C1 - PRIX DU PONT D'ARCOLE - 2875m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- **1. HUGOLINO -** Drops in category after coming 6th of 9 finishers in a 2550m Reims Class D early-June. Can claim a solid amateur record and must be duly respected
- **2. HARMONIOUS -** 2nd of 10 in a 2825m amateurs Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche earlier in the month. Boasts excellent credentials in this category and can play a leading role
- **3. HELVIRA -** Never far from faulting but has bags of ability at this level, latterly demolishing a 2750m La Capelle Class E 8 days ago and will have a lot to offer if Danny Mahieu keeps her trotting
- **4. HUTA JAZZ -** Has not won for over a year but has returned in excellent shape, latterly 4th of 15 in a 2525m Class F at Les Andelys and, although not a priority, is still worth watching
- **5. HADRIEN MERITE -** Sanctioned in a 2825m monté Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche late-May. Has other priorities and can be ruled out
- **6. IL MAGNIFICO -** Left a good impression at Caen before faulting, when never comfortable, in a 2800m Chartres Class F 10 days ago. New driver at the helm and can win this if he gets him off on the right foot
- **7. FLEUR DE VANILLE -** 5th of 16, at 93/1, in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F mid-month, but a repeat seems improbable
- **8. HURRICANE WIND -** Has not been seen out since trotting 5th of 17 in a 3000m Borély Class E last October but hails from a stable going good-guns and even with an extra 25m to travel, still looks competitive for a first-5 cheque
- **9. GITAN DE GUEZ -** Pleased on his amateur debut across town 2 months ago, has produced 2 decent runs since and, shod as he was at Vincennes, should not be overlooked
- **10. GALON D'AMIRAL -** Has not enjoyed the best of fortune lately, most recently faulting in a 2650m Laon Class F last Sunday. Seldom seen in this class of race but is confirmed and, with application, can have a say in the outcome
- **11. ISLA MUJERES -** Kicked 2024 off nicely but has since gone off the boil, most recently 9th of 13 in a 1800m Class E at La Capelle 2 weeks ago, and can expect to have few takers
- **12. EROS DU BRISSE -** Very disappointing this year, latterly 7th of 11 in a 2400m Amiens Class E last weekend, and even with 4 pads fitted, has no possible chance
- **13. HELLO JOHN -** 2nd of 13 in a 2800m Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles 3 weeks ago. Is confirmed here, is clearly in form, and even from the 2nd line, can play an important role
- **14. FRICHTI -** Last but one, when preparing for this, in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F 11 days ago. Hind shoes off this time but others still preferred

Summary: Nicely entered on the front line here, and partnered by Piet Van Pollaert, IL MAGNIFICO (6) reverts to his preferred configuration for his amateur debut and looks eminently capable of getting straight down to business. - 2. LABEL DE LARRE Lost his maiden status in a 2550m Reims Class E mid-month but takes on a tougher bunch this time and chances limited
- **3. LUKAS D'OLIVERIE -** Sanctioned as often as not but has ability. Unraced since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class B in January though and even with front pads fitted, is still expected to need the race
- **4. LEON DU CLOS -** Useful but could manage only 5th of 7 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class B 11 days ago, but the new configuration will do his prospects no disservice

Summary: A progressive filly that has taken to her new vocation like a natural, LAVALLOISE GIRL (9) lost her maiden status at Vincennes last month and Eric Raffin will be justifiably eyeing up a repeat. It's unlikely to be all plane sailing though considering how well L'APOGEE IMPERIAL (10) has been acquitting himself, and the entry he enjoys. It took some time but LOTUS ZEN (8) returns to Enghien with his morale intact and even racing shod, looks capable of making the frame, as does the improving LEGEND DARLING (7) who is fitted with hind pads this time.

- **2. LORD DU TRIEUX -** 3rd of 11 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class D 3 weeks ago. Is progressing nicely and is unlikely to be far from the action at the business end of the race
- **3. LORENZO D'EP -** Won a 2600m Class G at Châlons-en-Champagne mid-month, first time out. Takes a hike in class but will have come on for the run and, with 4 pads fitted, is not to be ignored

- **2. GRANDE PRETRESSE -** 12th of 13 in last weekend's race of reference, on first start since the spell. Appreciates Enghien conditions and will be one to keep an eye on
- **3. GINO VIVA -** Respectable 3rd of 15 in a 2100m Class C at Vincennes last weekend. Excels in mobile starts, is confirmed under these conditions, and looks a player
- **4. FOREVER JIEL -** Finished last but one in race of reference. Has a regressive profile and must get his house in order
- **5. HAMILTON DU HAM -** Came good 3 weeks ago when making short work of a 2850m Vincennes Class D. Is well-placed in front, has won twice over course and distance, and can do so again if Yoann Lebourgeois gets him off on the right foot
- **6. FILOU DE CHARDET -** Takes a dip in category after finishing 8th of 14 in a 2650m Bordeaux Gr.3 10 days ago. Decently-placed on front line but others still preferred
- **7. FILARETE DU VERGER -** 7th of 15, behind GINO VIVA (3), in a 2100m Vincennes Class C last weekend. Has solid references over course and distance and is thoroughly capable of securing a slice of the pie

- **3. KAPTAIN DE CRISTAL -** Made the frame in 3 before coming 8th of 10 finishers 2175m Vincennes Class D on 10 May. Races barefoot for the occasion but other more competitive choices available
- **4. KASSKOU CLEMAXELLE -** On a cracking run of form since early-April, latterly 2nd of 12 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F mid-month, but in this company will have too much to do

- **7. GLOIRE DES LOYAUX -** 3rd of 11 finishers, when shod, in a 3225m Vitré Class E on 2 June. Will appreciate the long Enghien straight and, barefoot this time, is unlikely to disappoint
- **8. EDI JOSSELYN -** Kicked the year off decently but disappointing since, latterly 11th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D last weekend, and will need to find more
- **9. GERSHWIN DE CHENU -** Not disgraced when 8th of 14, on comeback, in a 2100m Vincennes Class D 2 weeks ago. Previously won 3 in succession for Eric Raffin, but looks more a minor place chance this time around
- **10. GRAND SOURIRE -** Got back in the game 3 weeks ago when 3rd of 16 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D. Has previously won here, goes well for the day's driver, and can make this his own
- **11. FAVORI DE BRY -** Has not been seen out since coming 3rd, a place behind EDI JOSSELYN (8), in a 2925m Cagnes Class D early-January. Shoes on and best to wait
- **12. FALCO FLEURI -** Returns to a hard surface after coming 3rd of 14 in a 2975m Jallais Class E a fortnight ago. Entrusted to Franck Nivard this time and will be afforded every chance
- **13. FELICITA D'ECOUVES -** Was not the most fortunate when 9th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D last weekend. Sports a modified formula, and with a trouble-free run, can bring the fight to GRAND SOURIRE (10)
- **14. FOR LOVING YOU -** Impressed more than once last season before coming off the boil. Unremarkable 7th of 12 , behind GO CHICAGO (1), in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle mid-month and can be passed over
- **15. FILAE DE SOYORA -** Seldom gets her nose in front but finished a reassuring 3rd of 11 in a 2225m Feurs Class D mid-month and does not make the trip to Paris for reasons of tourism

16. DROP DE L'ITON - Last but one in a 2800m Pontchâteau Class E on 16 June. Enjoys an excellent entry, with front shoes off, but will not be in a position to take advantage

Summary: An honest trotter that always gives his best, GRAND SOURIRE (10) has previously won for Benjamin Rochard and his latest performance augurs well for his prospects. In the frame in 2 before being denied a run next time, FELICITA D'ECOUVES (13) can more than make amends if Alexis Collette keeps her out of trouble. GAGNANT DE BRIKVIL (2) showed a different side to himself last time out before losing his action, but his driver will be out to set the record straight. GLOIRE DES LOYAUX (7) has made the frame in 2 of her last 3 starts and although unlikely to impose, can still make the frame.

- **1. KERENE MIXO -** Decent filly making her first start since trotting 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2450m Caen Class E mid-March. Is barefoot for re-entry but risks being race-rusty
- **2. KHEOPS JENILAT -** Highly-impressive in a 2450m Caen Class D on his monté debut on 10 June, only to be subsequently sanctioned. On better behaviour though, can wrap this up
- **3. KNOKKE DE HOUELLE -** Opened his monté account at Laval before failing to fire in a 2850m Vincennes Class D a week ago. Should not be too quickly judged though and the Benjamin Rochard-factor cannot be ignored
- **4. KENNEDY JAMES -** 6th of 8 finishers in a 2100m Vincennes harness Class E on 11 June. Debuts under the saddle, with hind shoes off and Adrien Lamy in the irons, and will be competitive for a spot on the podium
- **5. KEMETCHA DES BAUX -** Has turned a corner over recent months, latterly securing a 2450m Caen Class E mid-month. Reverts to a proven formula and can give KHEOPS JENILAT (2) a run for his money
- **6. KING OF JIEL -** Useful colt that lost his action, when well-supported, in a 2550m Reims Class F 2 weeks ago. Back to a previous configuration and with application can make first 5
- **7. KALINKA DU BLEUET -** Sanctioned, when spent, in a 2850m Vincennes Class D last weekend and, in this company, will have her work cut out
- **8. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE -** Has 2 races in him since the break, latterly 7th behind KING OF JIEL (6), in a 2450m Caen Class F, and is not about to spring a surprise

Summary: KHEOPS JENILAT (2) had his monté debut won recently only to have victory taken away in the stewards' room, but Benjamin Chauve-Laffay will be loathe to allow that to happen a second time. Eric Raffin takes over on recent Caen winner, KEMETCHA DES BAUX (5) who will be fitted with front pads this time, and who will be no pushover. KNOKKE DE HOUELLE (3) was somewhat out of sorts across town last weekend but has otherwise been in cracking form and will be expected to redeem himself.
