- 2. KAID DE MORGE Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Paray-le-Monial on 1 April. Tries a Mounted race but is best watched for now
- 3. KENYA DES RACQUES Disqualified in three of four starts, including last time out at Bollène on 23 June. Tries a Mounted race and is capable of improvement
- **4. KLEOPATRE D'ALFORT -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified again last time out at Vichy on 1 June. Best watched for now
- **5. KIRINA DES MARAIS -** Showed some improvement last time out when runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Laon over 2850m on 9 June. Can contest the finish
