C1 - PRIX DE CONDAT - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 42,000

- **1. IONA GENDREENNE -** Imposed at Segré before being sanctioned in a Class E over course and distance 12 days ago. Evidently in super shape but, in this category, will have limited prospects
- **2. IL MAGNIFICO -** Debuts in the discipline after running 6th of 10 in a Class E over course and distance a fortnight ago. Has merit but finds himself in better company here and will struggle to make his mark
- **3. IDEAL D'ARTONGES -** Defied his 29/1 to come 3rd to IQUEM NARCY (5) over course and distance mid-month. Sports a new configuration but a repeat nevertheless seems improbable
- **4. ITALIA JADOR -** Pleased here late-October before coming 8th of 11 in a 2850m Laval harness Class E conditioner 11 days ago. Appears to have a future in this branch of the business and should again make first 5
- **5. IQUEM NARCY -** Won 2 of last 3, most recently with authority over course and distance midmonth. Takes on a better field this time but the nature of his recent romp bodes well for his chances
- **6. IQUITA VILI -** 3rd to IN LOVE DE BLARY (11) at Mauquenchy before coming 4th of 14 in a 3000m Nantes Class G 10 days ago. Not short of Vincennes references and is worth keeping an eye on
- **7. IBILI D'OCCAGNES -** 7th of 10 to IN LOVE DE BLARY (11) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E conditioner 2.5 weeks ago. Seldom lets the side down over 2700m here and, barefoot this time, must not be discounted
- **8. IRON SPIRIT -** Returns to his code of preference after finishing 11th of 14 in a 2100m harness Class E here last week. At this level though, will have little to contribute
- 9. ISABELLA DIMJY Clearly back in the game, most recently 3rd of 8 in a 2175m Class D here on 14 November. Has a particular liking for the main track and, with application, is not incapable of spoiling the party
- **10. ILEO PIERJI -** 10th of 13, when preparing for this, in a 2875m Enghien harness Class D a month ago. Appreciates these conditions and appears to have a good hand to play
- **11. IN LOVE DE BLARY -** Tenacious winner of a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is a serious type in this branch of the business and will be expected to bring the fight to ICARE DU LEARD (13)
- **12. IMOKO ATOUT -** Superb winner of a 2850m Maure harness Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Is new to the ridden code but is plainly in shape and will generate some interest
- **13. ICARE DU LEARD -** Has 2 runs under his belt, latterly 11th of 13 in a 3300m Chartres harness Class F 10 days ago. Has nothing to prove at this level, or over track and trip and, if applied, can finally open his 2024 account

Summary: A tough nut to crack when barefoot and focused, ICARE DU LEARD (13) enjoys a terrific entry here and, considering his liking for these conditions, can get straight down to business. Even though yet to impress under the saddle over 2700m here, IN LOVE DE BLARY (11) made quite the statement of intent last time out and is unlikely to go down easily. Facile winner over course and distance mid-month, IQUEM NARCY (5) is very easy to like, as is ILEO PIERJI (10) who has never disappointed over course and distance.

- **1. MOON DES CHARRONS -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2875m Enghien Class B a month ago, and is unlikely to generate much interest
- **2. MOON STAR -** Unexceptional last of 8, on debut, in a 2275m Nantes Class F a month ago. Mathieu Mottier reining this time but still not an obvious choice
- **3. MAGIE DE CHAHAINS -** Sanctioned, on return from a break, in a 2250m Auch Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and is not about to spring any surprises
- **4. MYGIRL DES FORGES -** 6th of 9, behind MARIE OH FREDLAU (12), in a 2200m Class D here late-October, and has a lot more to find this time
- **5. MA BELLA DE JED -** Placed in first 2 but showed her limits earlier this month when 7th of 8 to MAGDA DE VANDEL (7) in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and can be passed over
- **6. MADONE DU TRIEUX -** 2nd at Cabourg before being sanctioned in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has evident ability but others easier to trust
- **7. MAGDA DE VANDEL -** Confirmed good qualification with success on debut in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and will have her chances if she goes left-handed
- **8. MOUSTACHE -** Made up for Cabourg sanction when 2nd of 11 in a 2050m Laval Class F 11 days ago, but cannot be considered more than a minor place prospect
- **9. MASTERCLASS D'EARL -** 4th of 11, a place behind MAESTRIA GALAA (15), in a 2850m Class D over inner track a fortnight ago. Has done everything asked of her so far and a similar performance would see her confirm
- **10. MISS DE LA COTE -** Qualified well before confirming with victory in a 2400m Amiens Class E a month ago. Takes on a tougher challenge this time but still looks up to the task
- **11. MOUSKIE DE GUEZ -** Takes to the main track after 2 straight sanctions, most recently a 2850m Class D over the short course a fortnight ago. Not easy to handle but, with application, will not be going home empty-handed
- **12. MARIE OH FREDLAU -** Held her own when 4th of 9 in a 2200m Class D here late-October. Entrusted to David Thomain for the occasion and will not be available at 47/1 this time
- **13. MERRY -** Disappointing since winning on debut during the summer, most recently 8th of 11, behind MAESTRIA GALAA (15), in a 2850m Class D over inner track a fortnight ago, and has nothing to offer

Summary: In the frame in 2 of 3 to date, the well-engaged MAESTRIA GALAA (15) moves to the main track this time and should have the wherewithal to lose that maiden status. She will still come under pressure from MYSTIQUE LADY (14) who has shown considerable potential, and MAGDA DE VANDEL (7) who won first time out with Alexandre Abrivard earlier this month. Similarly successful on debut, MISS DE LA COTE (10) will not be far off the mark if she takes to the new profile.

- **1. KLASSIC FROMENTRO -** Should not be too hastily-condemned for running 6th of 9, behind KILLER FOR LOVA (6), in a Class E over course and distance last week. Is clearly capable and the 8kg allowance will do him no harm
- 2. KRACKSMAN Returns to a code he likes after finishing 8th of 12 in a harness Class D under these conditions earlier this month. Has solid main-track references but is being aimed too high this time
- **3. KILT -** Useful element that was sanctioned in a 2175m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Revised shoeing but must first reaffirm
- **4. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE -** Encouraging 3rd of 9, a place behind KILLER FOR LOVA (6), in a Class E under these conditions last week. Has more to find but can still get a look-in
- **5. KING DE PLAY -** Runner-up in 2 before coming 10th of 12 in a harness Class D over course and distance earlier this month. In this category, though, will have limited chances
- **6. KILLER FOR LOVA -** 2nd of 9, on return to the code, in a Class E under these conditions last week and, if not a flash in the pan, can make first 5
- **7. KIKI AND CO -** 9th of 12 in a 2850m harness Class A conditioner here last Friday. Faces his first goal of the winter and can pull it off if Christophe Corbineau keeps him focused
- **8. KING TEJY -** Unlucky 7th of 9, when preparing for this, in a 2850m Laval harness Class A 11 days ago. Would be preferred unshod for return to the discipline though
- **9. KIKI DU ROC -** Good, consistent type that came 4th of 9 in a 2175m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Has previously imposed under these conditions and can again finish close

Summary: Terrific winner over course and distance last time in the discipline, KIKI AND CO (7) has been specifically prepared for this, races unshod-behind, and even in the absence of Alexandre Abrivard can win this. Christopher Corbineau will nonetheless be justifiably wary of KEPHYR D'ESTE (12) who mad short work of the opposition on his recent comeback, and the talented, and reconfigured, KOH I NOOR (13) who could not have asked for a better entry on his monté bow. KIKI DU ROC (9) returns to his preferred distance and it will not be long before he returns to the winners' enclosure too.

- 2. JUSQUINE FOUTEAU Runner-up at Enghien before coming 3rd of 15 in a 2700m Class E here 2.5 weeks ago. Is plainly in shape and although not a leading contender, should still not be overlooked
- **3. JOIE D'AMOUR -** Got back in the game 3.5 weeks ago when easily winning a 2725m Graignes Class E. Has previously scored under these conditions and from the 3-spot is unlikely to disappoint. First 5
- **4. JURELLA -** Takes on first objective of new season after being sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2875m Enghien Class D a month back. Has everything going for her here and, on good behaviour, can open her winter account
- **5. JAFLOSA GIRL -** Returns to her preferred distance after running 9th of 13 in a 2700m Class D here last week. Damien Bonne reining this time and must be considered a legitimate contender
- **6. JUVAMINE RENARDIER -** Reassuring 3rd of 15 in a 2200m Caen Class D on 20 October. Pleased last time over track and trip and the draw will do her chances no disservice
- **7. JIRELLITA -** Sanctioned in a 2700m monté Class D here last week. Has been out of sorts for some time and even though reconfigured, will have few friends
- **8. JOIE INTENSE -** Disappointing in 3 so far this term, latterly 13th of 15, behind JUSQUINE FOUTEAU (2), in a 2700m Class E here 2.5 weeks ago. Breaks wide and others preferred

- **2. LOLLIPOP CHANLECY -** Consistent filly that ran 3rd of 7, a place behind LOUVE ANGEL (4), in a 2175m Class D here on 18 November. Fitted with pads for just 2nd time and is not incapable of making her presence felt
- **3. LAURENCIA BELLA -** Unremarkable 5th of 7, behind LOUVE ANGEL (4), in a 2175m Class D here on 18 November, and will have nothing to contribute
- **4. LOUVE ANGEL -** Made up for Enghien sanction when 2nd of 7 in a 2175m Class D here on 18 November. Not a priority but races with pads this time and will not be available at 122/1
- **5. LUDMILA DETE -** Has won 2 of 3 under the saddle, most recently a 2875m Enghien Class D with ease a month ago. Takes on a better lot this time but still has a reasonable shot of finishing close
- **6. LEIA PRINCESS -** Sanctioned when plainly going well in a 2175m Class D here last week. Has shown significant potential and Benjamin Rochard is unlikely to allow the same thing to happen again. Place chance
- **7. LOLA DAIRPET -** Quality element making first appearance since running 2nd of 9 in a 2250m Enghien Class C last July, and will need the run

LEIA PRINCESS (6) was sanctioned here recently but still showed her form and, front pads fitted this time, will have her chances. LILOU TREMBLADAISE (1) opened her monté account at the first time of asking and will be no easy touch if she takes to the Vincennes profile.

- **5. LARGO DE JOUDES -** Respectable 4th of 12, behind LORIE DE LA PRADE (3), in a 2150m Enghien claimer on 19 October. Is plainly better than that and can finish closer this time
- **6. LUCK AND JOY -** Last of 13, behind LISA DE CHANLECY (9), in a 2150m Enghien Class D a month ago. Has references at this level but latest numbers do little to inspire confidence
- **7. LOBBY MESLOIS -** Sanctioned in a 2175m monté Class D here last week. No star under harness but with front pads fitted for first time, should not be underestimated
- **8. LOU D'ECHAL -** Returns to claiming category after finishing last but one in a 2950m Toulouse Class E a week ago. Is new to Vincennes, faces a better bunch this time, and others preferred

- **4. LEXCELLENT DU METZ -** Undefeated in 2 starts, most recently a 2000m Rambouillet Class F early last month. Faces a stiffer challenge here but has yet to show his full potential and looks the one to beat
- **5. LOOKING D'AURCY -** Back under harness after being sanctioned early in a 2200m monté Class E here mid-month. JMB back in the bike but others still easier to trust
- **6. LAOS JIEL -** Missed out by little in a 2550m Reims Class E a fortnight ago. Debuts at Vincennes in good company, but is an honest colt and will again give everything he has

- **16. ISLA MUJERES -** 8th of 11 in a 2825m Chartres Class F early this month. Has not been up to scratch lately, and races with front pads, but is confirmed in the amateur category and could pleasantly surprise

Summary: Sanctioned in his last two, but nevertheless useful at a superior level, IF DE LA COUDRE (6) makes just his second appearance in the amateur division, but starts in front and the 25m advantage may just be enough to hold off the consistent HUDSON BAIE (15) who takes a notable dip in class. Hard to knock in this category, IDAO CASH (4) reassured last time out, while GLAXO LEMAN (5) makes his Vincennes debut in his class of choice.
