- **3. LEADER DU CHATELET -** Returned to form with a good win in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 7 October. Can follow up
- **4. LOZARI -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 14 December. Capable of being a threat this shorter distance
