- **3. KAZA ROCK -** Returned to form with a reassuring 3rd (unshod) over 2700m at Graignes on 2 September. Races shod here so is best watched for now
- **4. KING DRY -** Inconsistent but is undeniably capable. Won 3 consecutive completed outings (4 starts) in this configuration before a disappointing last-start 7th over 2400m at Beaumont on 9 September can do better

- **2. JINGLE GEDE -** Disqualified in 5 of 7 starts this year, including 3 consecutive recent appearances the latest over 2700m at La Capelle on 13 September
- **3. JADIS PRIOR -** Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials seldom far off the mark, though most effective when unshod. Didnt go unnoticed when 4th (barefoot) over 2625m at Agen on 15 September
- **4. JAMBALAYA -** Tricky customer with sound form references/credentials and undeniable means. Not hastily condemned after a recent failure at Arras on 22 September
- **5. JURA -** Delicate but has undeniable means and is most effective in this (barefoot) configuration. Finished 12th (shod) on his return from a break at Dieppe on 18 September but should fare better here under these conditions

- **3. JAVA PURA VIDA -** Has made no impression in 7 appearances this year disqualified once and unplaced in 6 completed outings, including her latest (10th) over 2800m at Langon on 18 July
- **4. JIKOA EFJI -** Delicate but has regained momentum recently and confirmed as much by finishing 3rd in consecutive starts, the latest over 2400m at Beaumont on 3 September. Keep safe
- **5. JATILUWIH -** Delicate, rarely far from a fault but confirmed under these conditions has sound references/form credentials in this configuration, including a last-start 5th Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 8 September. A winning chance
- **6. JULIETTE D'ELLE -** Adapted well to the southwest and has confirmed as much by finishing4th in consecutive recent outings, the latest over 2300m at Marseille-Borely on 11 September. Candidate for success

- **2. JOGGER KILY -** Finished 6th (shod) in his only appearance under the saddle but has performed consistently/competitively in harness races since in this (barefoot) configuration was over 2800m at Langon on 21 September. Keep safe
- **3. JAZZ PASSION -** Last-start winner over 2450m at Castillonnès on 8 September. Gets along well with his partner and will remain competitive for victory
- **4. JAGERSRO -** Has demonstrated commendable consistency, winning twice and finishing 2nd four times in his last 6 starts. Runner-up over 2225m at Lannemezan on 21 August
- **5. ISIS DU LEARD -** Delicate and seldom far from a fault but need only avoid disqualification to play a leading role. Disqualified in consecutive recent starts, the latest over 2850m at Mauquenchy on 12 September a question of wisdom
- **6. FEELING MESLOIS -** Versatile veteran with sound references and sufficient means in the mounted category. Back under the saddle after finishing 3rd in a 2575m amateur harness race at Agen on 15 September

Summary: Consistent JAGERSRO (4) is ideally engaged and seems likely to reconnect with success after finishing 2nd in his hat-trick bid last time. However, he'll have to thwart the expected challenge of last-start winner JAZZ PASSION (3) and JOGGER KILY (2), who isn't taken lightly on his return to the mounted category. Versatile ICARE WILLIAMS (10) and enigmatic ISIS DU LEARD (5) arent without chances either and shouldn't be hastily condemned for last-start disqualifications. Good race!
