- **3. LUTIN DE REUX -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 17 September. In good form before that and has a winning chance
- **4. LUGANO DE LOU -** Has lost his way with three disqualifications in a row, with the latest being at this track on 4 October. Probably best watched for now
