- **1. MAROUBRA -** Posted an excellent 1'17"4 in Caen qualification mid-June before losing her action in a 2300m Bernay Class F 3 weeks ago, and is not about to spring any surprises
- **2. MIRATISSIME -** Looked very ordinary when qualifying without fanfare at Caen early-June and is unlikely to cause an upset
- **3. MONICA JISCE -** Qualified in a respectable 1'18"8 at Laval earlier this month. Receives an Eric Raffin drive for debut and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **4. MAGGY JENILOU -** Qualified in a fine 1'17"5 at Caen in late-June before faulting early on debut in a 2250m Class D here last weekend. With application though can get a look-in
- **5. MASSIVE ATTACK -** Showed she was still somewhat green when debuting 3rd of 10 in a 2250m Class D here last weekend, and Yoann Lebourgeois will be loathe to allow the same thing to happen again. Chance
- **6. MAYA BEE -** Pleasantly surprising 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2225m Ecommoy Class F 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed and deserves to be treated with respect
- **7. MAHINA D'ENILA -** Qualified in 1'19"4 at Caen on 5 May. Allaire would not send her out if not able to win a race of this nature and can expect significant support
- **8. MORNING NEWS -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2225m Ecommoy Class F 3 week ago. Showed her form though and with Mathieu Mottier in charge this time, is not to be underestimated

Summary: Philippe Allaire sends out a pair here, both of which will have their chances. MAHINA D'ENILA (7) qualified respectably early-May, has had time to come on, and can get straight down to business. Stablemate MASSIVE ATTACK (5) is better than her recent debut result would suggest and has a decent chance of bringing home the bacon this time. MORNING NEWS (8) lost her action first time out but nevertheless caught the eye and will be dangerous if Mathieu Mottier can keep her trotting.

- **2. GRANDE MALICE -** 7th of 12 in an amateurs Class F over course and distance early-July and will have nothing to offer
- **3. GOFARA -** 10th of 11 in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G on 11 July and is not about to shake things up
- **4. HEROS NUEVO -** Returned to winning ways in a 2750m Ecommoy amateurs Class G 3 weeks ago. Excels with Daniel Grimault and is not incapable of doubling up
- **5. FLICFLAC DU LOGIS -** Second of 8 in a 2900m Clairefontaine amateurs Class H last weekend. Benefits from a good entry and returning to a hard surface may be just the ticket
- **6. HERA D'ESPACE** Placed just once in 4 at this level but reassured somewhat when 4th of 7 in a 3175m Saint-Omer Class F a week ago. Not a priority but in this small field can make first 5
- **7. GOLDISSIME -** Unplaced in 2 'pro' races, latterly a 2750m La Capelle Class F last week, after winning a Vincennes amateur event and returns to the category with a lot to contribute
- **8. GOOD DREAM -** Knocking at the door in the 'pro' categories lately, most recently 3rd of 7 in a 2700m Vittel Class H last weekend. Has placed just once in 3 amateur starts though and others easier to back
- **9. HOLD UP MESLOIS -** Makes first appearance at this level after finishing last but one in a 3175m Saint-Omer Class F last weekend, and will have few friends

Summary: After placing twice in this category across town late-spring, HERMES DU CHATAULT (1) went on to clinch victory in the professional category at La Capelle earlier this month and, barefoot this time, can repeat, but he will nevertheless be pitted against the recently revitalised HEROS NUEVO (4) who has won 4 of 7 at this level. GOLDISSIME (7) won his first amateur event across town last month and returns to the category with a decent hand to play. Runner-up in his last 3 starts, FLICFLAC DU LOGIS (5) deserves to have his day in the sun.

- 1. LOVE DE TOI Qualified under the saddle in 1'17"3 at Caen late-May and can get a look-in if it translates into competition
- **2. LATINO BOY -** 8th of 9 to LOCHAN (9) in a 2725m Pornichet Class E on 19 July. 4 pads fitted this time, with Alexandre Abrivard in the saddle, but still not a priority
- **3. LUIGI D'ISIGNY -** Has evident ability but sanctioned more often than not, latterly a 2750m Cabourg Class F last Tuesday. Mathieu Mottier in the irons this time but others still preferred
- **4. LOVER FACE BOY -** Takes first public steps under the saddle after trotting 9th of 11 in a 2850m Laval harness Class D early last month. Comes here fresh and, with Théo Peltier onboard, looks a major player
- **5. LUCKY DES SOURCES -** In the frame in 2 of last 3, most recently 3rd, a place behind LOCHAN (9), in a 2850m Laval Class E on 3 July, but will struggle to repeat
- **6. LOTUS PAULOIS -** 4th on monté debut at Reims last month before finishing last of 6 in a 2875m harness Class D here 11 days ago. Sports 4 pads this time but still not easy to make a case
- **7. LAZIO -** Returns to the discipline after faulting in a 2650m Pornichet harness Class E earlier this month. Yet to put a foot wrong under the saddle and will be competitive for a place on the podium
- **8. L'AS DE COEUR -** Erratic at the best of times, most recently 6th of 9 in a 2725m Cabourg harness Class D 9 days ago. Imposed at Caen last time in the code though and Benjamin Rochard gets the nod
- **9. LOCHAN -** Debuted smartly at Laval on 3 July before winning a 2725m Pornichet Class E, in fine fashion, 9 days ago, and is once again the obvious choice

Summary: Perfectly-engaged at the limit of earnings, LOCHAN (9) has looked thoroughly professional in both starts to date, most recently imposing well, and with Eric Raffin in the irons, looks set to make it 2 in a row. Quite clearly a colt with a future, LOVER FACE BOY (4) was never at his ease at Laval but switches code for the first time and will be expected to show another side to himself. LAZIO (7) is back under the saddle after freshening up at Pornichet and is not going to be far off the mark. L'AS DE COEUR (8) is not to everyone's liking, but he won under the saddle last month and should not be ignored.

- **2. JET DE CANVILLE -** 2nd of 12 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F last Monday. Has never impressed in the claiming division however and others easier to back
- **3. JUSTE D'UN JOUR -** A revelation since embarking on a claiming 'career', winning last 3, latterly over 2775m at Lignières a week ago, and is not incapable of adding another to his tally
- **4. JALISCO DE NEUVY -** 6th of 12 finishers in a 2750m Cabourg monté Class F on 12 July. Is reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois who won with him on their only association, and must not be underestimated
- **5. JUDY TURGOT -** Pulled-up in a 2850m Class E at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne a week ago. Has been a write-off for past 11 months and can be confidently ruled out

- **2. KALINKA MOYA -** Failed to confirm her Chartres victory when 9th of 11 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle last Monday. Races barefoot this time but others still preferred
- **3. KINJAL DE BELLANDE -** 7th of 10, on just 2nd start back, in a 2800m Vichy Class D earlier in the month, and is unlikely to improve on that
- **4. KYRA GIO -** 2nd of 16 in a 2750m Cabourg monté Class E on 2 July. Has other priorities and can be passed over
- **5. KAROLINE CADE -** Has started to come good again, latterly 2nd of 11 in a 2050m Cabourg Class E on 12 July, and will not be available at 55/1 this time around
- **6. KALINKA DU GRENAT -** Surprise 4th of 9 in a Class D under these conditions a fortnight ago but, and form maintained, can confirm
- **7. KIRANIE DES NOES -** Sanctioned here before trotting 4th of 11 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle early last week, and can play a role if she keeps her action together

- **14. KORSICANA** Has been knocking at the door, most recently 3rd of 12 in a Class E over course and distance a month ago, and with Franck Nivard reining, should figure prominently

Summary: An excellent servant when focused, KOMERE DE CORDAY (13) picked up her second success of the year when romping at Les Sables-d'Olonne earlier this month, and looks just to have the edge over KALINE DE FAEL (12) who made short work of the opposition at Le Mans mid-month. KALISKANA (8) sports pads for the first time, has been entrusted to Eric Raffin for the occasion, and if race-fit, can set the cat among the pigeons. Nicely-entered at the limit of earnings, KORSICANA (14) proved herself here in late-June and, with hind shoes off, will be no pushover.

- **2. LOVELY DU VALLON Made** good on her promise when winning a 2450m Caen Class D, with ease, on 20 June. In better company this time but still looks handy. Place chance
- **3. LISAS -** Quality element but sanctioned after missing the break in a Class C over course and distance earlier this month. Damien Bonne at the helm this time and can make amends
- **4. LUCIOLE DU VERTAIN -** Has been knocking at the door since winning in the provinces, latterly 3rd of 7 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 18 June, but faces a much stiffer test this time around
- **5. LOVE GLORY -** Good 3rd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 28 June. Gets a Benjamin Rochard drive this time and will have her chances
- **6. LISSANDRA JIEL -** Returns to racing with hind pads fitted after coming 3rd of 8 in a 2750m Class D at La Capelle 3 weeks ago. Mathieu Mottier reining and will not be sent out at 61/1 this time

- **3. KID DES MOLLES -** 3rd to KISS ME BOURBON (9) in a 2875m Class C over track and trip 3 weeks ago and should again have a good hand to play. Place prospect
- **4. KANTHABELLA -** 8th to KISS ME BOURBON (9) in race of reference. Frequently bites off more than she can chew and, even though sporting a new configuration, is not a realistic proposition
- **5. KELVALSE CASTELETS -** Competitive when unshod, most recently valiant 2nd to KISS ME BOURBON (9) in race of reference, and has a decent chance of making the frame once more
