- **1. JONQUILLE D'AIMTE -** Improving all the while, latterly successful in a 2775m Class F at Les Sables d'Olonne 10 days ago. Gabi Gelormini reining this time and will be no soft touch
- **2. JILIKA DU MESLE -** Maintained her decent form when 5th of 10 in an 1800m Class E at La Capelle 3 weeks ago. Should take well to Enghien profile and prove a decent place prospect
- **3. JURELLA DE PALM -** Raced well to finish 6th of 12 finishers in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late-June. Sports modified shoeing and should be good enough to challenge for victory this time
- **4. DONNER AMOUR -** 9th of 13 finishers, on comeback, in a 2100m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Is reunited with JMB for her Enghien debut and can be assured a competitive drive. Place chance
- **5. JACINTHE DE DAIDOU -** Returned to winning ways 2 weeks ago in a 2475m Francheville Class F, but will struggle to repeat
- **6. JAVA DES CAILLONS -** Good, consistent mare that made short work of a 2050m Cabourg Class F on 2 July and looks thoroughly capable of pulling off the double
- **7. MISS JAJA -** Starts for the first time since coming last of 9 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E mid-May. Shoes off for comeback but others still preferred
- **8. JAMINISTAR -** Disappointing on the whole this term, most recently last but one in a 2100m Pornichet Class E 9 days ago. Receives an Eric Raffin drive for the occasion but still not an obvious choice
- **9. JOHANA DU GUESCLIN -** Showed improvement when 4th of 9 finishers in a 2150m Argentan Class E mid-month, but with shoes back on will have less to contribute
- **10. JALNA DU PALAIS -** Races barefoot for the occasion after faulting in a 2150m Biarritz monté Class F 11 days ago. Is better in the other code and can be passed over

Summary: Consistently in the thick of things when focused, JAVA DES CAILLONS (6) flew up at Cabourg last time out and can double her money if she takes to the new conditions. David Thomain will still be wary of the Enghien-loving JURELLA DE PALM (3) who is competitively-shod for the first time, and JILIKA DU MESLE (2) who has been knocking at the door over recent months. Solid in Paris over the winter, DONNER AMOUR (4) has one race in her and with JMB reining must be respected.

- **2. LILI DRY -** Unraced since coming 6th of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Class A on 21 May. Has other priorities and not an obvious choice
- 3. L'AS DESBOIS Complicated but talented colt that ran 2nd of 9 in a 2150m Class C here 2 weeks ago. Moves up in category but is a progressive type and will be expected to figure prominently
- **4. LADY QUEEN -** Got off the mark with a superb Class C performance over course and distance on 3 July. Has never failed to fire at Enghien and with Mathieu Mottier in the wagon, will be no shrinking violet
- **5. LIBERTINE DJOB -** Has not been seen out since finishing last but one in a 2450m Caen monté Gr.2 early-May. Disregard
- **6. LAKARA -** Progressive filly starting for the first time since coming 4th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 6 months ago. Shoes on and no threat this time
- **7. LAPIS LAZULI -** Useful sort making first appearance since finishing 6th of 7 in a 2100m Gr.3 across town in early-February. Shoes on again and best to wait
- **8. LUSH LIFE -** Serious filly but sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 on 7 June. Just hind pads fitted this time and, even with application, looks no more than a minor place prospect
- **9. LOVE LETTER -** Failed to live up to expectations when last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 early-June. Has considerable ability, is Group-class material, and even racing shod looks a major player
- **10. LIPANGA DE GUEZ -** Unluckily sanctioned when denied a run in a 2150m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Showed her form though and, with application, can play a small part
- **11. LIGHT MY FIRE -** Quality individual whose last of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 early-June should not be taken at face value. Won his only start at the venue and is not incapable of returning home with his Enghien record intact
- **12. LIZY JOSSELYN -** Tricky filly that trailed in last of 8 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 early last month and is not about to buck the trend

Summary: Oddly below-par in a Vincennes Gr.3 after having imposed with ease on his penultimate start, Franck Nivard stays faithful to LIGHT MY FIRE (11) who looks a marginally better bet than the well-engaged LOGAN JIEL (14) who pleasantly surprised in the Gr.3 Prix de Rome here earlier in the month. LOVE LETTER (9) is significantly better than her recent performance would imply, races shod this time, and Julien Dubois will be out to set the record straight. L'AS DESBOIS (3) consistently gives what he can and deserves to take his chances at this level.

- **2. KATSUKI -** 5th of 14, at 50/1, in a 2150m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Did catch the eye that day though and, competitively-shod from the 2-spot, is not to be ignored
- **3. KEN ZAO DE NAPPES -** Useful, but complicated, colt that lost his action after just a few-hundred metres into a 2650m Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 weeks ago. Has obvious ability, enjoys a good place behind the car, and will have his supporters
- **4. KAMIL VAN HALBEEK -** Promising future prospect that came 10th, behind KATSUKI (2), on re-entry in a 2150m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run, is reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois, and looks a player
- **5. KRONOS D'ERPION -** 7th of 10, when preparing for this, in a 2900m Clairefontaine Class D last weekend. Takes a notable step up in category though and, in this field, will have his work cut out
- **6. KABIR BEDI -** Failed to pull off the hat-trick when sanctioned early in a 2650m Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne a fortnight ago. JMB reining this time and must be taken seriously
- **7. KEOPS BEGONIA -** Makes Enghien, and left-handed, debut after securing the hat-trick in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 9 July. Should take well to the Enghien profile and can win this if he turns
- **8. KEEN ON ME -** Not once out of first 2 when applied, latterly runner-up to KISS YOU PIYA (13) in a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 9 July. Starts wide in front but may just have the advantage this time around. Claim
- **9. KENNEDY FRANCE -** 4th of 11 finishers in a 2850m Carentan Class E a fortnight ago. Placed here 2 months ago but has a lot more to find
- **10. KHEOPS BOURBON -** Clearly in form but briefly faulted, coming 9th of 14, in 6 July Enghien race of reference. Gets on well with Mathieu Mottier and, despite the draw, can put things right

KERU DE LOU (15) is close to his best and must also be considered a live chance.

- **2. HARLEM DE BUCY -** 4th to GASPAR D'ANGIS (7) in a Gr.3 over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Plainly in form but nevertheless needs to take his game up a level
- **3. GALILEO BELLO -** Scored a 2nd straight when victorious in a 2925m Cagnes Class A on 8 July. In better company this time and although unlikely to pull off the hat-trick should nevertheless acquit himself honourably
- **4. FAKIR DE MAHEY -** Raced better in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3, behind GASPAR D'ANGIS (7), late-June than the result would suggest, but still has more to find
- **5. GAMAY DE L'ITON -** Has looked ordinary lately, most recently 6th in Prix de Washington. Is clearly on the way back up though and, with hind shoes back on, is eminently capable of making first 5
- **6. FULTON -** Won a monté Gr.3 over course and distance on 10 July. Has other priorities and can be ruled out
- **7. GASPAR D'ANGIS -** Fine winner of a Gr.3 over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has won 2 of 3 here and Eric Raffin will be out to apply the pressure on AMPIA MEDE SM (13)
- **8. GANAY DE BANVILLE -** Admirable 5th of 12 in 2100m Gr.1 Prix René Ballière over 2100m at Vincennes on 23 June. Will appreciate the drop in class and looks more a place chance this time around
- **9. JUSHUA TREE -** High-class trotter making first appearance since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 last February. Shoes on for the occasion but still has the class to finish in the mix

- **2. GIUSEPPE -** Never at his ease before being sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Class C on 21 June. 4th to EXTREME DESBOIS (12) here earlier in the season but will not be easy to trust
- **3. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY -** Lost his action in a 2750m Cabourg Class D a fortnight ago. Springs the occasional surprise but is new to the venue and unlikely to shake things up
- **4. GAVROCHE BEST -** Sanctioned at Laval before finishing 11th in race of reference and is unlikely to make his presence felt
- **5. GEGE DE FROMENTEL -** Simply superb in this branch of the business, most recently imposing over track and trip before trotting 3rd of 15 in a 2800m Langon harness Class D 9 days ago. Hind shoes off and, if still on the boil, can finish in the mix
- **6. GADGET DU GADE -** Won over Vincennes short course on 21 June before finishing last but one in a 2700m Gr.3 at the same venue a week later. Drops back in category but others still preferred

- **3. JASPER PIYA -** Drops in category after coming 8th of 14 finishers in a 2100m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Handed an excellent draw and will be competitive for a first-5 payday

- **11. GOLDEN GRACE -** Encouraging 6th of 13 finishers in a 2950m Le Mans Class E mid-month. David Thomain drafted in for the occasion and is not incapable of picking up a minor place cheque
- **12. GUCCI DE BARB -** Beaten only by a very good horse here earlier in the month before trotting 4th in Lignières race of reference. Unlikely to get his nose in front but will be competitive for a slice of the pie
- **13. FAUCON DE L'ALBA -** Pleasant 3rd of 13 in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Steps up in category and others easier to support this time
- **14. GARANCIO BELLO -** Sanctioned early in a 3100m Royan Class A 2 weeks ago. Eric Raffin reining for first time but still not easy to make a case
- **15. FIGARO GEMA -** Pleased twice here over past month but sanctioned in a 3450m Agon-Coutainville Class E a fortnight ago and the draw only compounds matters
- **16. GALIE DE CELINIERE -** 9th of 13 in a 2950m Le Mans Class E 11 days ago. Handed a dreadful draw and has no realistic chance

Summary: Unlucky to lose his action here last month, GERSHWIN DE CHENU (3) subsequently reassured at Lignières last weekend and barefoot, ideally-placed in front, and entrusted to Mathieu Mottier, can finally open his 2024 account. It's not a done deal though even if the hattrick-seeking FAVICI PASMARICK (8) is forced to break wide. Hard to knock when unshod, GAI MATIN (5) is well-positioned on the front line, while Alexandre Abrivard drives GAROU PIERJI (7) who has an appreciation for the Enghien profile.

- **1. KATIM DU GOUTIER -** In the mix for the most part, latterly 5th of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes Class B late-May. Shoes on this time and best to hold off
- **2. KENO PETTEVINIERE -** Pleasant 4th of 8, on return to competition, in a 2200m Vichy Class B mid-June. Has had time to recuperate, goes first time barefoot, and should not be ignored
- **3. KARAKA WOOD -** Made up for her return sanction when winning a 2425m Jullianges Class E a fortnight ago. Goes first time barefoot and, while not a priority, should nevertheless hold her own
- **4. KATAR** Bested just once in 4 when padded all around, most recently trouncing the opposition in a Class C over course and distance on 3 July, and repeating is not out of the question
- **5. KILLER QUEEN -** Reassured with victory at Vichy before coming 3rd of 9 in a 2650m Saint-Galmier Class B late-June. Pleased on her only Enghien appearance and must be worth retaining for a spot in first 5
- **6. KONFINEE -** Drops back in class after running 11th of 14, on re-entry, in a 2150m Gr.3 here a week ago. Sports a new configuration, will be reined by Alexandre Abrivard, but others still preferred
- **7. KARMA QUICK -** Classy colt that cruised to victory in a 2150m Class C here 2 weeks ago, on just 2nd start back, and a similar performance would see him double up
- **8. KAPORAL DES FORGES -** Honest colt that bit off more than he could chew in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 early last month. Has freshness on his side and will be competitive for a place on the podium
- **9. KOKOTE -** Difficult to knock when focused and unshod, as she showed when securing a 2150m Class C here on 10 July, and looks principal danger to KAPORAL DES FORGES (8)

Summary: A fine servant when he can keep his action together, KARMA QUICK (7) met no opposition over shorter here a fortnight ago and will take all the beating. The well-engaged KOKOTE (9) also won over 2150m here earlier in the month and will be no soft touch either. Twice a winner in 4 starts this year, KATAR (4) imposed over course and distance, with authority, last time and is similarly in with a shout. KAPORAL DES FORGES (8) drops back to a more reasonable level and can put his recent group-race blip behind him.
