- **1. MUST MAJYC -** Finished sixth on debut in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 12 January. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 2. MIKTYSON DE VIETTE Disqualified last time out at Chateaubriant on 19 January. Has not shown much so far and others are preferred
- **3. MER AGITEE -** A good third on debut in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 12 January. Not out of it
- **4. MAJYC FLIGHT -** Disappointing last run when tenth in Class F at Laval over 2050m on 16 November. Did better on debut and can upset

- **3. JONQUILLE D'AIMTE -** Unreliable but was third in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 19 December. Has a winning chance
- **4. JACK DU TRUFIER -** Returned to form with a barefoot win in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 14 January. Remains barefoot and may well follow up
