- **4. VENES -** Inconsistent gelding whose best references on this surface were achieved at a lower level. Unplaced (15th) in a 1300m handicap on this course on 8 August
- **5. SECOND TO NONE -** A proven PSF performer with sound references. Unplaced in back-to-back turf handicaps recently at Vittel, the latest (5th) over 2400m on 12 August
- **6. LE TROPIC -** Caught the eye when 4th in the reference race on 4 August in a course-and-distance handicap. With Christophe Soumillon in the irons, his candidacy for success is undeniable
- 7. LUCI DEL FARO Made no impression when only 9th in a course-and-distance handicap recently (17 August) but she remains capable of much better finished 3rd over track and trip on 30 July. Can make amends
- **8. POLMINHAC** Unreliable handicapper whose 2 career wins were achieved over this track and trip. Bounced back to form with an encouraging last-start 5th in a course-and-distance handicap on 30 July keep safe
- **9. MARTIAL ART -** Capable hard-knocker with references at this level in PSF handicaps off higher marks. Disappointed recently only 9th over track and trip on 30 July but he shouldn't be underestimated

LE TROPIC (6) is a proven performer on this course and could make life difficult for those rivals. EXCITING (11) will appreciate the return to PSF and has the means to make his presence felt too in a race of this ilk.

- 2. SEE YOU PINK Disappointing at this level recently and soundly beaten (13th) in a 1200m claimer on this course on 1 August. Has the means to do better
- **3. ALLURRE -** Didn't go unnoticed when 6th in a 2000m Quinté+ at Lyon-Parilly in June against male opposition and has confirmed that form with a good 4th over 1800m at Aix-les-Bains on 14 July. Place chance
- **4. LA BELLE POETE -** Outfought in the latter stages, finishing 8th on this course in her first Quinte+ appearance (3 August) over 1300m. Outsider
- **5. PEACEFUL SEA -** Soundly beaten in her 2 Quinte+ appearances (both at Saint-Cloud), the latest over 1400m on 30 June could only finish 13th. Others preferred
- **6. FREJA -** Consistent mare with sound references/form credentials at this level, including a last-start 3rd over track and trip on 30 July. High on the shortlist
- **7. ALVA** Model of consistency at this level, even against male opposition. Didn't go unn noticed when 5th in a 1600m Quinte+ at Compiegne on 22 July

Summary: DIVIDE AND RULE (9) was an authoritative winner of a handicap in June and continued her momentum by finishing a good 3rd in a quality Class 2 event at Vichy, so is value for the win in her first Quinté+ appearance. FREJA (6) is also a candidate for success judged on the strength and consistency of her form, while DARI RIVER (8) is likely to fare better at this level and could play a leading role too. Consistent ALVA (7). ZANDY (14), who receives weight from most of her rivals, and handicap debutante CLANITHA (12) are others to consider in a typically competitive Quinté+ event.

- **3. AMERICAN HOPE -** Inconsistent performer, albeit at a higher level. Bounced back to form with a reassuring 4th in a handicap over 1800m at Saint-Malo on 8 August
- **4. MR GOODNIGHT -** Has shown his form and well-being recently by finishing 4th in 3 consecutive outings, the latest at Clairefontaine over 1600m. Candidate for success
- **5. GRECIAN STAR -** Soundly beaten (15th) in a turf handicap over 1800m at Clairefontaine on 12 August but should fare better here under these conditions/back on PSF
- **6. DROIT DE PAROLE -** Honest veteran performer whose competitiveness at this level is beyond doubt. Has finished 5th in back-to-back recent outings, the latest on this course in a 1300m PSF claimer on 10 August
- **7. LE SICILIEN -** Consistent hard-knocker with sound references on both surfaces. Didn't go unnoticed when 4th in a conditions race over 1800m at Nort-sur-Erdre on 11 August
- **8. DONN CLIFS -** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th in a conditions race at Chantilly on 29 June. Best watched for now on his reappearance
- **9. NEOWISE -** Soundly beaten in 3 consecutive outings, including back-to-back recent starts after 2-month break. Finished 14th in 1400m handicap at Le Lion-d'Angers on 26 July

Summary: MR GOODNIGHT (4), the joint highest-rated runner in the race, appeals most of the runners engaged in this concluding contest on the strength and consistency of his recent form. He is marginally preferred to DOIT DE PAROLE (6), who has the means to fight for victory over this slightly longer distance. GRECIAN STAR (5) shouldn't be hastily condemned for his disappointing last start and need only bounce back to the form of his previous outing (2nd) to play a leading role. ADWAN (1) shoulders a big weight but isn't without a chance either.
