- 4. KAWASI JACK Finished 2nd in back-to-back starts earlier this year but fluffed his lines in this shoeing configuration last time, finishing 8th over 2650m at Avignon on 9 May. For another day
- **5. KEL JAC -** Capable colt seldom far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over 2950m at Vichy on 4 July
- **6. KING FORCE -** Has acquitted himself well in 3 consecutive claiming races recently, the latest (3rd) at Jullianges over 2450m on 14 July. Dark horse
- **7. KINGSWOOD -** Delicate but capable colt with sound references/form credentials, albeit without success. Dangerous to dismiss despite his recent faux pas at La Capelle on 9 July
- **8. KARMA DE MONTCIANT -** Complicated trotter with undeniable means seldom far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Shouldn't be hastily condemned following his latest failure at Vichy on 4 July
- **9. KING OF L'AUMANCE -** Inconsistent performer but did win in this shoeing configuration over 2025m at Avignon last month. Could only finish 5th over 2650m at that venue on 16 June
- **10. KASIMODO -** Tricky customer who improved to open his account over 2650m at Hyeres on 28 June with David Békaert at the helm. Confirmation expected
- 11. KHEOPS DU PERSIL Versatile sort but has achieved his best references (both career wins) under the saddle. Presented shod for this engagement after finishing 7th (plated) over 2800m in a harness race at Vichy on 1 July
- **12. KONOR HIGHLAND -** Consistent performer who has improved racing unshod won over 2150m at Vichy in May and wasn't disgraced when 5th over 2800m at that venue on 1 July. Not taken lightly
- **13. KERCHAK -** Honest hard-knocker, seldom far off the mark but has been hard to win with (just 1 victory from 22 starts). Can do better in this grade after a last-start 8th (shod) over 2700m at Vincennes on 25 June attractive outsider

- **3. IXION DE VANDEL -** Inconsistent but has the means to make his presence felt in a race of this nature, especially on his return to the harness category after a last-start 8th under the saddle over 2225m at Feurs on 5 July. Dark horse
- **4. ILLUSTRE DE CHENOU -** Reverts to the harness code after a last-start disqualification in a 2225m mounted race at Feurs on 5 July. Joker
- **5. INDIGO -** Has lost his way this year, finishing unplaced in all 4 completed outings disqualified in the other 3, including his latest outing at Vichy over 2150m on 17 June
- **6. IO DOMENICO -** Finished 2nd in his only appearance with this shoeing configuration and lines up here in good order (form and physical condition) after a recent 3rd over 3100m at La Gacilly on 15 July. Candidate for success
- **7. INTEL -** A model of consistency in the claiming category and at the top of his game at present, having won 2 of his last 3 starts the latest over 2700m at Cluny on 7 July. Dark horse
- **8. ILARIO DU MAINE -** Rewarded for his consistency with an overdue second career win over 1600m at Vichy on 6 July. Should remain competitive
- **9. IVAN LENDEL -** Inconsistent performer but does have sound references, even with his irons. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 2600m at Vitteaux on 7 July. Outsider
- **10. ITALIO DE LA ROQUE -** Has gone off the boil this year, unplaced 3 times and disqualified 4 times (including his latest outing at Vichy on 6 July) in his 7 starts this year. Others preferred

Summary: Hard race to assess with a marginal preference given to IO DOMENICO (6) judged on his good recent form and physical condition. However, last-start winner ILARIO DU MAINE (8) and rejuvenated IDEAL WESTERN (12) are other candidates for success, along with IOWA DE TOUCHYVON (2) who is ideally positioned at the start with David Békaert in the sulky. The latter's stablemate INSTINCT DE VETRE (1) also has the means to play a leading role and shouldn't be hastily condemned despite a recent failure (disqualification).

- **3. JESCO DE LA VALLEE -** Rarely seen under the saddle but has sound references/form credentials in this category, including a 3rd over 2950m at Vichy on 17 June. Not taken lightly
- **4. ILIS DU VALLON -** Unreliable mare but has achieved her best references under the saddle, so could do better back in the mounted category after 2 comeback outings in the harness code the latest (disqualified) at Cluny over 2700m on 7 July
- **5. IMPERATIF LA BORIE -** Delicate but capable trotter with sound references under the saddle seldom far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Sanctioned in harness race at Jullianges on 14 July
- **6. JULIANA DU LOISIR -** Honest hard-knocker, seldom far off the mark but has been hard to win with (only 1 victory from 34 starts). Only 8th (barefoot) over 2850m in a harness race at Lyon-Parilly on 29 June
- **7. JOIE DES VENTES -** Has won 2 of 3 appearances under the saddle in this shoe-fitting (plated) and would've refined her condition with a pleasing last start (6th) in a 2900m harness race at Clairefontaine-Deauville. Candidate for success
- **8. JINGLE DES BROUETS -** Has regained momentum back in the mounted code recently, confirmed as much with an encouraging 4th over 2225m at Feurs on 5 July. Dark horse
- **9. JOOSTER LE FOL -** Has formed a potent partnership with Tom Vlaemynck Debost under whom he finished 2nd last time at Vichy in a mounted race over 2950m. Should once again fight for victory
- **10. ILEX DE CABERT -** Has returned to form in 2 recent appearances under the saddle, finishing 4th at Bollène last month and 5th over 2650m at this venue on 30 June. Attractive outsider

Summary: Victory in this mounted race is likely to be fought out by JOOSTER LE FOL (9), who has finished 2nd in his last 3 appearances under the saddle, and versatile JOIE DES VENTES (7) who will appreciate reverting to the mounted category. JOMIZIO (12) has done little wrong under the saddle and is another serious candidate for success. Enigmatic KANARDO FOR CLARA (1) caught the eye last time with an improved 3rd under the saddle and need only confirm that form/improvement to make his presence felt too. KASTILLE (2) and JESCO DE LA VALLEE (3) arent taken lightly either. Good race!

- **3. HERMES SCOTT -** Inconsistent performer and is currently out of sorts, so unlikely to trouble the judge finished 10th over 2700m at Cluny on 7 July. Others preferred
- **4. GOLDENBOY DE CHENU -** Has won back-to-back amateur races recently over 2650m, the latest at Hyeres on 28 June. Ought to remain competitive on his return to the "pro" ranks
- **5. HASTIFER -** Has gone off the boil this year, unplaced 7 times and disqualified twice (including his last start at Vichy over 1600m on 4 July) in 9 starts this year. Others more persuasive
- **6. FLAG -** Soundly beaten (13th) when racing barefoot over 2800m in a harness race at Vichy on 2 July. Presented shod for this commitment, so is best watched for now
- **7. HAITI LADY -** Has nothing to prove under these conditions and is most effective in this shoeing configuration confirmed as much by finishing 3rd over 2850m at Feurs on 5 July. Keep safe
- **8. EMILIE DES IRIS -** Unplaced in each of her last 6 appearances, the latest (8th) over 2850m in this shoe-fitting at Feurs on 5 July. Outsider
- **9. GALION DES THIRONS -** Prolific veteran who is currently at the top of his game, winning 4 of his last 6 starts (3 of his last 4), including back-to-back recent outings over 2950m at Vichy the latest on 25 June. Sets the standard
- 10. GOLD PEJI Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials in this category and under these conditions, including a last-start 2nd over 2800m at Vichy on 4 July. On the shortlist
- **11. HABANERO DE VIETTE -** Delicate but retains the undeniable means to win a race of this nature confirmed as much by finishing 2nd over 2600m at Nancy on 28 June. Will be a factor if repeating that performance
- **12. GOOD LUCK TIT -** Tricky customer who seldom finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification, although has to redeem herself after a recent failure at Vichy over 2800m on 3 June. Dark horse

Summary: GALION DES THIRONS (9) has been at the top of his game for several months, winning three of his last four starts, and has a great opportunity to continue that momentum by completing his hat-trick in this concluding event. He will, however, be tested by the likely challenges of HABANERO DE VIETTE (11), who finished a reassuring 2nd last time out, and the enigmatic FLIRTINI (2) who shouldn't be underestimated with all 4 shoes removed for this race. HAITI LADY (7) and GOLD PEJI (10) complete the shortlist.
