even though barefoot, will still need to hold on a little longer
- **5. HERCULE DES SABLES -** 2nd of 8 in a 2850m Laval Class F last week, continuing his productive ways. May not be cut from the same cloth as IROKO DU LOIR (7) but can still apply the pressure
- **6. HEARTBREAKER WELL -** 12th of 17 in a 2800m Cholet harness Class F on 3 March. Has excellent references when barefoot and is not incapable of opening his monté account
- **7. IROKO DU LOIR -** Faulted shortly after the start under similar conditions a fortnight ago. Has nothing to prove at this level and will be no soft touch if Alexandre Angot can keep him trotting
- **8. INVICTUS DE HOERDT -** Decent 2nd in a 2800m Strasbourg Class G on 3 March. Excels racing clockwise and could well play the role of spoiler
- **9. I LOVE D'AMOUR -** Makes his first start since coming 3rd of 8 in a 3100m Class F on turf at Nort-sur-Erdre early-September. Barefoot for re-entry, is confirmed here, and is unlikely to be far from the action
- **10. FULGURIS SEGAH -** Honest type that finished a beaten 5th of 6 finishers in a 2900m Amiens Class F 2 weeks ago. Is new to Caen, will be fitter this time, and will be one to keep an eye on

- 3. FRANKLIN STAR Has not been seen out since a disappointing 6th of 13 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class G late-November. Ideally-situated behind the car but others still preferred
- **4. GO FAST DE VAINS -** Easy winner of a 2925m Cagnes amateur Class E on 23 February. Has had time to freshen up and debuts at Caen with a solid chance of making it a winning one
- **5. FEE D'AMARO** 7th on comeback a fortnight ago in a 2900m Amiens Class F. Benefits from a good draw but has never impressed in this category and chances limited
- **6. EDISON D'EBANE -** 5th of 13 in a 2850m Laval Class G 3 weeks ago. Is well-positioned on the front line and, while unlikely to impose, can still finish in the mix
- 7. HEROS DE BONNEFOI Solid 2nd of 14 in a 2700m Graignes Class E on comeback late last month. Has never disappointed at this level and, despite the somewhat wide draw, looks the horse to beat

**Summary:** Ideally-engaged at the limit of earnings, JOB DES MOLLES (18) missed out by the smallest of margins in Paris a month back and returns to the provinces with every chance of opening his 2024 account. Benjamin Rochard will still be keeping a watchful eye on the unshodbehind JANE CASH (5) who has a 25m head-start, and second-line starter JINGLE LOVER (12) who has previously won for Yoann Lebourgeois. JACKPOT DE JUMILLY (8) showed improvement at Nantes last time out but incurs no handicap here and looks competitive for a place in the frame.
