- **1. ICAMORA DE HOUELLE -** Continues to push her limits. Reeled off a hat-trick of wins (1 harness, 2 mounted) before her disqualification at this venue on 14 May not incapable of making amends
- **2. FINGER DE RODREY -** Disqualified in four consecutive outings, including all three 2024 appearances the latest over 2450m at Caen on 11 May. Hard to make a case for
- **3. GLADYS DU CEDRE -** Hard-knocking veteran mare who seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th at Enghien over 2875m on 20 April
- **4. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY -** Bounced back to form with a last-start victory under the saddle over 2700m at this venue on 14 May. Will have a say
- **5. DAHLIA DU PONT -** Has made no impression in all 6 appearances this year, the latest (14th) in a 2700m harness race at this venue on 24 May. Others preferred
- **6. FALCON D'ESPACE -** Unplaced in all three comeback outings in harness races this year. Reverts to the mounted code after finishing 7th in a 2950m Quinte+ at Vichy on 6 May
- **7. EXTREME DESBOIS -** Inconsistent veteran with sound references under the saddle when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th over 2450m at Caen on 11 May in this shoeing configuration
- **8. GAIN ULTIME -** Unreliable performer with inconsistent recent form, although does have sound references at this level. Needs to improve after finishing 10th over 2450m at Caen on 11 May
- **9. GO OR NOT -** Admirable veteran trotter with 15 victories under the saddle. Rarely disappoints with this shoeing configuration (barefoot) and caught the eye last time when 6th (shod) over 3000m at Marseille-Borely on 17 May
- **10. FORAIN JENILOU** Hard-knocking veteran with sound references under the saddle, including twice victories earlier this year won over 2175m at this venue in February. Has lost his way since and only finished 12th at Caen (2450m) on 11 May
- **11. GALANT GALAA -** Caught the eye on his debut in the mounted code last winter. Back under the saddle with all 4 shoes removed after finishing 14th in a harness race over 2450m at Caen on 11 May
- **12. DJESON D'ARIANE -** High-flying veteran who confirmed his form and well-being with a last-start mounted race success over 2700m at this venue on 12 April. Will fight for victory once more

Summary: Veteran DJESON D'ARIANE (12) has shown his form and well-being recently by winning 2 of his last 3 starts, including his latest, so is good value to continue his momentum. He will, however, have to thwart the likely challenges of ICAMORA DE HOUELLE (1), ideally positioned at the start, and another last-start winner in IBERIK DE MONGOCHY (4). Back under the saddle after a preparation outing in the harness category, GALANT GALAA (11) shouldn't be underestimated either.

- **1. LUNA NOVA GWEN -** Revealed serious means when winning on debut last year over track and trip, and finished 2nd in 2 of her next 3 starts, but hasn't looked the same since resuming. Disqualified twice before finishing 9th here in a 2700m Group II on 10 May
- **2. LIPANGA DE GUEZ -** Consistent performer who has been kept on the boil this year, making 10 race appearances. Finished 5th in a 2700m Group II harness race at this venue on 10 May will tempt lovers of outsiders
- **3. LUSH LIFE -** Unbeaten in 2 starts last year and made a winning reappearance/Vincennes debut over this track and trip in March. Lost her unbeaten record when 4th in a course-and-distance Group III last month and didn't go unnoticed when 6th in a 2700m Group II here on 10 May dark horse
- **4. LOVE LETTER -** Seriously talented filly with sound/consistent form credentials, including a last-start 4th in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May. Could have a role to play
- **5. LAYLA -** Consistent filly with sound references, particularly in this shoeing configuration. Wasn't disgraced (7th) in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May an attractive outsider
- **6. LIZY JOSSELYN -** Showed considerable early promise, winning on debut at Enghien in August, but has been disappointing this year. Disqualified in 2 of her last 3 starts including her latest in a 2700m Group II here on 10 May
- 7. LILAS CASTELLE Delicate but is a capable Group performer with sound references at this level. Disqualified in a Group II at this venue over 2700m on 10 May but shouldn't be hastily condemned
- **8. LADY -** Seriously talented filly with 4 race victories from 6 completed outings (7 starts). Finished 3rd in her other 2 appearances, including a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May not taken lightly
- **9. LOPIGNA -** Revealed serious quality last year by winning 3 of her first 4 starts and finished 4th in a Group II over track and trip on 7 January. Disqualified in 2 of 3 subsequent starts, including her latest in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May
- **10. LEXIE DE BANVILLE -** Smart performer with sound references/form credentials in the mounted category, including a last-start 3rd in a 2450m Group II under the saddle. Unknown quantity in the harness code
- **11. LIZA JOSSELYN -** Exciting prospect with 5 victories from 6 appearances. Has won consecutive Group III contests, the latest over this course and distance on 19 April will fight for victory

- **14. LA JOYEUSE WICZ -** Classy, lightly raced Group I winner at this venue over 2700m in mid-February and was returning from a subsequent absence when only 11th in a 2700m Group II here on 10 May. Capable, even with her irons

15. LOUISIANE DE BOMO - Won 5 of her first 6 starts before finishing 5th in a 2700m Group I on 18 February. Resumed after a subsequent absence when runner-up to LOTTA BOURBON (13) in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May - has a big say

Summary: Quality Group II event for three-year-old fillies, of whom progressive LIZA JOSSELYN (11) could be the one to side with. However, she will be seriously tested by LOUISIANE DE BOMO (15), whose comeback (2nd) in a Group II race won by LOTTA BOURBON (13) was very encouraging. LILAS CASTELLE (7), who is a tricky customer but a proven performer at this level, and LET ME SHINE GIO (12) are also candidates for success.

- 1. JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT Has regained momentum in this shoeing configuration. Won over 2500m at Reims on 8 April and has confirmed that form/improvement by finishing 3rd in both starts since, the latest at La Capelle over 2750m on 10 May
- 2. JENY DES MALBERAUX Unreliable performer but seldom finishes far off the mark when applied, especially in this configuration. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th over track and trip on 23 April dark horse
- **3. JOUVENCE D'AVRIL -** Capable mare with sound references at this level when avoiding disqualification. Sanctioned in her last start at Laval over 2850m on 23 May is rarely far from a fault but could get into the picture if remaining wise
- **4. JADE HAUFOR -** A 23-start maiden who displays commendable consistency, albeit without success. Finished 3rd in a similar race over 2700m at this venue on 4 May on the shortlist
- **5. JANIS SHOW -** Consistent performer in this category with sound references/form credentials under these conditions, including a last-start 4th over 2700m at this venue on 4 May
- **6. JUSQUINE FOUTEAU -** Reliable mare with sound references at this level. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th (shod) over 2800m at Cholet on 14 May should have more to offer with all four shoes removed
- **7. JADE MAJOR -** Delicate but has sufficient means to play a leading role in a race of this nature. Races barefoot for this occasion after a discreet (disqualified) comeback outing at Vichy over 2950m on 12 May beware
- **8. JAYA DES BROUSSES -** Improved after a much-needed comeback outing to finish a reassuring 2nd at Nantes over 3000m on 9 May. Has a winning chance

JUSQUINE FOUTEAU (6) should have more to offer racing unshod so could pose a threat. JALNA GIRL (10), with Eric Raffin at the helm, JADE HAUFOR (4), confirmed in this category, and consistent JANIS SHOW (5) are other potential place-getters.

- **1. LEARN TO FLY -** Showed early promise last year but has lost his way this term. Disqualified in consecutive Group III races at this venue, the latest over 2175m on 19 April
- **2. LE VOYOU D'ALMO -** Versatile colt with references (victories) in both codes. Crossed the line last of 9 finishers in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May for another day
- **3. LASH PERRINE -** Finished 2nd in a course-and-distance Group II on 6 January but has finished unplaced in all subsequent starts, the latest (8th) in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May
- **4. LOVE AND SUN -** Has revealed considerable means under the saddle but is best watched until reverting to that category, having been disqualified in his first appearance in the harness code last time (at this venue over 2700m on 10 May)
- **5. LUCKY JACKSON -** Delicate but his means are undeniable confirmed as much by finishing 2nd behind LUCIANO MENUET (11) in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May
- **6. LOMBOK JIEL -** Talented colt with serious means. Finished a creditable 6th in a 2700m Group I event in mid-February and didn't go unnoticed when 5th on his reappearance in a 2700m Group II on 10 May
- **7. LARGO DE CASTELLE -** Runner-up in consecutive Group III contests here, including one over track and trip, before finishing a creditable 4th in a 2700m Group II at this venue on 10 May. Dark horse

LOMBOK JIEL (6) caught the eye on his reappearance in that race and should prove a formidable opponent once more, just like LOVINO BELLO (10) whose effective in this shoeing configuration is beyond doubt. Both LOULOU DE MYE (9) and LUCKY JACKSON (5) are contenders for the podium.

Runner-up on his mounted debut before confirming that promise with a good 3rd under the saddle at this venue over 2700m on 23 April
- KEY BISCAYNE Tricky customer but seldom finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over 2700m at this venue on 17 May
- **3. KID DES MOLLES -** Inconsistent but rarely disappoints under the saddle in this configuration (barefoot). Finished a reassuring 2nd over 2700m at this venue on 23 April
- **4. KAISARIA -** Finished 6th (of 6 finishers) in a 2450m Group II under the saddle at Caen over 2450m on 11 May. Dark horse
- **5. JUNON DE LOU -** Finished an encouraging 3rd in her first start under the saddle behind JEWEL D'HERMES (6) over 2250m at Enghien on 2 May. Not taken lightly
- **6. JEWEL D'HERMES -** Has won both completed outings (3 starts) under the saddle this year and was a brilliant winner over 2250m at Enghien on 2 May. One to beat
- **7. JAVA WIC -** Most effective in this category and under these conditions (with all 4 shoes removed). Returned to form with an encouraging 2nd over 3150m at Saint-Brieuc on 26 March
- **8. JAMES OF CARLY -** Tricky customer but seldom finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification, and confirmed as much by finishing 3rd over 2200m at this venue on 5 April. Keep safe
- **9. JUDY BLUE EYES -** Showed signs of improvement when finishing 4th under the saddle over 2850m at Maure-de-Bretagne last time (30 April). More needed
- **10. JOKER DE FROULAY -** Has regained momentum with each comeback outing this year and confirmed as much by finishing 2nd over 2875m at Argentan on 28 March. Place chance
- **11. JUBLA VIKING -** Delicate and seldom far from a fault but is undeniably capable of playing a leading role in a race of this nature, especially if remaining wise. Caught the eye when 3rd under the saddle over 2850m at this venue on 23 April

Summary: JEWEL D'HERMES (6) was a very convincing winner over 2250m at Enghien earlier this month and, on the evidence of that success, is the horse to beat. Highly regarded KIRGHIZE SPEED (1) has shown his class and versatility, so is likely to lead the opposition with JAVA WIC (7) and KID DES MOLLES (3) also competitive for a place on the podium. JUNON DE LOU (5) and JAMES OF CARLY (8) come next.

- **2. I ALONE -** Course-and-distance winner of a similar contest on 1 February in this shoeing configuration (barefoot). Only 7th over 2550m at Gournay-en-Bray when resuming after a break but she should fare better under these conditions
- **3. GEORGIO HAUFOR -** Has made no impression in all 4 comeback appearances this year disqualified in consecutive recent outings, the latest over 2725m at Graignes on 24 May. Others preferred
- **4. HAUTE SPHERE -** Versatile veteran mare with sound references in this shoeing configuration. Uunplaced in 3 comeback outings this year, the latest (8th) over 2675m at Lisieux on 13 May
- **5. HOPE -** A regular at this level and is seldom far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 1800m at La Capelle on 10 May dark horse
- **6. HECTOR DES BUTTES -** Versatile, hard-knocking veteran with references in both codes, although probably at his best under the saddle. Needs to reaffirm after a last-start disqualification in a mounted race at Cholet on 14 May
- **7. IMPACT CASTELETS -** Unreliable performer with inconsistent recent form, although does have references at this level. Finished 8th in a 2150m claimer at Enghien on 2 May this extended distance should serve his interests
- **8. GAZOU PIQUENARD -** Maintaining a good level of form and consistency this year, albeit in amateur races for the most part. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th at that level over 2100m at this venue on 21 May candidate for success from the front row
- **9. FRISSON DU QUESNE -** Inconsistent veteran who has finished unplaced in both comeback outings this year, the latest (13th) in a 2100m claimer at this venue on 16 April. Improvement needed
- **10. FLY TO THE MOON -** Capable veteran trotter with sound references, although most effective when racing fully unshod. Absent since his disqualification at Agen on 15 October
- **11. ERGUE GABERIC -** Hard-knocking veteran with better references under the saddle won a 2700m mounted race in mid-February. Unplaced in consecutive harness claimers recently, the latest (14th) here on 30 April over 2700m
- **12. GOLIATH DU CAUX -** Soundly beaten in 4 of his last 5 starts (disqualified in the other), the latest (14th) in a 2950m Quinte+ at Vichy on 13 May. Most effective in this configuration (barefoot), so can be expected to fare better in this grade
- **13. EMENCOURT BLEQUIN -** Hard-knocking veteran with references at this level seldom far off the mark on a going day, confirmed as much by finishing 7th in a 2700m claimer at this venue on 30 April. Dark horse

- **2. LUSSABEAU -** A 16-start maiden seldom far from a fault but usually acquits himself well when avoiding disqualification. Was outclassed (last of 8) in a 2450m Group II at Caen on 11 May
- **3. LEANDRO DE MER -** Finished 4th three times and 2nd once in his first four completed outings (five starts) but has proven to be very delicate since disqualified in all 3 subsequent appearances, the latest here over 2700m on 23 April
- **4. LAURENCIA BELLA -** Confirmed the promise of her introduction (2nd) under the saddle by winning a 2200m mounted contest at this venue on 16 April. Has scope to improve
- **5. LENNON D'ANS -** Consistent colt with sound references, albeit without a race victory from 15 appearances. Seldom finishes far off when avoiding disqualification. Must bounced back from a recent failure in a 2450m Group II at Caen on 11 May
- **6. LOVISSIME -** Justified favouritism in her first start under the saddle by winning impressively in this shoeing configuration over 2700m at this venue on 3 May. Could pay to follow her progress
- **7. LORD ELLINGTON -** Reeled off a hat-trick of harness race victories at Cagnes during winter. Begins under the saddle after finishing 7th in a 2700m harness race at this venue on 30 April
- **8. LUZ FATALE -** Has revealed considerable means by acquitting herself consistently/competitively in each of her 4 appearances, all in the mounted category. Showed her form and well-being by finishing 2nd over 2700m here on 23 April
- **9. LUNIK DU CHOQUEL -** Versatile colt with sound references/form credentials under the saddle, including respectable performances at Group level in this category. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th in a 2450m mounted Group II at Caen on 11 May

Summary: LOVISSIME (6), who had revealed promise in the harness category, made a winning start under the saddle at this venue over 2700m in the same shoeing configuration so is, logically, the horse to beat - it could pay to follow her progress. LUZ FATALE (8) has both the form and experience in this code to pose the biggest threat. LORD ELLINGTON (7) is an unknown quantity in the mounted discipline but shouldn't be underestimated, while LUNIK DU CHOQUEL (9) has shown enough in this category to also make his presence felt.

- **2. KITA JADOR -** Last-start winner over 2850m at Laval on 2 May in this shoeing configuration. Ought to remain competitive
- **3. KEYPTOWN -** Unreliable performer but seldom finishes far off the mark when applied, especially in this grade/category. Has a place chance on the evidence of her last-start 8th over 2450m at Caen on 5 May
- **4. KARMINA DU BREUCQ -** Disqualified in her last four appearances, the latest over 2525m at Cavaillon on 9 April. Best watched for now
- **5. KALINE D'ERABLE -** Consistent filly with sound references at this level and solid form credentials, which includes finishing 4th in consecutive recent outings the latest over 2700m at this venue on 15 May. One to beat
- **6. KATANA -** Unplaced in all five comeback outings this year, although seldom finishes far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 2450m at Caen on 5 May
- **7. KARA DE PADD -** Tricky customer but seldom finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 3000m at Nantes on 9 May
- **8. KARELLE DU DORAT -** Delicate but has revealed considerable promise, winning three of five completed races (seven starts). Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over 2675m at Lisieux on 13 May
- **9. KIMMERIDGIENNE -** Consistent, lightly raced performer with sound references/form credentials albeit without a victory. Ought to be competitive after an encouraging 4th over 2825m at Chartres on 28 April
- **10. KANDY LIFE -** Disqualified in four of her last five starts, including three consecutive recent outings the latest over 2800m at Vichy on 13 May. Hard to make a case for
- **11. KALINKA MOYA -** Caught the eye when a fast-finishing 6th over 2700m at this venue on 15 May. Should not be underestimated
- **12. KINOU DAB -** Won her first two outings last year and showed her form/well-being by finishing 2nd in both comeback outings in 2024, the latest at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 12 May. High on the shortlist
- **13. KALINKA ERA -** Tricky customer but usually acquits herself well/competitively when avoiding disqualification proved as much by finishing 6th over 2350m at Angers on 3 April. Dark horse

Summary: Proven in this category and an effective performer over speed courses/distances, KALINE D'ERABLE (5) seems capable of resuming winning ways. KINOU DAB (12) and KALINKA MOYA (11) start from the second row but have the means to make up the ground/pose a threat. Enigmatic KELLY PRINCESSE (1) is on a long run of disqualifications but, judged on her best references, isn't incapable of making her presence felt.
