**C1 - PRIX JACQUES JEANJOT - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted
- EUR € 21,000**

- 1. KOLCANI JEEP** - Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 20 July. Others are much preferred
- 2. KIDAM DU METZ** - Has some fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at Cabourg 2750m on 9 July. Might play a minor role
- 3. KARLA D'AVENIR** - She has been disqualified in her last five starts, with the latest being at Genêts on 21 July. Capable of an upset if smart
- 4. KOPERNIK DE GODREL** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Le Mans on 16 July. Capable of earning some minor money when wise
- 5. KAYENNE** - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Amiens on 20 July. Probably best watched for now
- 6. KASSIOPEE NANIE** - Has struggled all year and was disqualified last time out at LaLaon on 23 June. Best watched this time
- 7. KEEGAN DE PARNIERE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 8 March. Can contest the finish if wise
- 8. KABOBBOY SANT** - Unreliable this year and was 8th last time out in a Class E harness race at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 20 July. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. KOBANA DU CYGNE** - Has struggled this year and was 9th last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 15 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 10. KERVIGNAC** - Improved with each run and was a winner last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 8 February. Can follow up if fit from a break
- 11. KERENE MIXO** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Enghien on 29 June. Barefoot and capable of earning some minor money
- 12. KYOTO JIEL** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out at Vittel on 14 July. Best watched for now
- 13. KAMES** - Did not show his best when 6th last time out in a Class D harness race at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 May. Has won his last two races under the saddle and can score again

Summary: Progressive last-start winner KERVIGNAC (10) hasn't been seen since his victory at Vincennes in February but represents a stable firing on all cylinders, so his progress could be worth following in this opening event. KAMES (13) is ideally engaged at the limit of earnings and will appreciate reverting to the mounted category (won his last 2 appearances under the saddle), so could make life difficult for the selection. KEEGAN DE PARNIERE (7) is seldom far from a fault but has the undeniable means to pose a threat, if avoiding disqualification. KARLA D'AVENIR (3), KOBANA DU CYGNE (9) and KOPERNIK DE GODREL (4) have place prospects.

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C2 - PRIX JEAN PIERRE MASSIN - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. ISCO DE WATOU - On a very long losing run and was 8th last time out in Class 3150m on 21 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win

2. ILLICO DES BROUETS - Disappointing of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Laon over 2850m on 26 May. Capable of better and is not out of it

3. ILMENITE - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class F at Nates over 3000m on 3 June. Can go one better this time

4. IDEE MELOC - Unreliable but did do better when 5th last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 20 July. Might play a minor role

5. IZAC AWAGNE - Has struggled this year and was 8th last time out in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 11 July. Needs to do more to win this race

6. GOLD DE BERG - Disqualified in his last four starts, with the latest being at Bréhal on 22 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred

7. ISLA MUJERES - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 23 July. Capable of making the frame when in the mood

8. IBIS PETTEVINIERE - Did not show his best when unplaced in a Class E Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 July. Better in harness races and can bounce back to score

Summary: IBIS PETTEVINIERE (8) made light of a 25m handicap when winning at Nantes on 3 June and, with a repeat of that performance, should recapture the winning thread and confirm his superiority over re-opposing rival ILMENITE (3) who was a well-beaten 2nd that day and isn't likely to turn the tables in this considerably smaller field. ILLICO DES BROUETS (2) has been out of sorts lately but, judged on his best form/references, is capable of getting into the picture. ISLA MUJERES (7) is an attractive outsider.

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C3 - PRIX ALBERT LEFEVRE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. JOHANNA DE BRETT** - Holding her form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 20 July. Can contest the finish again
- 2. JANET JIEL** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 25 July. Capable of bouncing back to score when in the mood
- 3. JANIA DANICA** - In good form of late and was barefoot and third last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and can fight out the finish
- 4. J'ADORE BLUE** - Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 19 July. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 5. JACKIE D'HERTALS** - Unreliable but did not run badly when fourth last time out at Duingt over 2000m on 13 July. Needs to do more to win this race
- 6. JAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 22 June. Others are preferred
- 7. JILPA KALONIG** - Has struggled this year and was 5th last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 20 July. Others are much preferred
- 8. JOLIE ROMANCE** - Unreliable and has been disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at La Ferté-Vidame on 21 July. Capable of bouncing back to be a serious threat
- 9. J'ATTENDS LOSEILLE** - Disqualified in her only start of this year at Châlons-en-Champagne on 16 June. Can improve but is best watched for now
- 10. JULIE DU NORD** - Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this course on 22 July. Capable of winning when wise

Summary: JANET JIEL (2) won on this track over 1800m on 16 June and, despite failures in both subsequent outings, could be worth giving another chance to, with this longer distance more to her liking and Gabriele Gelormini at the helm. JANIA DANICA (3) caught the eye with an encouraging 3rd last time and is likely to fight for victory if reproducing a similar performance. JULIE DU NORD (10), if in the mood (avoiding disqualification), delicate JOLIE ROMANCE (8) and consistent JOHANNA DE BRETT (1) are all likely to be competitive too.

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C4 - PRIX JACQUES FOURNIER - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. JOYAU DARLING** - On a long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 29 July, Can go one better this time
- 2. JUSTE AVANT** - In good form of late and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 10 July. Can go one better this time
- 3. JAVLAR** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Orléans over 3400m on 1 April. Capable of winning if in the mood
- 4. JUST DU CHATELET** - Non runner
- 5. JOGGER STAR** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 15 April. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. JALVENT MONTAVAL** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 20 July. Others are preferred
- 7. JAZZ DU CHATAULT** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 20 July. Has a winning chance
- 8. JOYAU D'EVER** - Has disqualification issues but was runner-up last time out in Class F at La Ferté-Vidame over 2775m on 21 July. Can contest the finish again
- 9. JAG PRIOR** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third last time out in a Claimer at Pornichet-La Baule over 2750m on 4 July. Might play a minor role

Summary: Enigmatic JUSTE AVANT (2) is seldom far from a fault but has looked more reliable/efficient racing unshod so could be rewarded for his consistency with an overdue fourth career success, which has eluded him since October last year. JOYAU D'EVER (8), JAZZ DU CHATAULT (7) and JOYAU DARLING (1) have all been hard to win with but are capable of making life difficult for the selection.

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C5 - PRIX ANTOINE DIEU - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. KIRIO DE REUX** - Has improved of late and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Les Andelys 2525m on 30 June. Barefoot and capable of making the frame
- 2. KAPITEN DU MELEUC** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 24 June. Capable of playing a minor role when in the mood
- 3. KLYDE GALAA** - Holding his form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 10 July. Can make the frame
- 4. KING DE LA COTE** - Bounced back to his best with a barefoot win in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 5. KAOS DE LA COTE** - Yet to win and was disqualified last time out at Carentan on 13 July. Might pop up in a place if in the mood
- 6. KOURASI LEPINE** - Has disqualification issues and was 5th last time out in Class F at Vittel over 2700m on 21 July. Capable of playing a minor role
- 7. KOOS KOETS** - Unreliable and was unplaced last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 July, Can play a minor role
- 8. KILLER MELOC** - Has really struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Amiens on 27 May. Others are preferred
- 9. KENAVO DES GLENAN** - Disappointing of late and was tenth last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 9 July. Needs to do more to win this race
- 10. KRACK TER BLEKTE** - Yet to win a race and was 7th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 20 July. Capable of earning some minor money
- 11. KAREFUL** - Unbeaten in two starts with the latest being in Class G at Feurs over 2050m on 5 July. Deserves the utmost respect
- 12. KASH ELEVEN** - Yet to win a race and was 8th last time out in Class F at Argentan over 2150m on 27 January. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 13. KID D'ECHAL** - Has won twice in 5 starts but has also been disqualified twice, including last time out at Montmirail on 30 June. Not out of it
- 14. KRIS MARTIN** - Has disqualification issues but has also won his last two starts, with the latest being in Class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Can complete the hat-trick
- 15. KEYSTONE DE WATOU** - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class F at Abbeville over 3150m on 7 July. Has won twice and is capable of an upset
- 16. KALICO JACK** - Unreliable but was 5th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 July. Capable of making the frame

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Summary: Progressive KRIS MARTIN (14), who has won his last 3 completed outings (4 starts), and unbeaten KAREFUL (11), who proved his efficiency/versatility over a shorter trip last time, appeal most and are likely to fight out the finish - it could go either way. KING DE LA COTE (4), however, has raised his game racing unshod on all four and isn't incapable of getting involved if building on the form/improvement of his last-start success. KID D'ECHAL (13) and KALICO JACK (16) are proven at this level so could make their presence felt in the finish. Good race!

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C6 - PRIX ALBERT VIEL - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. KARA DE LA BESVRE** - Yet to win a race and was fourth last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 24 June. Can earn some minor money
- 2. KALINE D'ARDENNES** - Has some fair form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 20 July. Capable of making the frame
- 3. KIRUNA DU PONCELET** - Has struggled this year and was 8th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 17 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. KHALEESI HEAVEN** - Holding her form and was third last time out in Class F at La Ferté-Vidame over 2750m on 21 July. Can contest the finish
- 5. KIGUELLA D'ALTAR** - Holding form well and was third last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 11 July. Be right there at the finish once again
- 6. KARINA JOSSELYN** - Disqualified last time out at Chartres on 30 June. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- 7. KELLE** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at Vittel on 21 July. Capable of earning some money when wise
- 8. KANELLE CASTELETS** - Disqualified last time out at Meslay-du-Maine on 16 May. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 9. KENZA DE LA BESVRE** - Disappointing of late and was 8th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 July. Others are preferred
- 10. KALLAS D'OURVILLE** - Yet to win a race and was 9th last time out in Class E at Laon over 2650m on 23 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. KLASS ACTION** - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 10 July. Hard to trust but is capable of winning
- 12. KAMILA DES MONTS** - Very unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 20 July. Others are much preferred
- 13. KILANSKA** - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Nancy on 14 April. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 14. KEROZIA DE REM** - Very unreliable and was unplaced last time out in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 22 July. Others are preferred
- 15. KARLA DE PAGERIE** - Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 21 July. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 16. KEEP ON RUNNING** - Yet to win a race but did not run badly when fourth last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Nancy over 2600m on 28 June. Might play a minor role

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Summary: KARINA JOSSELYN (6) confirmed the promise/encouragement of her comeback 3rd by finishing 2nd next time out before fluffing her lines (disqualified) at Chartres when last seen. She is, however, more than capable of redeeming herself against opposition of this ilk and is good value to make amends/repay her followers. KIGUELLA D'ALTAR (5) has finished on the podium in his last 3 outings and is likely to play another leading role, while KLASS ACTION (11) needs only to avoid disqualification to stake a claim. KHALEESI HEAVEN (4) appeals most of the remainder.

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C7 - PRIX RAYMOND SAUVAGE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LATINO CASTELETS** - Disqualified in all three starts so far, with the latest being at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 22 July. Best watched for now
- 2. LENZO** - Disqualified last time out at Saint-Omer on 21 July. Did not run badly on debut but others are preferred
- 3. LOEK DE REUX** - Showed some improvement when third last time out in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 July. Not out of it
- 4. LUBERON** - Has been disqualified twice in four starts, including last time out at Reims on 22 June. Best watched for now
- 5. LAMKELZE DE NIEL** - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 22 July. Can earn some money if smart
- 6. LOOPING RENARDIER** - Holding his form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Vire over 2700m on 1 July, Has a winning chance in this line-up
- 7. LEOGNAN** - A bit of a disappointment when 6th last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 2300m on 7 July. Won well on debut and should fight out the finish
- 8. LOUP DE MER** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 7 July. Capable of making the frame when in the mood
- 9. LITTLEBOY D'HOLLOW** - Showed what he is capable of with a Class H win last time out at Abbeville over 2300m on 7 July. Tougher task in this line-up
- 10. LE MAC** - Unreliable and was fourth last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 15 July. Has a place chance if smart
- 11. LOUPIAC** - Not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 2300m on 7 July. Won nicely on debut and can score again
- 12. LEGOLAS PAULOIS** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 2300m on 7 July. Place chance in this line-up

Summary: Debut winner LOUPIAC (11) lost little in defeat when 4th at Montier-en-Der last time and, judged on the evidence of his first-start success at Le Croisé-Laroche, remains an attractive betting proposition. He gets the nod ahead of fellow debut scorer LEOGNAN (7), who subsequently finished behind the selection at Montier-en-Der, and consistent LOOPING RENARDIER (6) who is open to improvement in this (plated) shoe-fitting. LOEK DE REUX (3), LOUP DE MER (8) and LEGOLAS PAULOIS (12) have place prospects.

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C8 - PRIX GILBERT BRASSARD - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LADY GODIVA** - Disqualified on debut at Montier-en-Der on 20 July. Likely to improve but others are preferred
- 2. LAHRANA DU HAUTY** - Disqualified twice in four starts, with the latest at Montier-en-Der on 20 July. Best watched for now
- 3. LIANE** - Has struggled so far and was 8th last time out in Class F at Montier-en-Der over 325m on 20 July. Others are much preferred
- 4. LOVE ME DE DUSSAC** - Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 19 May. Can play a minor role
- 5. LOVE ME SAUTREUIL** - Not disgraced when third last time out in Class G at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 21 July. Can make the frame again
- 6. LATINKA** - Has run well in both starts, with the latest third being in Class F at this track over 2700m on 22 July, Has a winning chance
- 7. LOVELY DES BROUETS** - Has some fair form and was 5th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 17 July. Has a place chance
- 8. LA LUNA STAR** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 16 July. Might play a minor role
- 9. LEGEND SMART** - Won well on debut in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2200m on 16 June. Capable of following up in this line-up
- 10. LUMIERE DU CHENE** - Did not show her best when 12th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 13 July. Better this distance and can bounce back to score
- 11. LISCIA** - Bounced back from two disqualifications to win in Class G at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 21 July. Can contest the finish
- 12. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Disappointing last run when 8th in a Class C Mounted race at Enghien over 2225m on 17 July. Others are preferred

Summary: LEGEND SMART (9) revealed obvious ability/potential when scoring on debut at Pontchâteau on 16 June and she ought to have benefitted from that experience, so could remain undefeated with improvement on the cards. LUMIERE DU CHENE (10), judged on her victory two starts back, last-start winner LISCIA (11) are best equipped to threaten the selection's 100% record. LATINKA (6), LOVE ME SAUTREUIL (5) and LA LUNA STAR (8) don't lack the means to make their presence felt either.
