- **2. MYRTILLE MARBOULA -** Surprise winner of a 2625m Cherbourg claimer 3 weeks ago. Faces a very different challenge this time and a minor place prospect at best
- **3. MEGANE DE CERISY -** Sanctioned early in a 2050m Cabourg Class D mid-month. Trainer reining this time and others preferred

- **12. IQUEM -** Disappointing in 2 before being sanctioned in a 2850m Parilly Class C 2.5 weeks ago. Shod this time, and even with Mathieu Mottier in the bike, is hard to recommend
- **13. INFIEL -** Races barefoot for harness return, most recently sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class E earlier in the month. Seldom disappoints here when focused though and should not be ignored
- **14. INSIGHT SPOKEN -** 5th of 11, when being conditioned, in a 2150m Class C here last weekend. Hind shoes off this time and, while unlikely to impose, can nevertheless make first 5

Summary: Already winner of two straight at Vincennes this month, and one of the most generous horses here, INHERIT (9) sports 4 pads this time but can still pull off the hat-trick. Runner-up to him mid-month, despite traffic problems, IOUPY TOLLEVILLE (11) can again play a prominent role, but may first have to see off ILEO PIERJI (6) who would have finished 2nd had he not lost his action in the final stages. ILIO MANNETOT (1) is considerably better than recent numbers would suggest and looks competitively well-in here.
