- **4. GALTON SAINT BAR -** Finished 8th in a Mounted class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 19 December. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive

- **4. LIBERTY DELO -** Disqualified in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 17 December. Must be wise to have a chance
- **5. LATINO LA MAZURE -** Unplaced in a class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 10 December. This is the third run back from a break and can get closer
- **6. LOHENGRIN -** Third in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 November. Holding form and is not out of it
- **7. LADY FLO DE MAX -** Finished 7th in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 17 December. Probably needed the latest and can play a minor role

- 1. JINGALO BABEL Lightly raced ultra-consistent performer at the top of his game and whose form references/credentials, include a 2450m Castillonnès victory in September and a creditable last-start 4th over3275m at Saumur on 20 October
- **2. JACOBSON -** Versatile but delicate trotter with undeniable means boasts sound references/form credentials in both trotting disciplines, including an improved/encouraging last-start 4th in a 3000m Nantes harness race on 16 December
- **3. JASPE -** Joined current yard/trainer after finishing 2nd in a 2850m Vincennes claimer in November and finished 4th over 2400m at Amiens for new connections on 1 December. Long-time maiden (44 starts) with place prospects
- **4. JALISKA DE LA NADE -** Experienced but unreliable mare and currently out of sorts finished 2nd over 3100m at Chinon in mid-August but unplaced in 3 subsequent starts, the latest (8th) over 2800m at Rambouillet on 6 October. Others preferred
- **5. JIMMY DU CLOS -** Acquitted himself well in both visits to this course (2nd and 5th), albeit over further. Absent since finishing 11th at Durtal on 14 July but remains open to improvement on his reappearance so must be respected keep safe
- **6. JAKIRA -** A long-time 48-start maiden with the form and experience to acquit herself competitively. Showed her form and well-being by finishing 4th over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 8 December
- **7. JUMPER DE LA NADE -** Experienced hard-knocker who seldom finishes far off the mark and whose references/form credentials include a recent 7th (didn't go unnoticed) at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- **8. JULIUS D'ALCI -** Inconsistent but retains sufficient means, especially under these conditions/in this configuration. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 10th over 2700m at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 December attractive outsider
- **9. JAMAICA DES ILES -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials seldom far off the mark, though most effective racing unshod. Disqualified in a 2600m harness race at Meslay on 19 December but remains capable of better

**Summary:** JACOBSON (2) bounced back to form with a reassuring 4th last month and will likely make the most of his ideal starting position by playing a promising role throughout. JIMMY DU CLOS (5) is returning from a rest but has shown enough in both visits to this course to make life difficult for the selection. JINGALO BABEL (1), and JORLANDO (13) are others with legitimate podium ambitions. JULIUS D'ALCI (8) appeals most of the remainder.

- **1. IP OP DE LA ROQUE -** Unplaced (soundly beaten) in 3 recent comeback appearances after a 6-month absence, albeit in harness races the latest (8th) at Mons over 2300m on 5 December. Others preferred
- **2. IRLANDO D'OR -** Delicate but versatile trotter (rarely far from a fault, though usually acquits himself well when remaining wise). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 10th in a 2750m Cabourg harness race on 17 December beware
- **3. I AM MAJYC -** Won a 2800m mounted race at Vire under Amélie Poulain last month but was disqualified in both subsequent outings, the latest under the saddle at Mesly over 2875m on 19 December. Question of wisdom
- **4. IRIS RENARDIER -** Complicated but versatile veteran mare with sound references under the saddle, which include a reassuring last-start 4th on this course in a 2875m amateur race on 15 December. More needed
- **5. IRAFARA -** Disqualified 4 times and finished unplaced 3 times in her 7 appearances after back-to-back victories under the saddle. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2725m harness race at Cabourg on 19 December attractive outsider
- **6. IDO MENDY -** Won a 2750m mounted race at Cabourg in July but struggled since disqualified 5 times in 8 subsequent starts and finished unplaced in his other 3 outings, the latest (9th) in a 2850m Mauquenchy harness on 3 December
- **7. INTIME COTERIE -** Veteran hard-knocker with sound references under the saddle in this shoeing configuration. Didnt go unnoticed when 6th (shod) in a course-and-distance amateur race on 15 December respected with front shoes removed
- **8. INTREPIDE NEMO -** Experienced hard-knocker with references under these conditions/with this configuration in mounted races at a higher level. Unplaced (9th) over 3000m at Nantes on 3 December but retains the means to fare better here
- **9. IVANHOE DU CLOS -** A winner of his last 3 appearances under the saddle, 2 in this shoeing configuration (the latest on 19 November). Disqualified in a harness race over 2700m at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 December in preparing for this engagement
- **10. HORACIO DU MONT -** Rarely seen in this code but has performed well under the saddle. Switches to the mounted category now after 4 consecutive unplaced harness appearances the latest (soundly beaten) at Les Andelys on 15 September
- **11. HINSERT MAHCATH -** Enigmatic trotter disqualified in 6 of his last 7 starts, including back-to-back (both) comeback appearances the latest (6 December) in a 3150m harness race at Saint-Brieuc. Confirmed under the saddle, question of wisdom
- **12. IKEM DU GERS -** Versatile trotter with the form and experience under the saddle to acquit himself competitively. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 10th in a harness race over 2700m at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 December danger
- **13. ILVICA DE HOUELLE -** Complicated veteran mare disqualified in 5 of her last 8 appearances, including back-to-back recent starts the latest over 2700m at Vincennes on 12 December. Question of wisdom

- **14. IDEAL D'URZY -** Experienced trotter (in the harness category) who made a winning start under the saddle over 2700m at Laval in November. Showed his form and well-being by finishing 3rd (barefoot) in a 2650m harness race at Bordeaux on 17 December and returns to this mounted code with legitimate winning ambitions
- **15. IVRE DE TOI -** Seldom far from a fault but usually acquits herself competitively when applied/remaining wise (boasts the form and experience to play a leading role). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her failure in a course-and-distance event on 15 December
- **16. HOLD UP CRAZY -** Consistent and versatile veteran trotter maintaining remarkable consistency alternating between the 2 codes. Showed his form and well-being with a creditable 5th in a 2875m mounted race at Meslay on 19 December

**Summary:** Judged on the evidence of his winning mounted debut, IDEAL D'URZY (14) has a bright future in this code and it could pay to follow his progress back under the saddle. IVRE DE TOI (15), for whom this will remain a question of wisdom, can threaten the selection if avoiding disqualification, while IVANHOE DU CLOS (9) is another with the means to acquit himself competitively on his return to the mounted category. Beyond those principle contenders, HINSERT MAHCATH (11) and IKEM DU GERS (12) complete the shortlist.

- 2. INVISIBLE D'ISI Regained form/momentum recently confirmed the improvement of his Cordemais 4th by finishing 6th over 2550m at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 20 December. Dark horse
- **3. IRELAND TEAM -** Complicated but not devoid of ability seldom far from a fault but usually acquits himself competitively when applied/remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed (7th) in a 2700m Le Croisé-Laroche harness race on 16 December
- **4. IDYLLE MIKA -** Disqualified (plated) over 2750m at Cabourg on 7 December but is confirmed under these conditions/with this shoeing configuration. Respected with her shoes removed for this commitment
- **5. INTERACTION -** Rarely seen in this barefoot configuration but showed her form an well-being with an improved/reassuring 2nd (unshod) in a 2750m harness event at Cabourg on 7 December. Candidate for success

- **18. ILIO MANNETOT -** Well-performed trotter with the undeniable means (form and experience) to play a leading role. Proved his form and well-being by finishing 5th in a 1700m Quinte+harness race at Vincennes on 14 December on the shortlist

**Summary:** Carefully prepared for this commitment, ILLICO PRESTO FAC (15) is hard to oppose, especially under the conditions he will find to his liking. Rejuvenated INTERACTION (5) and hard-knocker ILIO MANNETOT (18) are best equipped to challenge the selection. They lead the opposition ahead of proven right-hander ISA DES LANDES (12) and ILLICO DE VAU (10), who is an attractive outsider.

## C8 - PRIX DE L'ORNE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- **1. FLIGHT COMMODORE** Inconsistent performer who continues to blow hot and cold but didn't go unnoticed (3rd) in a 2700m amateur race at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 December. Dark horse
- **2. GALAXIE DU PARC -** Experienced veteran mare of 113 appearances (with 5 wins). Confirmed under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration but must improve to have a say here finished 9th over 3000m at Châteaubriant on 11 November
- **3. HUNMEC SOMOLLI -** Honest hard-knocker whose best recent references/performances were achieved at a lower level, which include a 2nd at Mauqeunchy and last-start 5th at Laval over 2850m in amateur races. For lovers of outsiders
- **4. HAVA DE BEAUREGARD -** Ultra-consistent veteran mare with sound references/form credentials with this barefoot shoeing configuration, including a last-start 2nd over 3150m at Saint-Brieuc on 6 December. Not taken lightly
- **5. GAVOTTE DU PRATEL -** Veteran mare with sound references and undeniable means (form and experience) under the conditions/in this shoeing configuration but currently out of sorts. Unplaced (9th) over 2950m at Le Mans on 16 December
- **6. HELSINKI GIRL -** Inconsistent but retains sufficient means, especially under these conditions/in this configuration. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 8th over 2550m at Bordeaux on 24 November dark horse
- **7. HARTFORD -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration, though out of sorts at present. Finished 10th (shod) on this course over 2150m on 15 December best watched for now
- **8. HIP HOP DE CHENU -** Honest hard-knocker whose physical condition and encouraging recent form will stand him in good stead here. Finished 3rd in consecutive recent starts, the latest over 2050m at Lyon-La Soie on 11 December keep safe
- **9. HARRY DE MIENNAIS -** Game frontrunner who wouldn't be winning out of turn after finishing 2nd in consecutive recent appearances, the latest over 2550m at Beaumont on 20 December. Will be hard to peg back if allowed an uncontested lead
- **10. HELIA DE BAFFAIS -** Consistent, in good form and physical condition, ideally engaged at the first level and is confirmed under these conditions/in this unshod shoeing configuration. Worth another chance despite finishing 9th at Vire over 2800m on 20 November
- **11. HISTORY MAJYC -** Veteran hard-knocker with sound references at a higher level, including a last-start 6th over 2850m in a Quinte+ at Vincennes on 13 December, but is most effective without her irons (unshod) so best watched for now
- **12. GITANE DU RIB -** Versatile trotter with undeniable means (form and experience) but is currently out of sorts disqualified under the saddle in a 2700m mounted race at Graignes on 23 November. For another day
- **13. HETRE D'OURVILLE -** Regaining momentum after a 5-month absence and confirmed as much with an improved/encouraging 2nd at Saint-Brieuc over 2500m on 3 November. Will play a leading role if repeating that performance

- **14. HAPPY FACE -** Consistent hard-knocker with sound form references under these conditions/in this unshod configuration at a higher level, including a last-start 5th over 2100m at Vincennes on 2 December. Candidate for success
- **15. HADRIEN -** Well-performed trotter (13 wins from 48 starts) with sound references at a higher level, including a last-start 3rd (unshod) at Pornichet over 2725m on 21 September. Races shod on his reappearance so is best watched for now
- **16. HAILEY D'OURVILLE -** Consistent hard-knocker with solid form references under these conditions and with this unshod configuration at a higher level, including a last-start 6th over 2750m at Cabourg on 17 December. Keep safe
- **17. GAMIN DES ISLES -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references at a higher level although most effective racing without irons (unshod). Finished 13th (shod) over 2950m at Le Mans on 16 December others preferred
- **18. HOLD UP DES VENTES -** Well-performed trotter but no longer the force of old unplaced in all 5 appearances this year, the latest (13th) in a 2750m harness event at Cabourg on 17 December.

**Summary:** HARRY DE MIENNAIS (9) is a proven frontrunner and will be hard to beat if allowed an uncontested lead. Class-dropper HAPPY FACE (14) and HETRE D'OURVILLE (13), who spearheads Virginie Moquet's charge, are other legitimate candidates for success, with HELIA DE BAFFAIS (10) best of the rest. In-form HIP HOP DE CHENU (8) has place prospects too.
