R4 DIVONNE [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE HAUTEVILLE - PRIX PGPA - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class G
Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

1. INROAD OAKS - Has struggled of late and was 7th last time out in Class G at this course over 2650m on 11 August. Needs to do more to win this race

2. GIORGIO DU VIVIER - Disqualified last time out in Class G at this course over a similar distance on 18 August. In good form before that and has a winning chance

3. FALCO DA VINCI - Unreliable but did win last time out in Class G at this course over 2650m on 18 August. Can follow up if in the same mood

4. GOPTION MONTAVAL - On a very long losing run but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class G over a similar distance on 18 August. Can fight out the finish again

5. GAME HAUFOR - Holding his form well and was third last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux on 22 June. Should fight out the finish

6. GUEPARD GRIFF - Has struggled of late and was 12th last time out in Class G F at this course over 2050m on 16 August. Others are preferred

7. GRINGO DU NOYER - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Aix-les-Bains on 9 August. Capable of earning some money when smart

Summary: GAME HAUFOR (5) returns from a break but was in good form and is barefoot and ready to strike. FALCO DA VINCI (3) is unreliable but did win a solid enough race last time out and could follow up if in the same frame of mind. GOPTION MONTAVAL (4) showed improvement last time out and can get involved with the finish again. GIORGIO DU VIVIER (2) was in good form before faulting last time out and could bounce back and win.

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C2 - COMMUNAUTE D'AGGLOMERATION-CREDIT MUTUEL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. KAMERIC** - Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Avignon over this distance on 16 June. Can make the frame again
- 2. KALLAGAN** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at this track on 16 August. Capable of playing a minor role when in the mood
- 3. KRIS MARTIN** - At the top of his game and was a winner last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 16 August. Can win again
- 4. KOLENA** - Unreliable and was 7th last time out in Class E at Vichy over 2800m on 3 August. Might pop up in a place on best form
- 5. KATIA DE ROMAZ** - Much improved of late and she was runner-up last time out over this track and trip on 16 August. Not out of it
- 6. KALYPSIA BOND** - Not disgraced when a runner-up to rival in this race KRIS MARTIN (3) last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 16 August. Has a winning chance
- 7. KING DE BASSIERE** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced last time out in Class D at this course over a similar distance on 16 August. Others are preferred
- 8. KAHILA GEDE** - Struggling of late and was 11th last time out in Class E at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 9 August. Could play a minor role

Summary: A very cosy winner at the venue last time out, KRIS MARTIN (3) finds another good entry here and gets the vote to register back to back victories. Runner-up to the selection in her last outing, KALYPSIA BOND (6) should once again give a good account. KATIA DE ROMAZ (5) is currently as good as ever and is sure to go well. KAMERIC (1) is unshod back from a break so is best to keep high on the shortlist.

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C3 - PRIX JOEL DESPRES - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LOYAL DU CHENE** - Yet to win a race but is in good form and was third last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 5 August. Has a place chance
- 2. LUCK AND JOY** - Has been running well in Claimers of late and was runner-up at Feurs last time out over 2050m on 5 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. LALBANE STAR** - Battling to find best form and was 5th last time out in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 5 August. More is needed to beat these runners
- 4. LEVIATHAN SANTMIXO** - Did not show his best when 6th last time out in Class D at Aix-les-Bains over 2700m on 6 August. Capable of earning some money
- 5. LOVE ME DE CERISY** - Disqualified last time out at Vichy on 12 June. Capable of bouncing back to score this shorter distance
- 6. LIONNE DES BROUETS** - Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class B at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 19 June. Has a winning chance
- 7. LETS GO DE MONCHEL** - Disappointing form of late and was 7th last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 11 August. Capable of an upset
- 8. LEI E BELLA** - Ultra-consistent so far and was a winner last time out in Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 28 May. Returns from a break but can score again
- 9. LORD DE BANVILLE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 13 July. Capable of contesting the finish when in the mood
- 10. LUDIVER DES VAUX** - Very unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 3 August. Can contest the finish again

Summary: LEI E BELLA (8) has always been a well regarded filly and could score on return from a break. The Bourgoin's yard has a strong hand in this line-up with LORD DE BANVILLE (9), who is a good trotter when he can keep his stride together, and LUDIVER DES VAUX (10), who comes in the race on the back of a solid 3rd place effort at Enghien earlier this month. Padded on all four feet, LIONNE DES BROUETS (6) has a good each-way chance.

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C4 - S.E.T.F - HORIZON PROTECTION SECURITE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JIPSY DES AIRES** - Well beaten 8th in a class E at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths
- 2. JUST PAT** - He was disqualified in a class C at Feurs over 2850m on 19 July. Remains barefoot and if wise can be involved in the finish
- 3. JOLAN BOY** - Finished 9th in a class E at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and is well placed behind the car
- 4. JOLISSIME ELDE** - Well beaten 9th in a class F at Lignieres over 2825m on 4 August. Needs to show more
- 5. JOKAI** - A runner-up in a class E at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and did show improvement in the latest
- 6. JARDIN D'ERABLE** - Well beaten 8th in a class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 22 July. Remains barefoot. Moderate of late and others are preferred
- 7. JERICHO DU BELLAY** - He won in a class F at this track over 2650m on 16 August. Has confidence from the latest victory and will have his supporters
- 8. JISKAYA DE CARSI** - She finished 5th in a class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 8 August. Not well placed behind the car but is capable of contesting the finish
- 9. JASMIN DE LA COUR** - A runner-up in a class F at this track over 2650m on 16 August. He starts in the second row but did perform well at this track in the latest
- 10. JIPSY ROYALE** - Ran fifth in a class F at this track over 2650m on 16 August. Remains barefoot. Can play a minor role at best
- 11. JOS DU JAL** - He was fourth in a class F at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. Reverts to barefoot and did run a fair race at this track in the latest
- 12. JORGE ARTHUR** - He was fourth in a class F at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and must be wise
- 13. JESSIE RITAL** - A winner of a Claimer at this track over 2050m on 12 August. Others are much preferred in this line up

Summary: JERICHO DU BELLAY (7) finished in front of some of today's rivals last time out and gets a tentative vote to score, despite his draw on the outside. JUST PAT (2) is ideally positioned on the front line too and looks the biggest threat to the selection. JOKAI (5) was a close runner-up last time out at Lignières and in similar form can go one better. JISKAYA DE CARSI (8) has a poor draw on the front row but remains hard to ignore.

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C5 - PRIX GILBERT JOUBERT - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class B Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. KROKEUSE** - Finished 6th in a class D at this track over 2675m on 16 August. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths
- 2. KEN DE CORDAY** - A runner-up in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 31 July. Remains barefoot. Has been wise of late and he has been competitive
- 3. KILLER DE BEAULIEU** - He ran third in a class D at this track over 2675m on 16 August. Remains barefoot. Performed well at this track and can place at best
- 4. KELOWA STARDUST** - She ran third in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 23 July. Reverts to barefoot and is a consistent sort that is not out of it
- 5. KAPITANO DE LOU** - A winner in a class D at this track over 2675m on 16 August. Can double up if in the same mood
- 6. KINNAIRD** - A runner-up in a class D at this track over 2675m on 16 August. Remains barefoot and did show improvement in the latest effort
- 7. KAPTAIN DU LIAMONE** - He ran well when fourth in a class B at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2700m on 15 August. Probably needed the latest effort and has bare hindquarters for this race
- 8. KINGSLAND DE SIMM** - He ran fourth in a class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 August. Should make a bold bid for success

Summary: KINGSLAND DE SIMM (8) has done well in better fields than this and should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. KAPITANO DE LOU (5) won nicely at this course last time out and could be the biggest threat. KAPTAIN DU LIAMONE (7) probably needed the last run and can contest the finish. KELOWA STARDUST (4) was not disgraced last time out and is barefoot and ready to be competitive again.

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**C6 - MATHIEU HAUW - PX RENAULT PAYS DE GEX - 2675m (a1m1/2) -
Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000**

- 1. ITEM BUISSONAY** - Has major disqualification issues and was tenth last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 18 August. Others are much preferred
- 2. ICIANO** - Consistent of late and was barefoot and third last time out in Class G at this track over 2050m on 18 August. Can contest the finish once again
- 3. ILLA VILLA** - Has lost her way of late and was disqualified last time out at this course on 18 August. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 4. INGALLS** - On a very long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2700m on 6 August. Can go one better
- 5. IZZIA HIGHLAND** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at this course on 18 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. ISCO DE JOUDES** - Unreliable and was 11th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 12 August. Capable of an upset when in the mood
- 7. IBIS DU LYS** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out at this track on 18 August. In good form in Claimers before that and can play a minor role at best
- 8. ISTRIA** - Battling to regain best form and was 6th last time out in Class F at this course over a similar distance on 18 August. Can do better this time and is not out of it
- 9. IRVING DE BAILLY** - A bit of a disappointment when 5th last time out in Class F over a similar distance at this track on 18 August. Won nicely before that and has a winning chance
- 10. IDREAMIS** - Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in Class D at Compiègne over 2800m on 3 August. Capable of winning on best form
- 11. IDEE SHANNON** - Returned to her best with a solid win last time out in Class F at this course over a similar distance on 12 August. Can double up

Summary: IDEE SHANNON (11) won a similar event over the course & distance only four days ago and can follow up. She gets the vote ahead of IDREAMIS (10) who seems to be very well entered in this modest line-up. She now has three comeback runs in her and could be a real danger to the selection. IRVING DE BAILLY (9) usually runs well at this course and is shortlisted as well, although he keeps his shoes on. ISTRIA (8) faces an easier task than last time and can bounce back.

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C7 - FEDE.COURSES CENTRE-EST. CAVEAU GESSIEN - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. GOWEN CHALEONNAIS** - On a long losing run and was disqualified last time out at this course on 16 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. HOTESSE D'HAUFOR** - Has really struggled this year and was tenth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 16 August. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. FLAG** - Unreliable but was barefoot and fourth last time out in Class E at this track over 2650m on 12 August. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 4. HOLLYWOOD TORINO** - Broke a long losing when scoring last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 16 August. Can follow up
- 5. HELLO BOY DU PIC** - Fluffed his lines with a rare disqualification at this course last time out on 16 August. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- 6. HEAVEN JULRY** - Very unreliable but did win last time out in Class H at Sault over 3000m on 11 August. Tougher task this shorter distance
- 7. HARDE DESTINEE** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 16 August. Can contest the finish again
- 8. IBIZA EVENING** - In good form and was barefoot and fourth last time out in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 15 July. Can win this shorter-distance
- 9. HALTESS GRIFF** - Has yet to win a race but she has been runner-up in her last two starts, with the latest being in Class E Mounted race at Aix-les-Bains over 2725m on 9 August. Could make the frame
- 10. GIANT MEC** - Battling to regain best form and was unplaced last time out in Class D at this course over 2675m on 18 August. Others are preferred
- 11. GLAIEUL DE JOUX** - Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 16 August. Has a place chance

Summary: IBIZA EVENING (8) takes a significant step down in grade and looks the obvious pick in this line-up. She should take a power of beating and is retained ahead of HOLLYWOOD TORINO (4), whose last winning effort was properly eye-catching. HELLO BOY DU PIC (5) is on a redemption mission after his last sanction and can also be given some serious consideration. HARDE DESTINEE (7) was narrowly headed last time out over the course & distance and could go well once again.

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C8 - BELLINO II - ZENITUDE HÔTEL RESIDENCES - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

- 1. IDEAL DE BANNES** - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 12 August. In good form before that and has a winning chance
- 2. FILOU DU CAIEU** - Holding his form and was third last time out in Class F at Château-du-Loir over 2575m on 28 July. Has a place chance
- 3. HAUBAGNE** - Very consistent of late and was fourth last time out in Class F at this course over this course and distance on 12 August. Can contest the finish again
- 4. IMPERIAL KEY** - In good form of late and was fourth last time out in Class F at Jullianges over 2450m on 14 July. Has a place chance
- 5. HORIZON VOLSIN** - Only modest of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at Jullianges over 2450m on 14 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. FASCINANT** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 4 August. Capable of earning some money when in the mood
- 7. INITIALE CASTELETS** - Did not show her best when 6th last time out in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 15 August. Won her penultimate start and deserves respect for that win
- 8. INBREED** - Disqualified last time out at Vichy on 4 July. In good form before that and can bounce back to score

Summary: INBREED (8) is away since his sanction early July. He makes a much awaited comeback and should be ready for a big run. He gets the vote ahead of INITIALE CASTELETS (7) who ships a long way for the race and is the only runner on the day for trainer Nicolas Ensch. IDEAL DE BANNES (1) is a solid trotter who is sure to give a good account back under the saddle. HAUBAGNE (3) always gives everything she has no matter the discipline and is another one for the shortlist.
