Summary: DARI RIVER (1) had legitimate excuses for finishing unplaced last time but she is certainly worth another chance, especially on the evidence of her earlier form. She is taken to redeem herself at the expense of FORCEFULL (12), who sports first-time headgear, and ALI (5), who should've improved after a much-needed comeback outing. Consistent MARHARRY (4) and experienced maiden AURORA'S BEAUTY (8) are also potential place-getters.
