- **1. IRLANDE DU CHENET -** 4th of 9 in a 2950m Dinan claimer 2.5 weeks ago, on just 2nd start back, but still appears to have no realistic chance
- 2. IMA DU CANET Sanctioned in a 2750m Class F at La Ferté-Vidame on Sunday, but is barefoot for the occasion and the Eric Raffin-factor must be taken into consideration. Place chance
- **3. IENA MESLOISE -** No star but always gives her best, latterly 6th of 7 in a 2600m Berck-sur-Mer amateurs Class H on 4 August, and can get a look-in
- **4. IDYLLE DU GASSEL -** Never far from faulting but came a pleasant 5th of 12 in a 2750m Class H at La Ferté-Vidame last Sunday. Unlikely to shake things up but can still make first 5
- **5. INES DE MAJEAN -** Back under harness after coming 7th of 9 in a monté Class F over course and distance on 12 August and is not about to spring any surprises

- **8. IBACA** Was not disgraced when 6th of 7 in a 2625m Class F at La Rochelle earlier in the month. From the front line, in this company, looks capable of imposing
- **9. INES DU MARLOU -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2875m Class H at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne last week. On back line and can be ruled out
- **10. ITALIE FRANCE -** Last of 10 in a 2750m Class F at La Ferté-Vidame last weekend. Reverts to a proven formula and, on good behaviour, can play an important part

Summary: One of the more open races of the day and it may just be worth taking a punt on IBACA (8) who races with front shoes off and who enjoys a good entry on the front row, although ISKA DE VICTHI (6) reassured at Abbeville and looks a similarly serious proposition. Unshodbehind this time, ITALIE FRANCE (10) is giving away distance but should have a lot to contribute in this small field. Barefoot, with the champion driver reining, IMA DU CANET (2) is most definitely one for the shortlist.

- **2. JACARTO DE HOUELLE -** Faulted early in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last Sunday. Has bags of ability though and with Anthony Barrier reining this time, will be afforded every chance
- **3. JUDOKA -** Last but one, when prepping for this, in a 2725m Pornichet Class F 3 weeks ago. Has never disappointed here, is barefoot for the occasion, and merits a 2nd look
- **4. JUPITER FRANCE -** Encouraging 4th of 12 in a 3150m Class F at La Roche-Posay on 11 August but, in this company, will have too much to do
- **5. JOYAU DAIRPET -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2725m Pornichet Class F 3 weeks ago but nevertheless showed his form. Dynamic winner here early last month and, if focused, can play a leading role
- **6. JOKER DES LANDES -** Game sort that lost his action in a 2850m Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne 8 days ago. Will appreciate the return to a hard surface and debuts at the venue with justified ambition
- **7. JOURNAL INTIME -** Placed 3rd here before repeating in a 2950m Le Mans Class F on 27 July. Is plainly close to his race and with the aid of Eric Raffin, can return to winning ways

- **3. IMPEC D'AVRAN -** 7th of 10 finishers in a 2900m amateurs Class H at La Chartre-sur-le-Loir last Sunday and even from the front line will have too much to do
- **4. IMPOLOKO -** Last of 8 in a Class F over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Has nothing to write home about this term and can be passed over
- **5. IVOIRE D'ECHAL -** Made it 5 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2650m Pornichet Class F mid-month. Pads fitted this time but other more reliable options available

- **2. HUGO DE DUSSAC -** Missed out by little in a 2725m Pornichet Class G earlier this month. Anthony Barrier maintains faith and will be justifiably eyeing victory this time
- **3. HORUS DE VAL -** Still had a lot to give when sanctioned in a 2650m Class G here on 12 August. Won here last month and is still very much in the picture
- **4. HAVANE DE CHENU -** Occasionally loses focus but is a quality mare, most recently 3rd of 9 in a 3150m Class E at La Roche-Posay 12 days ago, and must be respected

- **3. I KEEP CALM -** Last of 4 finishers, but by no means trounced, in a 2875m Class E at Meslay-du-Maine late last month. Top driver in charge this time and can win a race of this nature
- **4. IVOIRE DAIRPET -** 2nd of 10 in a 2875m Class F at Meslay-du-Maine last week. Races shod this time though and best to hold off

- **9. KANELLE LA RAVELLE -** 3rd of 11, at 119/1, in a 2750m monté Class F 10 days ago, but a repeat seems most improbable
- **10. KILLER DE MILLAC -** Opened his career account last month but failed to confirm when last of 8 in a 2300m Châteaubriant Class E a fortnight ago, and can be passed over
- **11. KLIF DE LA MITRIE -** 9th of 11 in a Class E over course and distance on 10 July. Has been completely off the boil all season and can be ruled out

- **3. JELLA DE LA NOEMIE -** Has merit but sanctioned in 4 of last 5, latterly a 2475m Francheville Class F mid-month, and even with modified shoeing, will have few takers
- **4. JOLLY DES BORDES -** Endured a tough trip to finish last but one, behind JACINTHE DES BOIS (5), in a 2300m Châteaubriant Class F 2 weeks ago. Pleasant 3rd here last month but still represents no more than a minor place chance

- **10. JOLLY LADY -** Reassuring 4th of 7 finishers in a 2650m Class F here earlier in the month and a similar effort would see her challenge for a step on the podium
- **11. JAMAICA PHEDO -** Capricious but capable mare that faulted in a 2650m Class F here 2.5 weeks ago. Has nothing to prove in this category and can make a big splash if Eric Raffin keeps her trotting
- **12. JOKE BLUE -** Sanctioned in a 3100m Chinon Class F last week. Consistently in the thick of things though when focused and barefoot, and with application will be no easy touch

Summary: JEUNE ORANGE COTON (8) left a very good impression against the boys earlier in the month and, in their absence, looks the one to beat. That said, JOLIE ROMANCE (6) is never easy to knock when focused and, on good behaviour, can put up significant resistance. Although a handful at the best of times, JAMAICA PHEDO (11) is not lacking ability, sports front pads for the occasion, and the engagement of Eric Raffin will only work in her favour. JOLLY LADY (10) appears to be back on the right road and Guillaume Martin will be eager to make good on her form.

- **3. LULU D'ECHAL -** Sanctioned in 3 of 4 monté starts. Is not entirely devoid of ability and, with some luck in running, can pick up a minor place cheque
- **4. LOUNA CAYENNAISE -** Has taken particularly well to the monté code. 2nd of 10 finishers in a Class F over course and distance last weekend and has a realistic chance of losing her maiden tag
