1. LENNON D'ANS - Complicated 19-start maiden disqualified in each of his last 5 appearances, the latest in a 2700m mounted race on this course recently (20 December). Others preferred

2. LEONARD DU CLOS - Tricky customer, disqualified in 2 of his last 5 starts, but usually acquits himself well when applied/remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on this course in a 2700 mounted race on 20 December - dark horse

3. L'AS DE COEUR - Delicate trotter with undeniable means but is rarely far from a fault - disqualified in each of his last 5 appearances, the latest in a 2700m mounted race on this course on 20 December. Best watched for now

4. LOTI SOLO - Consistent performer under the saddle with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th on this course over 2700m on 28 November. Attractive outsider

5. LEON DU CLOS - Lightly raced trotter with sound references/form credentials under the saddle and scope to improve. Blotted his copybook when disqualified in a 2700m mounted race here on 21 November but shouldn't be hastily condemned

6. LUIGI D'ISIGNY - Delicate and rarely far from a fault but has undeniable means (sound references/form credentials) - performs well when remaining wise. Disqualified here on 12 November so this is again a question of wisdom

7. LE PRIEURE - Won 3 consecutive starts switched to the mounted category and acquitted himself well in defeat recently, finishing 3rd in both subsequent starts on this course - the latest over 2700m on 28 November. Speedy trotter, hard to beat

8. LEONCE DU CLOS - Consistent colt with solid form references/credentials under the saddle - finished worse than 3rd for the first time in 8 starts when 4th on this course in a 2700m mounted race on 12 November. Keep safe

9. LABEL DE TILLARD - Complicated colt disqualified in 5 consecutive starts, the latest in a course-and-distance harness race last week (21 December). Others preferred

10. LUCIFER D'ORPHEE - Progressive trotter with an impressive record in the mounted code - 2nd twice with 3 victories in 5 starts under the saddle. Last-start winner on this course over 2700m on 28 November

11. LOTUS ZEN - Acquitted himself well in defeat when finishing 7th on this course in a 2700m Group III on 21 November. Not taken lightly

Summary: LE PRIEURE (7) has a bright future in the mounted category and it could pay to follow his progress. He's taken to resume winning ways at the expense of LUCIFER D'ORPHEE (10), who has both the form and experience to make life difficult for the selection. Delicate LUIGI D'ISIGNY (6), if he can avoid disqualification, consistent LEONCE DU CLOS (8), and class-dropper LOTUS ZEN (11) also have the means to challenge for a spot on the podium, with LEONARD DU CLOS (2) best of the rest.

1. IPSO DU FER - Experienced hard-knocker with references under these conditions/with this configuration at a higher level. Unplaced (10th) in a 2700m Quinte+ on this course on 14 December but can do better in this grade - dark horse

2. HELIA DE FROMENTIN - Regained momentum recently in 3 starts with this shoeing configuration and confirmed as much with a last-start victory over 2950m at Le Mans on 16 December. Winning chance

3. IDOLE ELDE - Consistent hard-knocker in good form and physical condition with sound references at a higher level, including a course-and-distance 4th on 26 November. Will fight for victory if repeating that performance

4. IMPACT CASTELETS - Unreliable but undeniably capable of winning a race of this nature, especially over a course and distance he likes. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2150m harness race at Argentan on 15 December- keep safe

5. EQUALITY - Consistent veteran mare whose competitiveness in this category and over this distance is beyond doubt. Showed her form and well-being by finishing 6th on this course over 2700m on 23 November - cannot be underestimated

6. HARMATTAN DU RIB - Inconsistent but retains sufficient means, even with his irons (shod) - usually acquits himself well and is seldom far off the mark. Unplaced (11th) in a stronger course-and-distance event on 20 December but will find this is easier

7. GRYFFONDOR DU POLI - Thriving veteran trotter, rewarded for his consistency with a laststart 2700m win on this course on 23 November. On the shortlist

8. HEROS DE CHOISEL - Unreliable but not devoid of ability with references at a higher level - seldom far off the mark on a going day. Must bounce back from a recent disqualification at Nantes on 8 December

9. HUNADORA - Experienced veteran, confirmed under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration but is currently out of sorts. Finished 9th over 2850m at Laval on 8 December

10. HORSE DE GRAMMONT - Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials at a higher level and an amateur victory (shod) over 2850m at Mauquenchy when last seen in this category (24 November). Not taken lightly - for lovers of outsiders

11. ESPOIR DES MAZURES - Experienced trotter and a regular in amateur races - seldom finishes far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2500m Châtelaillon-La Rochelle amateur race on 9 November

12. IDEAL FLEURI - Honest hard-knocker in good form and physical condition - won over 2650m at Saint-Galmier 2 starts back before finishing 2nd over 2750m at Cabourg on 17 December. Attractive outsider

13. ILIADE MENCOURT - Confirmed the improvement of her previous start (3rd) at Mauquenchy by finishing 2nd in a course-and-distance event at a higher level on 26 November. Races shod on this occasion but retains a winning chance

14. GOWEN CHALEONNAIS - Veteran trotter of 121 appearances with vast experience in this category and references at a higher level but out of sorts at present. Finished 8th over 2825m at Chartres on 26 November

15. HASCHELEY BERRY - Inconsistent veteran mare with references at a higher level - seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2700m harness event at Le Croisé-Laroche on 16 December

Summary: HELIA DE FROMENTIN (2) has gone from strength to strength recently in this shoeing configuration and she's good value to follow up a Le Mans victory 12 days ago. Consistent hard-knockers IDOLE ELDE (3) and ILIADE MENCOURT (13) acquitted themselves well in a course-and-distance race last month, and they are best equipped to challenge the selection for race honours. Proven in this category, both GRYFFINDOR DU POLI (7) and EQUALITY (5) have legitimate podium ambitions.

3. KILDARE OF LOVE - Won a course-and-distance mounted race on 5 November and confirmed that form/improvement with a good 4th on this course over 2850m on 22 November. Not taken lightly

4. KENTUCKY IDEAL - Runner-up in his last 2 course-and-distance appearances, the latest in this (unshod) configuration on 8 October. Disqualified in a 2850m harness race here on 18 November but an entirely different proposition under the saddle

5. KASBAH PERRINE - Inconsistent at a higher level but is course-and-distance suited and retains sufficient means to be competitive in a race of this nature. Was far from disgraced when 8th in a 2700m Group I at this venue on 15 December

6. KADO SHINING - Versatile trotter who usually acquits himself competitively when applied (avoiding disqualification). Eye-catching 3rd in a 2700m harness race at this venue on 8 December and is equally effective under the saddle - dark horse

7. KATINKA AIMEF - Delicate trotter with undeniable means but rarely far from a fault. Didn't go unnoticed (5th) in a 2700m Group I at this venue on 15 December - not taken lightly

8. KAKO GASCOGNE - Versatile trotter and winner of his last 2 appearances in the mounted category (the latest over 2850m at this venue on 22 November). Won a course-and-distance race in October, proving his efficiency over this trip - winning chance

9. NAOMI BROS - Well-beaten 13th of 14 in a 2700m Group II harness event on this course on 7 December in her first start on French soil/since joining Nicolas Bazire. Unknown quantity under the saddle but Eric Raffin engaged - seriously respected

10. KELVALSE CASTELETS - Classy filly with undeniable means, though rarely far from a fault - disqualified in 4 of her last 5 starts - the latest in 2700m Group I at this venue on 15 December. Question of wisdom with her

11. KERRY LOVE - Runner-up in 3 of her last 4 appearances in this (unshod) configuration, including her latest over 2850m at Laval on 1 November. Keep safe

Summary: NAOMI BROS (9) finished a well-beaten 13th in a Group II harness race on this course earlier this month in her first start on French soil. However, she shouldn't be hastily condemned in her first start under the saddle, especially with Eric Raffin aboard the highly regarded filly for Nicolas Bazire. KAKO GASCOGNE (8), a course-and-distance winner in the mounted category, speedy KENTUCKY IDEAL (4), and recent Laval runner-up KERRY LOVE (11) have the form and experience to expose any chinks in that rivals' armour.

2. GAGNANT DE BRIKVIL - On a run of 3 consecutive disqualifications, his latest in a 2700m harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 December. Others preferred

3. REVEN DEJAVU - Classy Swedish trotter with solid form references/credentials, including commendable Vincennes performances in fields superior to the one he races in here. Confirmed under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration, so isnt taken lightly despite his latest failure (disqualification) over 1640m at Jägersro on 23 November

4. FIFTY - Ended a run of 3 consecutive disqualifications with a reassuring 3rd in a 2850m amateur race at the beginning of the month on this course (1 December). Has more on his plate now

5. EUNIS DU PATURAL - Hard-knocking 10-year-old veteran at the top of his game (in good form and physical condition) and most efficient in this barefoot configuration. Runner-up over 2950m at Toulouse on 20 November in his last unshod appearance

6. GOLD PEJI - Complicated veteran trotter - rarely far from a fault but usually acquits himself well when applied/remaining wise. Disqualified in 3 of his last 5 starts, the latest in a course-and-distance mounted race on 14 December

7. FRANCO FLEURI - An excellent 2nd over 2850m on this course in early November and, on the evidence of that performance, shouldnt be hastily condemned for finishing 11th here over 2100m on 6 December. Keep safe

8. GAMINE DE RIBEAU - Veteran of 117 starts with 11 victories. Finished 6th in her only Quinte+ appearance but has lost her way recently and was a well-beaten 11th over 2700m at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 December.

9. MISTER DONALD - Inconsistent trotter with undeniable means/sound references but is out of sorts - unplaced in his last 3 starts, the latest (7th) on this course over 2850m on 1 December. Outsider

13. STARO MOJITO - Versatile hard-knocker with sound references in both codes, including a last-start 2nd in a course-and-distance mounted race on 14 December. Confirmation required back in the harness category

14. GO TO AMERICA - Soundly beaten in consecutive recent starts on this course, both Quinte+ events - the latest (14th) over 2100m on 11 December. Dark horse

15. GRAZIELA D'EL - Regained momentum recently after a lengthy absence and confirmed as much with a reassuring 4th in a Quinte+ event over 2100m at this venue on 11 December. Dark horse

16. FLAMBEUR DU DIGEON - Versatile veteran trotter and a big-priced winner of a 2100m harness event at this venue on 6 December. Shouldn't be underestimated with Benjamin Rochard at the helm again

Summary: Scandinavian trotter REVEN DEJAVU (3) has blown hot and cold in Sweden recently but, judged on his performances at Vincennes last winter in superior races/fields, this represents a good opportunity to set the record straight back on French soil. GIANA DE MARZY (12) heads the long list of potential dangers, which includes FRANCO FLEURI (7) and EUNIS DU PATURAL (5). Favourably engaged under the conditions, last-start winner FLAMBEUR DU DIGEON (16) is also a genuine candidate for the leading places. GO TO AMERICA (14), with Yoann Lebourgeois in the sulky, and MISTER DONALD (9) complete the shortlist.

12. LUGANO - Well beaten 8th in a class D at this track over 2100m on 7 December. Needs to improve on recent efforts

13. LOUSTIC D'YVEL - A winner in a class E at this track over 2200m on 10 December. Has confidence but is facing stronger rivals

Summary: LOOKING D'AURCY (4) was well in contention when he faulted last time out and can make up for this below-par performance. He is the pick ahead of LOVELY TRIP (8) who had a run a good race on 7 December here before his last sanction. LUCKY LOVE (2) has been knocking loudly at the door and should go well once again. LORENZO DE CHENU (11) showed some improvement last time and is not out of it.
