## R4 CABOURG [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DES PISSENLITS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders  
Race - Mounted - EUR € 28,000**

- 1. GINA SAINT QUENTIN** - Experienced mare with better references in amateur races but currently out of sorts (for some time now). Finished 8th in a 2875m mounted race at Argentan on 15 December
- 2. GOVANON** - Complicated veteran, rarely far from a fault - made no impression (failed to finish) under the saddle in a 2875m mounted race at Argentan on 15 December
- 3. HUNE DE CONDE** - Disqualified 4 times and unplaced on 10 occasions in her 14 appearances this year - finished 13th in a 2800m harness race at Strasbourg on 3 November. Others preferred
- 4. GAMBIT GIBUS** - A 101-start veteran with just 2 wins and 13 places to his name. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th in a 2875m mounted race at Argentan on 15 December but has more to do at this level/in this company
- 5. GRANIT D'EPONA** - Last-start winner of a 2550m claimer in the harness category at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 9 December. Rarely seen under the saddle
- 6. IF DU RIB** - Experienced trotter with undeniable means but more efficient/competitive in the harness category. Disqualified in a 2700m mounted race at Graignes on 23 November but shouldn't be hastily condemned
- 7. GINKGO ROCQ** - Disqualified in 5 of his last 8 appearances, including back-to-back recent outings under the saddle - the latest in a 2875m mounted race at Argentan on 15 December
- 8. HISTOIRE DE JAVA** - Versatile veteran mare whose reassuring last start (3rd) in a 2900m Amiens harness race on 9 December should stand her in good stead here, despite switching to this code/back under the saddle. Keep safe
- 9. IDEAL D'ARTONGES** - Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials under the saddle, which include a 2850m victory under the saddle at Mauquenchy on 12 September when last seen in this shoe-fitting. Beware
- 10. HATE YOU BEYLEV** - Experienced trotter with solid form references/credentials under the saddle, including a last-start 2nd at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 December. Sets the standard
- 11. HEIDI DU BISET** - Model of consistency in the harness code with the form and experience in this shoeing configuration to be competitive in her first start under the saddle. Finished 5th over 2400m at Amiens on 9 December
- 12. HECTOR DU MINON** - Unreliable but undeniably capable performer (albeit in the harness category), especially with Dorothee Dieudegard at the helm. Lacks references under the saddle but will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- 13. HAWAI DE KERLEAN** - Hard-knocking versatile veteran with undeniable means and whose form references/credentials include back-to-back victories (July and August) under the saddle. Unplaced (7th) in a harness race over 3000m at Chateaubriant on 1 December

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**Summary:** A toss-up between HATE YOU BEYLEV (10), HAWAI DE KERLEAN (13) and HEIDI DU BISET (11) for race honours. They may find themselves fighting for victory and will likely dominate the finish ahead of versatile HISTOIRE DE JAVA (8) and experienced IF DU RIB (6) who appeal most of the remainder.

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## C2 - PRIX DES TILLEULS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JOLIE PLANTE** - Experienced hard-knocker whose references include finishing 3rd in a 2800m harness race at Strasbourg when last seen in this shoe-fitting on 9 June. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- 2. JARLA** - Seldom far off the mark, albeit in harness races at a lower level. Unplaced (9th) at Le Croisé-Laroche in a 2700m event on 2 December - improvement needed
- 3. JASMINE D'AMOUR** - Unplaced in consecutive recent outings under the saddle, the latest (11th) in a 2175m mounted race at Vincennes on 11 December. Can do better in this category
- 4. JELLY BULLE** -
- 5. JELLY JAMM** - Won a 2500m event (unshod) at Reims in March but struggled in 8 subsequent appearances - the latest (10th) over 2350m at Angers on 9 December. Others preferred
- 6. J'ADORE CHENEVIERE** - Placed once (this configuration) in 14 appearances this year and must improve to be competitive after a recent failure (disqualification) at Graignes on 13 December. Best watched for now
- 7. JOY ERCA** - A winner of back-to-back recent outings (shod) for new connections, the latest over 2550m at Reims on 7 December. Not taken lightly
- 8. JESABELLE DU JOUR** - Won 2 of 3 Cabourg appearances, including a similar course-and-distance event on 5 October with Tony Le Beller at the helm and with whom she is reunited after a subsequent Vincennes disqualification
- 9. JULIANA BREIL** - Unplaced in all 6 appearances since winning a 2850m harness race at Bréhal in August. Wasn't disgraced in finishing 5th under the saddle in back-to-back mounted races at Vincennes, the latest on 2 December
- 10. JOIE GIBUS** - Unplaced in both recent comeback outings after a 9-month absence, though didn't go unnoticed (6th) over 2400m at Amiens on 9 December. Respected here with all 4 shoes removed (barefoot)
- 11. JAMINA DES CHASSES** - Complicated but undeniably capable hard-knocker with sound form references/references but is most effective racing unshod. Unplaced (10th) at Caen over 2450m on 12 October - best watched for now
- 12. JAHIA DU TRIO** - Consistent hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 5th at Amiens on 9 December over 2400m. Dark horse
- 13. J'ADORE BLUE** - Bounced back to form with a reassuring 4th over 2400m at Amiens on 9 December in her first start with this shoe-fitting. Confirmation expected
- 14. JOYEUSE DU PORTO** - Winner of back-to-back recent starts in this configuration, the latest at Cordemais on 24 November over 2825m. Can complete the hat-trick with Yoann Lebourgeois, who has steered her to victory before
- 15. JOLYA DE POMMERAYE** - Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, albeit without a win (she's a 36-start maiden). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 8th over 2700m at Vincennes on 1 December

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**16. JAVA DE FOLIOT** - Disqualified twice - the latest at Caen on 9 November - and unplaced (8th) once in her last 3 starts but is ideally engaged at earnings limit. Shouldn't be underestimated

**Summary:** Thriving JOYEUSE DU PORTO (14) seems capable of completing the hat-trick. She gets the nod ahead of JAHIA DU TRIO (12), with Benjamin Rochard at the helm, and Frédéric Héon's charges JOLYA DE POMMERAYE (15) and JESABELLE DU JOUR (8). However, JOY ERCA (7) and J'ADORE BLUE (13) also have the means to challenge for a spot on the podium. JAVA DE FOLIOT (16) comes next.

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## C3 - PRIX DES CINERAIRES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JOUEUR** - Sparingly raced trotter with room for improvement and sound references/form credentials, which include a last-start 2nd at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 24 November. The horse to beat
- 2. JAZZ DANOVER** - Experienced hard-knocker with sound form references - seldom far off the mark, though rarely wins (won 2 of 51 appearances). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th over 2600m at Nantes on 30 November
- 3. JOESTAR DES NOES** - Enigmatic but undeniably capable sort - usually acquits himself competitively if applied/remaining wise. Disqualified in back-to-back recent starts, the latest at Argentan on 15 December but could make amends
- 4. JAM DES LANDES** - Versatile hard-knocker who seldom finishes far off the mark but must improve to make his presence felt, having finished 10th in a 3150m mounted race Saint-Brieuc on 6 December. Outsider
- 5. JUST BE GOOD** - Talented but complicated in equal measure, if not more so - rarely far from a fault but shouldn't be taken lightly, despite 3 consecutive disqualifications (the latest at Reims on 7 December). Keep safe
- 6. JACADI DE PEBRAC** - Inconsistent performer whose best references/performances were without irons (unshod). Disqualified at Argentan on 15 December and is best watched for now
- 7. JOLLY LOOK** - Consistent hard-knocker with the form and experience to fight for victory. Soundly beaten 11th (shod) at Argentan over 2150m but should fare better now with shoes removed
- 8. JOKER DREAM** - Unreliable but has the means to play a leading role if avoiding disqualification, especially in this (barefoot) configuration. Finished 9th (shod) at Argentan over 2150m on 15 December
- 9. JISCOUR DU GERS** - Blows hot and cold at a lower level but is most efficient/competitive racing unshod. Unplaced (shod) over 2700m at Graignes on 29 August - for another day
- 10. JASMIN DU ROCHER** - Complicated but undeniably capable trotter - usually acquits himself competitively when remaining wise. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his recent failure (disqualification) at Meslay on 19 December
- 11. JULLIAN DADDY** - Experienced 23-start maiden with sound references/form credentials, including back-to-back runners-up finishes (both in this barefoot configuration) - the latest over 2600m at Nancy on 30 November. Big chance
- 12. JUSTICIER DAIRPET** - Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials but currently out of sorts - disqualified last time out over 2450m at Caen on 9 November. For another day
- 13. JOUR D'ERABLE** - Delicate (seldom far from a fault) but retains undeniable means/ability, though is most effective without his irons. Absent since finishing 8th (unshod) at Vincennes on 7 June - best watched for now
- 14. JAPPELOU** - Honest trotter on an upward trajectory - regained momentum recently in 2 starts with this shoe-fitting, the latest (2nd) over 2500m at Saint-Brieuc on 3 November. Winning chance

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**15. JOKER DE L'EPINE** - Sparked improvement in this barefoot configuration to finish a reassuring 4th over 2625m at Cherbourg on 24 November. Confirmation required

**16. JEANBAT DANOVER** - Out of sorts and unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of recent performances, the latest (failed to finish) in a 2825m harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November

**Summary:** Rejuvenated JAPPELOU (14) and overdue 23-start maiden JULLIAN DADDY (11) are the main winning hopes in this event and are preferred to enigmatic JUST BE GOOD (5) who is undeniably talented and even more complicated, though shouldn't be taken lightly with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm. JOLLY LOOK (7), JOKER DREAM (8) and PLAYER (1) have legitimate podium prospects.

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## C4 - PRIX DES PELARGONIUM - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. LORD DU VIVIER** - Unplaced (6th) on debut at Graignes over 2700m on 8 December but showed enough to suggest he could get into the picture here with improvement expected. Not taken lightly
- 2. LAFAYETTE DU BOURG** - Twice 3rd over 2550m at Gournay-en-Bray in September but yet to build on that promise in 4 subsequent starts, the latest (5th) at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Others preferred
- 3. LIL BOSS ONLY** - Improved with every outing and finished 2nd over 3000m at Nantes on 8 December. Should have a role to play if making further progress
- 4. LU DE MUTRECY** - Improving trotter whose last-start 2nd over 2450m at Caen on 28 October bodes well for his chances here. Keep safe
- 5. LE ROI** - A 9-start maiden unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of his recent performances, the latest (9th) at Vire over 2800m on 1 December
- 6. LEWIS D'ALEXIANE** - Lightly raced gelding with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Dark horse
- 7. LUKABEL** - An authoritative last-start winner over 2875m at Meslay-du-Maine in his first start with this shoe-fitting on 24 November. Confirmation expected
- 8. LEON DU RIB** - Impressive winner at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 23 September but disqualified in both subsequent outings, the latest at Cherbourg over 2625m on 24 November
- 9. LEBARON D'OURVILLE** - Placed twice in 8 starts (finished 3rd on both occasions) but is best watched for now after finishing 8th on his return from a 6-month absence over 2825m at Cordemais on 24 November. Outsider
- 10. LIGHTNING** - Improving recently to finish 2nd at Mauquenchy last month and 3rd over 2800m at Vire on 1 December. Could have more to offer with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm
- 11. LALBER** - Seldom far off the mark (10-start maiden) but must improve to have a say in the outcome. Finished 7th at Graignes over 2700m on 8 December
- 12. LEADER BEACH** - Debut winner at Vitré in June but unplaced in both subsequent appearances - finished 8th over 2700m at Vire on 1 July. Open to improvement on his reappearance but is best watched for now
- 13. LISTAO** - Inconsistent but not devoid of means /ability - retains the form and experience to make his presence felt, despite a recent failure (11th) over 2200m at Vincennes on 4 December. Attractive outsider
- 14. LENNON** - Blotted his copybook (lost his unbeaten record after back-to-back victories) when disqualified in his latest appearance at Chartres on 26 November. Open to improvement and capable of making amends - respect
- 15. LOTUS JIEL** - Debut winner at Mauquenchy in January and acquitted himself well in defeat in 3 subsequent starts - the latest (3rd) over 2150m at Enghien on 8 March. Respected on his reappearance

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**Summary:** Last-start Meslay winner LUKABEL (7), recent Mauquenchy runner-up LIGHTNING (10) and unexposed LENNON (14), despite a recent failure, are best equipped to fight for victory. LEON DU RIB (8) isn't written condemned for recent disqualifications, having shown enough before that to be competitive in a race of this nature. BOSS ONLY (3), with Benjamin Rochard engaged, and LORD DU VIVIER (1) make up the shortlist ahead of LU DE MUTRECY (4).

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## C5 - PRIX DES FRAXINELLES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

**1. MARAVIGLIA** - Disqualified when in front on debut over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 17 November. Not taken lightly

**2. MY DESTINY QUEEN** - Disqualified on debut at Cherbourg in a 2625m claimer on 6 October. Improvement needed to have a say

**3. MONTEQUILLO** - Unplaced in 3 of 4 appearances, the latest (7th) over 2800m at Chartres on 26 November but has revealed sufficient means to acquit himself competitively in a race of this ilk. Keep safe

**4. MAFALDA** - Runner-up on debut at Cherbourg last month and didn't go unnoticed after her disqualification at Laval on 16 November. Needs only to remain wise to gain compensation

**5. MODESTY** - Showed promise in both October appearances - 4th on debut and 3rd on this course over 2050m - before a recent failure (disqualification) at Chartres on 26 November. Needs to reaffirm

**6. MEGANE DE CERISY** - Complicated filly, disqualified in 3 consecutive recent outings, the latest at Vincennes on 22 November

**7. MISTER MAGIC** - Complicated colt with undeniable means/ability and scope to improve. Disqualified in 3 of 5 appearances but showed enough in both completed starts (3rd and 4th) to suggest he'll to play a leading role if applied

**8. MISTRAL CASTELLE** - Confirmed the promise of his debut 3rd at Alençon in September by finishing 2nd over 2050m at Laval on 8 December

**9. MADE IN MARETTES** - Taking course-and-distance winner on debut earlier this month (7 December). Has more on his plate but is open to any amount of improvement

**10. MARILYN MONROE** - Progressive last-start winner over 2275m at Nantes on 8 December. Could get into the picture with further improvement

**11. MADOKA JIEL** - Improving trotter with the form and experience to be competitive - her references include finishing 3rd in 3 consecutive starts, the latest over 2400m at Amiens on 9 December. Dark horse

**12. MARA AULNAIES** - Lightly raced filly with scope for improvement and solid form references/credentials, including a last-start 4th over 2150m at Enghien on 27 October. Respected on her reappearance

**Summary:** Well-bred MAFALDA (4) didn't go unnoticed despite her early disqualification at Laval last time and she need only repeat the performance of her debut (2nd) to gain compensation here. MISTER MAGIC (7), for whom this remains a question of wisdom, enigmatic MONTEQUILLO (3), whose recent performances don't reflect his ability, and lightly raced MARA AULNAIES (12) look best of the rest.

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## C6 - PRIX DES ARISTOLOCHES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. KARNAC D'ALCI** - Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd over 2500m at Reims on 7 December. Confirmation needed
- 2. KOVE DU CHENE** - Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, albeit without success (he's a 33-start maiden). Finished 3rd (unshod) at Bordeaux on 24 November
- 3. KLAIRON DE TILLARD** - Disqualified once and soundly beaten 3 times in 4 appearances this year, including her latest at Graignes on 11 November. Others preferred
- 4. KINGSTON DU MINON** - Finished 5th in back-to-back October appearances and didn't go unnoticed after his early disqualification at Cherbourg on 1 November. Will be competitive if avoiding disqualification
- 5. KIMMAJO** - Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials but currently out of sorts - finished 7th over 2450m at Caen on 29 May and hasn't been seen since. Watch for now
- 6. KOWEIT** - Honest hard-knocker with the form and experience to acquit himself competitively. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his recent failure (disqualification) at Argentan on 15 December
- 7. KOKA DU DOUET** - Confirmed the improvement of his course-and-distance 4th earlier this month by finishing 2nd over 2825m at Cordemais on 15 December. On the shortlist
- 8. KNOWING** - Unreliable but is confirmed under these conditions/in this configuration with the form/experience to play a leading role, if building on his last-start 5th over 2700m at Graignes on 11 November. Dark horse
- 9. KOPEK BOURBON** - Out of sorts, unplaced in 3 consecutive appearances - the latest (9th) over 2450m at Caen on 9 November. Not incapable of resurfacing in a race of this nature, especially with David Thomain at the helm - beware!
- 10. KELLER DE L'ITON** - Continues to blow hot and cold but boasts sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a course-and-distance event on 7 December. Winning chance with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm
- 11. KNOCKANDO** - Inconsistent (at a higher level) but undeniably capable of resurfacing in a race like this, despite finishing 10th at Vincennes over 2175m on 12 December. Keep safe
- 12. KALYPSO DREAM** - Seldom far off the mark on a going day but is relatively exposed (a 25-start maiden) so needs to improve to make his presence felt. For another day
- 13. KINDER DANOVER** - Runner-up in back-to-back unshod appearances before his last-start 12th (shod) in a course-and-distance event on 19 December. Better expected with all 4 shoes removed
- 14. KAZAK ROYAL** - Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd in a 2700m Vincennes claimer on 13 December. Confirmation needed
- 15. KARYNDO ROBSEN** - Consistent 22-start maiden with sound references/form credentials (albeit without a victory), including a last-start 5th over 2400m at Amiens on 9 December. Dark horse

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**16. KIWI D'AUVRECY** - Progressive sort, especially in this (barefoot) configuration - wasn't winning out of turn when opening his account at Graignes over 2700m on 8 December. Seems capable of following up with another victory

**Summary:** A close call to be made between KIWI D'AUVRECY (16), who was rewarded for his consistency with a breakthrough victory last time, and KELLER DE L'ITON (10), who caught the eye with an encouraging course-and-distance 2nd earlier this month. KOKA DU DOUET (7), improving after joining Pierre-Louis Desautette, KINDER DANOVER (13), efficient/competitive racing unshod, and KINGSTON DU MINON (4) should also acquit themselves competitively.

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## C7 - PRIX DE THIBERVILLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. KYRA D'ECOUVES** - Yet to win a race but was 5th in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 19 December. has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 2. KONFINEE A BAZOCHE** - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 19 December. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 3. KANDY CHAMPOSULT** - Yet to win but was runner-up last time out in Class G at Nancy over 2600m on 30 November. Can contest the finish
- 4. KAABA RINGEAT** - Improving and was third in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 7 December. Can earn some more money
- 5. KASCADE** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Chateaubriant on 7 December. Others make more appeal
- 6. KOKO QUEEN** - Hard to trust but the last run at Cherbourg on 6 October is worth ignoring. Might play a minor role
- 7. KENZA SOLO** - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 19 December. Has struggled of late and others are preferred
- 8. KOHANA** - Yet to win a race after 38 starts and was 6th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 14 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. KALINA DE LAURIERE** - Disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 9 November. Unreliable and others are preferred
- 10. KOB DE MONTI** - Unreliable and was 9th in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Could play a minor role when in the mood
- 11. KOSETTE DU HAMEL** - A winner of her last two starts, with the latest in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 20 November. Can complete the hat-trick
- 12. KITA MESLOISE** - Disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 December. In fair form before that and is not out of it
- 13. KELLY D'ERABLE** - Disappointing form of late and was tenth in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Barefoot this time and could be competitive
- 14. KHAGNES** - Disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 December. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 15. KATINKA COTON** - Did not show her best when 9th in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 13 December. Barefoot this time and should contest the finish
- 16. KIANA OASIS** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Others are preferred

**Summary:** Hat-trick seeking KOSETTE DU HAMEL (11) lines up here with legitimate winning ambitions - it'll pay to follow her progress. However, she will be challenged by KATINKA COTON (15), who has a great opportunity to redeem herself under favourable conditions, and KHAGNES (14), with Yoann Lebourgeois an eye-catching engagement. KITA MESLOISE (12), KELLY D'ERABLE (13) and KOB DE MONTI (10) appeal most of the remainder.

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## C8 - PRIX DES SAPINS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 19,500

- 1. LOVELY FILLY** - A three-year-old filly by Pagalor out of Quita d'Eronville who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- 2. LOLITA** - Disqualified in both starts so far, with the latest being at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 22 July. Can do better returning from a break and being under the saddle this time
- 3. LADY DU CEBE** - has not shown much so far and was 8th in a Class G harness race at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 24 November. More is needed to win
- 4. LADIVA D'ARELINE** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 8 December. Others are much preferred
- 5. LONAKA D'OCCAGNES** - Has yet to show much and was 6th in a Class E Mounted race over this track and trip on 7 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 6. LADY MILLION ANAJO** - Has major disqualification issues but was fourth last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 1 December. Might play a minor role
- 7. LA PELLOISE** - Has been a disappointment since a good debut and was 8th last time out in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 1 December. Should improve trying a Mounted race
- 8. LOVA DE FROMENTEL** - Showed improvement in second start when third in a Class F Mounted race at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 1 December. Can contest the finish
- 9. LEDORIKA** - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 7 December. Capable of earning some money when in the mood
- 10. LIVIA DES LANDES** - Has improved of late and was fourth in a Class E Mounted over this course and distance on 7 December. More is needed to win
- 11. LA NESLOISE** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in a Class F harness race at Cabourg over this track and trip on 7 December. Capable of earning some minor money
- 12. LADY D'HELIOS** - Consistent so far and was fourth in a Class F harness race over this track and trip on 7 December. Can contest the finish
- 13. LA TRINITE NEMO** - Unreliable so far and was 6th in a Class F harness race at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 31 October. Capable of an upset
- 14. LOVELY MARINA** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in a Class F harness race at Graignes over 2700m on 11 November. Capable of an upset
- 15. LISE DE SIENNE** - Disqualified on her debut but did win last time out in a Class F harness over this course and distance on 7 December. Can follow up on Mounted race debut
- 16. LINEA DE L'ALBA** - Disappointing of late and was 7th in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 December. Capable of an upset

**Summary:** Newcomers under the saddle LOLITA (2), disqualified in both starts under harness, LA PELLOISE (7), who could improve tried in this shoe-fitting for the first time, and LISE DE SIENNE (15), a last-start winner in the harness category at this venue, appeal most. LADY D'HELIOS (12), LA TRINITE NEMO (13) and LOVA DE FROMENTEL (8) are others with legitimate podium ambitions.
