- **1. PLANEUR -** Good 2nd at this track over 3700m in a claiming chase on December 4th last time. One to keep safe
- **2. ILLAHO** Won over hurdles at this track in a Class 3 race on December 12th last time. Back over fences after a 2nd in November and a mishap after that on his penultimate run. Player
- **3. MESSY -** Two recent falls, 4th before that over 3450m in a claiming chase at Compiegne on November 2nd. Needs to brush up on his jumping
- **4. LACRYMA CHRISTI -** Two 3rd placed runs of late, the latter at this track over 3800m in a Class 1 chase on December 16th. Ought to play a lead role
- **5. SAGA NIGHT** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over hurdles at this track over 3400m in a Class 4 race on December 6th. Place chance

**Summary:** LACRYMA CHRISTI (4) has the best form over fences and can score in what looks like calmer waters than her latest start in a Class 1 chase 8 days ago at this racecourse when he was third. ILLAHO (2) could be the one that gives the selection the most to do. He fluffed his lines over fences two starts ago after a promising second on his chase debut in November. A recent win over hurdles will have installed confidence. PLANEUR (1) and LADY DU SAPHIR (6) warrant respect and can feature.

- **3. BOB MORANE -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 4000m in a handicap hurdle on December 2nd at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. Opposable
- **4. HELLENA -** 3rd last time over 4000m in a handicap hurdle on December 9th at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. Needs more consistency

- **2. SAIL ON -** 4th on the latest run over 3800m in a Class 1 chase at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on December 16th. Back over hurdles and others look better equipped
- **3. TORONADO BELLO -** 2nd last time in a claiming hurdle behind LORD CIERGUES (7) at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on December 6th. Will need to raise his game to be involved
- **4. NADURRA -** Has improved with race experience, 2nd last time over 3300m in a Class 3 hurdle at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on December 16th. Out quickly and holds a leading chance

- **2. NYIRI -** Won a handicap chase at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 4200m in a handicap chase on December 9th. Useful performer over hurdles and fences and can feature
- **3. REVE DE PRINCE -** Credible 3rd last time over 4200m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a handicap chase behind NYIRI (2) on December 9th. Capable performer who should be on the premises
