C1 - PRIX D'ARGENTAN - 2925m (a2m) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- **1. ICARE DES CHAMPS -** Unreliable and was 7th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 13 August. Won his penultimate start and could surprise when in the mood
- **2. ILLIMITEE -** Does not lose often and was a winner of her last three starts, with the latest being in Class F at this track over 2700m on 13 August. Barefoot and could make the frame
- **3. IDYLLE DU PERSIL** Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class E at this course over 2700m on 17 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. IDEFIX D'OLMEN -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 15 August. Might play a minor role
- **5. INCAHUASI -** A barefoot winner of his last two starts at this track, with the latest being in Class D over 2925m on 29 July. No out of it

- 9. INGRID TURGOT She was disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at this course on 22 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 10. IRON MESLOIS On a long losing run but he has been runner-up in two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 10 August. Can follow up
- **11. IES WE KAN -** Usually very competitive over this course and distance and was fourth last time out in Class C on 10 August. Should contest the finish once again

- **4. ELIXIR WIND -** Disappointing form of late and was 7th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 27 July. Others are preferred
- **5. FRILOUZ DE KERNAS -** More than a year since last win but is holding form and was fourth last time out in Class B at Hyeres over 2650m on 2 August. Place chance

- **3. DEUS ZACK -** Has improved since trying this short distance and was runner-up last time out at Taranto on 28 July. Can contest the finish
- **4. ERIC THE EEL -** Mostly modest form this year and was 7th last time out in a GR.2. at Argentan over this distance on 10 August. Others are preferred
- **5. EMERAUDE DE BAIS -** Disqualified last time out at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 15 August. Has run well over this track and trip and could be a threat
- **6. AMPIA MEDE SM -** More than a year since last win but has been placed twice over this distance of late and was third last time out in a GR.2. at Argentan on 10 August. Can contest the finish again
