### C1 - PRIX DU CASINO PARTOUCHE DE PORNICHET - 2725m (a1m1/2) -Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 30,000

**1. HERMES DE CLOPEAU -** Has major disqualification issues but did run well last time out when runner-up in Class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 21 July. Capable of going one better

**2. HELLO KERODA -** Disappointing of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2775m on 10 July. Best when barefoot and is not this time so others are preferred

**3. HAPPY END COSSE -** Battling to regain winning form and was 5th last time out in Class F at Savenay over 3100m on 14 July. Capable of making the frame

**4. HARIBO DU THIOLET -** Modest of late and was 6th last time out in Class H at Bagnoles-del'Orne over 2850m on 14 July. Needs to find few lengths to win

**5. HERMES PAT -** Very unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class F at Segre over 2700m on 15 July. Capable of popping up in the money when in the mood

**6. HAS DE COEUR -** Battling to regain winning form and was 7th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 20 July. Was in good form earlier this year and is not out of it

**7. HAPPY DANOVER -** Heavily raced this year and was runner-up last time out in Class E at La Roche-Posay over 3150m on 21 July. Can contest the finish

**8. FERIA DE LIGNY -** Has really struggled of late and was 13th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 13 July. Needs major improvement to win

**9. HASARD -** Unreliable of late and was 8th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 June. Capable of an upset

**10. HURIEL LUDOIS -** Disappointing of late and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 July. Has won twice this year and is in with a winning chance

**11. HOUSTON PAJELO -** Barefoot and third last time out in Class D at Enghein over 2875m on 6 July. Not unshod this time but can contest the finish

**12. GAGNEUR -** Disappointing of late and was tenth last time out in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 2 July. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** A tricky opening event in which HOUSTON PAJELO (11) makes the most appeal judged on the strength and consistency of his recent form, including an improved last start (3rd) at Enghien earlier this month. HURIEL LUDOIS (10) should have more to offer reverting to the harness category and has the means to play a leading role, too. HASARD (9) has continued to blow hot and cold recently but isn't incapable of making his presence felt either. HERMES PAT (5) and GAGNEUR (12) are others with podium ambitions.

# C2 - PRIX DE PLESSE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

**1. INAO SAINT CLAIR -** In fair form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Place chance in this line-up

**2. ISARD DE PLAY -** Modest of late and was 6th last time out in Class F at Francheville over 2450m on 14 July. Capable of better and could contest the finish

**3. IASELMA -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at Le Mont-Saint Michel on 18 July. Best watched for now

**4. IDOLA BELLA -** Has struggled this year and was barefoot and 7th last time out in Class H at Rânes over 315m on 13 July. Not unshod this time and others are preferred

**5. ISEO PRIOR -** Unreliable of late and was 6th last time out in Class F at Saint-Pierre-la-Cour over 2600m on 14 July. More is needed to win this race. Might place

6. IDOLE DE BERGAULT - Has been kept to Mounted races for some time now and was 7th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 6 Junly. Could be the surprise package in a harness race

**7. ICONE DU GARDEN -** Has struggled in three starts this year and was 11th last time out in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 23 June. Could be ready to improve and earn some money

**8. IPSOS DANOVER -** On a long losing run but has been fair of late and was 5th last time out in Class G at Amiens over 2900m on 20 July. Place chance

**9. IVAN DE L'ERDRE -** Showed some improvement when runner-up last time out in Class F at Segre over 2700m on 15 July. Can contest the finish again

**10. IMANOLO DE LOU -** In good form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Francheville over 2475m on 14 July. Could contest the finish once again

**Summary:** IMANOLO DE LOU (10) is a model of consistency with references at a higher level under these conditions, so sets a good standard. He is good value to recapture the winning thread at the primary expense of ISARD DE PLAY (2), who has a 25m headstart with Benjamin Rochard at the helm. IVAN DE L'ERDRE (9) has regained momentum recently and confirmed as much with a reassuring last start, so needs only to repeat that performance to get onto the podium. ICONE DU GARDEN (7), with Matthieu Abrivard in the sulky, and INAO SAINT CLAIR (1) complete the shortlist.

# C3 - PRIX ASOSP44 - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

**1. IOUP LA BOUM -** On a very long losing run but is consistent and was fourth last time out in Class E at La Roche-Posay over 3150m on 21 July. Could earn some minor money

**2. GRAND VENT RUSH -** Battling to regain winning form and was 9th last time out in Class F at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 8 July. Capable of earning some minor money

**3. ILLUSION D'AMOUR -** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 21 June. Capable of contesting the finish when in the mood

**4. ILEO PIERJI** - Has been good this year winning three times but was 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race over this track and trip on 4 July. Capable of winning but will have shoes on this time around

**5. IKYTA DE LA VALLEE -** Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 13 January. Could need this run returning from a break

**6. INSIGHT SPOKEN -** Much improved this year winning four times including last time out in Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 30 July. Change of shoe arrangement but can still score

**7. IZIA DE MONGIVAL** - Did not show her best when 6th last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 15 July. Barefoot and can bounce back to score

**8. IOUPY TOLLEVILLE -** Has not won for some time now and was 7th last time out in Class G at Enghien over 2875m on 10 July. Capable of earning some money

**9. HYSOPE DU BOCAGE** - Disappointing last run when 11th in Class D over this track and trip on 11 July. In good form before that and has a place chance

**10. IMAGE D'ATALANTE -** Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 June. Not out of it in this line-up

**Summary:** INSIGHT SPOKEN (6) completed his hat-trick with a dominant Sablé-sur-Sarthe success last month and, on the evidence of that performance, seems capable of extending that winning sequence returning to a track that he particularly enjoys. Versatile ILEO PIERJI (4) has shown his form and well-being under the saddle recently but is equally adept in this code, so rates the biggest danger to the selection. Consistent IZIA DE MONGIVAL (7), confirmed in the barefoot configuration, and enigmatic IMAGE D'ATALANTE (10) arent taken lightly, though, and have the means to make their presence felt too.

**1. JACKPOT ATOUT -** Yet to win a race but has been consistent of late and was third last time out in Class F at Francheville over 2475m on 13 July. Place chance

**2. JOBIC KERGWEN -** Has major disqualification issues but did run well when fourth last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 12 July. Could earn some money when smart

**3. JACKPOT DE PLOMB** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 14 June. Won the penultimate start and is capable of an upset

**4. JOYAUX DE REUX -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class H at Erbray over 2675m on 7 July. Fitter this time and can bounce back to score

**5. JUNIOR DU GRENIER -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at La Gacilly on 15 July. Capable of a surprise when wise

**6. JAMAICA FLIGNY** - Disappointing form this year and was 5th last time out in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 13 July. Capable of better but others are preferred

**7. JACARTO DE HOUELLE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class E at Segré over 2700m on 15 July. Could play a minor role

**8. JOHN ANGOT -** Very consistent and was third last time out in Class H at Francheville over 2475m on 14 July. Should contest the finish yet again

**9. JUDOKA -** Not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Barefoot this time and is not out of it

**10. JANE'S FELLA -** Disqualified last time out at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 10 July. Needs major improvement to win this race

**11. JOY BRETONNIERE -** Much improved of late and was a winner last time out in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2550m on 13 July. Should fight out the finish once again

**12. JIBRIL SNOB -** Disqualified last time out at Vichy on 25 June. Capable of better and could get involved with the finish

**13. JOLLY DES BORDES -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 10 July. Capable of making the frame

**14. JIRAFENN LORIETTES -** Battling to regain best form and was fifth last time out in Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 7 July. More is needed to win

**Summary:** Highly regarded JOYAUX DE REUX (4) has been sparingly raced and is probably a lot better than his record may suggest. He would've benefitted appreciably from a much-needed comeback outing at Erbray earlier this month and it could pay to follow his progress here, especially with Matthieu Abrivard at the helm. JOY BRETONNIERE (11) has taken her game to new heights recently, winning 2 of her last 3 starts (including her latest), and will pose a threat to the selection if making further progress. The booking of Benjamin Rochard in the sulky bodes well for the chances of JOHN ANGOT (8), whose consistency ought to be rewarded sooner rather than later. JUNIOR DU GRENIER (5) and JOLLY DES BORDES (13) appeal most of the remainder.

**1. KARISME DE JUAN -** Disqualified in his last four starts, with the latest being at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle on 13 July. Best watched for now

**2. KAIROS ECUS -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 7th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 4 July. Can shine under Matthieu Abrivard

**3. KAPTAIN FAFA -** Battling to win a race but was fourth last time out in Class E at Savenay over 3100m on 14 July. Might play a minor role

**4. KEOPS DES NOUES -** Has lost his way of late and was 9th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 4 July. Others are preferred

**5. KOBE BEJI** - Disqualified last time out at this course on 11 July. In good form before that and is capable of being a threat

**6. KAMIKAZE DRY -** Much improved of late and was a winner last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 4 July. Can follow up

**7. KLASSIC WINNER -** Holding form and was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 11 July. 11 July. Be right there at the finish once again

**8. KORSO SNOB -** Disqualified last time out at Le Mont-Saint-Miche on 18 July. Fair form before that and is not out of it

**9. KEMEUNEUR -** Disappointing form of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 18 July. Capable of better but others are preferred

**10. KRYSTAL PALACE -** Yet to win a race and was 8th last time out in Class E at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 14 July. Barefoot for the first time and could strike

**Summary:** KAIROS ECUS (2) has yet to win but could benefit by the 25m start and Matthieu Abrivard seated. KAMIKAZE DRY (6) has improved of late and was a good winner last time out. KRYSTAL PALACE (10) is barefoot for the very first time so deserves respect. KLASSIC WINNER (7) is holding form nicely and could get involved with the finish once again.

**3. KISACELEA -** Has some fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class G at Vichy over 2800m on 4 July. Could earn some minor money

**4. KYMIJALLY -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Saint-Pierre-la-Cour on 14 July. Remains barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race

**5. KIA BLUE -** Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 13 July. Others are preferred

**6. KANTARA GEMA -** She was disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Laval on 3 July. Best watched for now

**7. KARLA JALLERIE -** Much improved of late and won again last time out in Class F at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 30 June. Not fully barefoot this time but is not out of it

**8. KASSIE DANOVER -** Disqualified last time out at Graignes on 5 February. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**9. KATYLAND -** Unreliable but did win last time out in Class H at Luçon over 3025m on 7 July. Deserves respect

**10. KEVISE BECO** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class F at Vire over 2825m on 1 July. Needs to do more to win this race

**11. KONTESSA DREAM -** Much improved of late and was a winner last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 4 July. Can follow up

**12. KYOKA BOCNEUF -** Unreliable but was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 4 July. Might play a minor role

**13. KELLY CHALEONNAISE -** Has disqualification issues and that was the case last time out at Le Mans on 16 July. Capable of making the frame when wise

**14. KELLA DU DONJON -** Unreliable but did run well last time out when fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 4 July. Can do even better this time

**15. KOETANE D'AVRIL -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Sablé-sur-Sarthe on 30 June. Capable of better and could play a minor role

**16. KIM BLUE -** Disqualified last time out at Clairefontaine-Deauville on 14 July. Won twice earlier this year and is not out of it

**Summary:** KONTESSA DREAM (11) won nicely under this current driver last time out and has every chance of following up. KELLA DU DONJON (14) ran well over this course and distance last time out. She can contest the finish once again. KATYLAND (9) is in good shape and won last time out but is unreliable. KIM BLUE (16) faulted last time out but has a winning chance if finding her form from earlier this year.

**3. LEGENDE SEVEN -** Disqualified in class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 18 July. Won well at this distance on debut and can bounce back to score

**4. LUCKY LUMALO -** Disqualified in class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Won well in June but others are preferred

**5.** LE KADOR - Runner-up in class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 13 July. Has placed in all three career attempts. Should contest the finish

**6. LIO D'AVEL -** Runner-up in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 4 July. Deserves to go one better after both runner-up performances

**7. LORD DAIRPET -** Unreliable and was fourth in class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2650m on 11 July. Can make the frame again

**8. LUCAS DE TOURNAI -** Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 26 June. Not out of it

**3. KOENIG TEK -** Finished 5th in class H at Segre over 2700m on 15 July. Remains barefoot but has yet to win and others are preferred

**4. KIR BLOND -** Disqualified in class F at Durtal over 2825m on 14 July. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred

**5. KIF ALDO -** Showed improvement when third in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish

**6. KEL PACHA DAIRPET -** Disqualified in class F at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 14 July. Unreliable and is capable of an upset

**7. KISSABEL DE TIMM -** Disqualified in class E at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 5 February. Remains barefoot but has major disqualification issues. Best watched for now

**8. KOKTAIL DE JANZE -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class F at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2775m on 13 July. Big chance in this line-up

**9. KENZO VEETA -** Disqualified in class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 21 July. Unreliable and has disqualification issues. Others are much preferred

**10. KENNETH DU CLOS -** Finished 5th in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 10 July. Capable of better and could make the frame

**11. KAYAK GEMA -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 10 July. Yet to win and has disqualification issues. Others are preferred

**12. KOSTO DU BANOU -** Finished 6th in class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 9 July. Has won under the saddle and deserves the utmost respect

**13. KOMETE DU DESTIN -** Ran well when third in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 10 July. Improving and is not out of it

**Summary:** KOKTAIL DE JANZE (8) deserves a victory after the two recent runner-up performances and could win this lucky last race. KOSTO DU BANOU (12) has already won a race under the saddle and will not go down easily. KIF ALDO (5) showed improvement last time out and could do even better this time. KOMETE DU DESTIN (13) was not disgraced last time out and is another to consider.
