**C1 - PRIX D'ECOUCHE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR €
35,000**

1. LILOU - Fifth in a class E at this track over 2850m on 10 January. Remains barefoot. Was not far off them in the latest

2. LIBERTA MESLOISE - A winner in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. This will be the third run back and is not out of it

3. LILY BECO - Third in a class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 20 January. Performs well when tackled and deserves to be respected

4. LOKIE KADESH - Improved effort when fourth in a class E at this track over 2700m on 29 December. Some improvement in the latest and can confirm that

5. LOLITA - A winner of the last two, the latest in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. If wise should make a bold bid for victory

6. LOTTA ROSIE - A runner up in a class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 January. Remains barefoot. Mathieu Mottier will give every assistance from the sulky and will have supporters

7. LASKA DU LIVIER - Finished 7th in a class E at this track over 2850m on 10 January. Others are preferred in this line up

8. LOVELY JENILOU - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2200m on 1 January. Remains barefoot and if wise can be involved in the finish

9. LERMINE D'OLIVERIE - A winner in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. Remains barefoot. Has confidence and can play a minor role

10. LIBELLULE - Disqualified in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 12 January. Probably needed the latest and might still need it

11. LILYROSE WIND - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2850m on 25 December. If wise can bounce back to be competitive

12. LAMAGISTERE - Disqualified in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. A long break and probably will need the run

Summary: LOLITA (5) is a talented individual in both codes. She either wins races or is disqualified. She has a great cruising speed and can score if applied. LILY BECO (3) boasts a very good record when racing plated and is expected to go close. LILYROSE WIND (11) was unlucky last time out and can make amends. LOKIE KADESH (4) is well entered and can leave behind her last efforts.

C2 - PRIX DE LANNEMEZAN - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 59,000

- 1. IRON MAN D'AVRIL** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 12 December. When wise is competitive but is hard to trust
- 2. HIRO DE L'ORMERIE** - Fifth in a class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 19 January. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- 3. HANDSOME BOY** - A runner up in a class E at this track over 2850m on 22 December. Remains barefoot. Holding form and has sufficient means to fight for victory
- 4. CAIO TITUS BOND** - Fifth in a Harness class E at this track over 2850m on 14 January. Remains barefoot. Mathieu Mottier will give every assistance from the saddle
- 5. ICARE DU LEARD** - Finished 6th in a class D at this track over 2850m on 1 January. Remains barefoot. Place prospects in this line up
- 6. IGO CLEA** - Fifth in a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on 22 December. Lightened in the shoeing arrangement and has best form in this configuration
- 7. ISLAMORADA** - A winner in a class E at this track over 2850m on 22 December. Remains barefoot and is track suited. Very capable of following up
- 8. INITIALE CASTELETS** - Finished 10th in a Harness class D at this track over 2850m on 5 January. Remains barefoot. Others are preferred in this line up
- 9. STARO MOJITO** - Finished 7th in a class D at this track over 2175m on 11 January. Unreliable but does pop up in a place every now and then
- 10. IMPERIAL COGLAIS** - A winner in a class E at this track over 2175m on 2 December. In good form and should be competitive again

Summary: ISLAMORADA (7) won quite cosily her last start at this track and seems to have plenty more to offer. IMPERIAL COGLAIS (10) is very good over the shorter distances and comes in on the back of a nice success so should go close too. CAIO TITUS BOND (4) has failed to shine in two previous attempts in this code but should not be underestimated with the talented Mathieu Mottier in the saddle. A runner-up to the selection in his last run, HANDSOME BOY (3) can be in the mix once again.

C3 - PRIX D'AVIGNON - 2850m (a2m) - Gr3 Race - Harness - EUR € 80,000

1. **LORD DU GERS** - A runner-up in a class A at this track over 2700m on 26 January. Remains barefoot. Not far behind LORD DELO (7) in the latest and deserves to be respected
2. **LAST MAN** - A winner in a class B at this track over 2100m on 19 January. Remains barefoot. A runner up behind LORD DU GERS (1) on 29 December and can reverse the form
3. **LEWIS RIVER** - A runner-up in a class A at this track over 2175m on 21 December. Tries barefoot for the first time and is seldom far off them. Might suit
4. **LARA DU GOUTIER** - A runner up in a class A at this track over 2175m on 22 December. Reverts to barefoot and is seldom far off them
5. **LA VIE A DEUX** - Fifth in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 12 January. Has won on this track but is facing stronger
6. **LASH PERRINE** - Fifth in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Remains barefoot. Others are preferred in this line up
7. **LORD DELO** - A winner in a class A at this track over 2700m on 26 January. On the rise and if getting a good start could be hard to beat
8. **LUSH LIFE** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 12 January. Capable of a surprise if wise
9. **LEONARDO ROC** - Disqualified in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 17 November. Must be wise to be involved
10. **LADY DADA** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 12 January. Undefeated when tackled and can play a minor role
11. **LIZZANO D'ALOUETTE** - A winner in a class A at this track over 2700m on 1 January. Has confidence and has place prospects in this line up
12. **LEADER DE JOUDES** - Third in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Reverts to barefoot and is a consistent sort who can make the frame

Summary: LORD DELO (7) is a class act and will be hard to beat if he can keep his stride in check in the first few meters of the race. In case he happens to fault, the smart LORD DU GERS (1) looks the best alternative for success. LAST MAN (2) was an impressive winner at this track on 19 January and could be involved. LEWIS RIVER (3) is from a top-yard and runs barefoot for the first time so maybe best to keep on the shortlist.

C4 - PRIX DECIDEE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. ROCKY OASIS** - A runner up at Mons over 2840m on 13 January. Facing stronger and might struggle
- 2. KALICO JACK** - Disqualified in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on 17 January. Hard to trust but when wise is capable of placing
- 3. KROKEUSE DE DIAM'S** - Disqualified in a class D at this track over 2700m on 7 December. Remains barefoot. Has disqualification issues and is hard to trust
- 4. KRISTALE D'ERABLE** - Third in a class D at this track over 2700m on 22 December. Reverts to barefoot. Not far off them in the last two and can be competitive again
- 5. KARAIELLA BOND** - Disqualified in a Harness class D at this track over 2100m on 14 January. Must be wise to have a chance
- 6. KENIDILLE** - Third in a class C at this track over 2175m on 30 August. If not needing it is not out of it
- 7. KANELLE DE TILLARD** - Disqualified in the last two, the latest in a Harness class D at this track over 2100m on 14 January. Place prospects if wise
- 8. KEY BISCAYNE** - Fifth in a class C at this track over 2700m on 7 January. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths
- 9. KILOU D'YMER** - Finished 7th in a class C at this track over 2700m on 7 January. Poor form and others are preferred
- 10. KEPHYR D'ESTE** - Fourth in a class D at this track over 2700m on 8 December. Remains barefoot and is a consistent sort who deserves to be respected
- 11. KOALA** - A runner up in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 January. Éric Raffin will give every assistance from the saddle and can go close to winning
- 12. KING OF JIEL** - Finished 6th in a class C at this track over 2700m on 7 January. Others are preferred in this line up
- 13. KAKOU CAYENNAIS** - Finished 7th in a Harness class D at this track over 2700m on 23 January. Remains barefoot and debuts under the saddle. Capable of contesting the finish
- 14. KIF DU BIEF** - Finished 10th in a Harness class C at this track over 2700m on 29 December. Debuts under the saddle and this could suit

Summary: KOALA (11) has been well prepared for this race and has the assistance of Eric Raffin which will be a massive help. KIF DU BIEF (14) is very well entered and can make an impact on his debut in this code. KEPHYR D'ESTE (10) has finished just once out of the first four in ten runs under the saddle and should be closely involved yet again. KAKOU CAYENNAIS (13) is from a top yard and is respected on his debut in this discipline.

C5 - PRIX DE MONTELMAR - 2850m (a2m) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. KALINE DE VIVOIN** - Finished 8th in class B at this course over 2700m on 18 January. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. KASSYA** - Disqualified in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 January. Victorious on three occasions last year and is not out of it
- 3. KATE MESLOISE** - Unreliable and was 6th in class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 January. Barefoot and can contest the finish
- 4. KLASS HAUFOR** - Victorious in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 December. In very good form and can complete a hat-trick
- 5. KEY LADY** - In good form and was runner-up in class B at this track over 2700m on 18 January. Can fight out the finish again
- 6. KORONA DELADOU** - Victorious in Class C at this course over 2175m on 7 September when barefoot. Not unshod this time and could need this run returning from a break
- 7. KIVALA RENARDIER** - Not disgraced when 5th in class C at this track over 2700m 6 January. Unreliable and others are preferred this time
- 8. KANAKA DE BUSSET** - Finished tenth in class B at this track over 2700m on 18 January. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now

Summary: KLASS HAUFOR (4) scored quite impressively last time out in front of KEY LADY (5). The former seems to have more to offer and can strike again. Her main opponent is on the rise but needs to find a few lengths to reverse the form. KASSYA (2)'s last run is best to be forgotten and she can be given another chance. KATE MESLOISE (3) ran a better race than her last placing suggests and is worth a look in.

**C6 - PRIX DE LAVAL - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR €
62,000**

- 1. KAVALA DE PADD** - Finished fourth in class B over this course and distance on 18 January. Unreliable but might play a minor role
- 2. KRAFEN** - Finished 6th in class C at this track over 2850m on 18 January. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 3. KILL JOY LADY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class B at this course over 2850m on 10 January. Won in October and is capable of earning some money
- 4. KARMA POWER** - Victorious in Class B over this track and trip on 16 January. On an impressive winning streak and can score again
- 5. KYOTO DIGEO** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in class B at this track over 2850m on 1 January. Unshod and could go one better
- 6. KEEP YOUR DREAMS** - In good form and finished third in class B at this course over 2850m on 10 January. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. KAPTAIN DU LIAMONE** - Victorious in Class B at this course over 2850m on 1 January. In very good form and is clearly not out of it
- 8. KEMIA DU CHENE** - Finished fourth in class B at this course over 2850m on 10 January. Has shown improvement and has a place chance if smart
- 9. KARAKA WOOD** - Victorious in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 20 January. Barefoot this time and can make the frame
- 10. KOBAYASHI** - Disqualified in class C over this track and trip on 19 January. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred this time
- 11. KAPORAL DES FORGES** - Finished tenth in class D at this track over 2100m on 14 December. Unreliable and others are preferred
- 12. KALMIA PERRINE** - Victorious in Class B at this track over 2850m on 10 January. Can get involved with the finish again

Summary: KEEP YOUR DREAMS (6) is a long losing run but he is in fine form and races barefoot for the first time. He has every chance in this line-up. KARMA POWER (4) has been in great shape this winter and looks a big threat to the selection. KALMIA PERRINE (12) is always very effective in this division and runs barefoot. She won her last start and can follow up. KARAKA WOOD (9) is back on song with a nice last-start success and is another who can have a big say in the outcome.

C7 - PRIX DE COURTEMER - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. KAMELIA DU CORTA** - 5th in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 7 January. Unreliable since June and others are preferred this time
- 2. KRILLE ELLIS** - 6th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 January. Will come on for the race and reunites with Eric Raffin. Leading chance
- 3. KALIFORNIE** - Disqualified in class F at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 19 January. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 4. KITA MESLOISE** - Disqualified in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 5. KELLY CHARLY ERA** - Runner up in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Has shown improvement but this is tougher and others are preferred
- 6. KOH SAMUI BOND** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 January. On a long losing streak and is best left out against this lot
- 7. KALIE TEJY** - 3rd in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 7 January. Placed in both previous attempts and has a place chance here
- 8. KEYPTOWN** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 January. Has major disqualification issues and can be overlooked
- 9. KALIKA DU LEVANT** - 4th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 January. In decent form and can score better if smart. Place chance
- 10. KALINE DE LA COUR** - 4th in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 7 January. Victorious back in December and can contest the win here
- 11. KELOMA DREAM** - 11th in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 25 January. Victorious back in October and can contest the finish if applied
- 12. KETTINA DU CYGNE** - Runner up in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 28 December. Has shown improvement and can contest the finish

Summary: KRILLE ELLIS (2) is expected to come on for her last run and has the services of Eric Raffin so can be given a tentative vote in an open race. KALINE DE LA COUR (10) ran a solid race when 4th over this course & distance earlier this month and has claims on the back of this effort. KALIE TEJY (7) has been in fine fettle of late and warrants some consideration. KALIKA DU LEVANT (9) is possibly better over longer but she is usually effective in this division.

**C8 - PRIX DE BRIEY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR €
35,000**

- 1. LOUSTIC DES MACE** - Disqualified in class G at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 January. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched fro now
- 2. LILIUS DE GUEZ** - Showed improvement when fourth in class E over this course and distance on 15 January. Unreliable but could play a minor role
- 3. LAIOS DU GOUTIER** - Unreliable and was 8th in class E over this course and distance on 15 January. Yet to score and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. LASCAUX DEL PHEDO** - Disappointing last run when 9th in class E over this course and distance on 15 January. Victorious back in December and is not out of it
- 5. LEONARDO DE LOU** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in class E at this track over 2175m on 21 December. Capable of fighting out the finish
- 6. LOUSTIC** - Victorious in Class D at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 31 October. Won twice last year and has a winning chance if fit from a break
- 7. LUCAS DE TOURNAI** - In good form and was third in class D at Enghien over 2875m on 19 October. Has shown improvement but has yet to win. Might place
- 8. L'AS TEJY** - Victorious in Class E at this course over 2200m on 3 January. Not barefoot this time but can contest the finish

Summary: A half-brother to Champion Etonnant, LOUSTIC (6) is back from a break but is unshod on all four feet and has run well fresh before. He could be a tough nut to crack. LEONARDO DE LOU (5) faulted in his only previous run under the saddle but his harness form is solid and he should redeem himself soon or later. LASCAUX DEL PHEDO (4) is lighter in his shoeing arrangement this time and can bounce back to form. L'AS TEJY (8) is well entered and can be given a good look in although he is not barefoot this time.

- 1. DIABEL** - Victorious in Class E at this track over 2700m on 16 January. In good form and can complete a treble of wins
- 2. DADA DEL RONCO** - Needed the last run when 7th in class C at this course over 2700m on 1 January. Victorious back in August and is not out of it
- 3. JOSEPHA CHOUP** - Finished fourth in class D at this course over 2700m on 11 January. Capable of making the frame
- 4. JORIA MESLOISE** - Disqualified in class C over this track and trip on 18 January. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 5. JUNE D'ERABLE** - Disqualified in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 18 January. Won well in August and has a place chance if smart
- 6. DAYTONA DI CECCO** - Finished 12th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 January. Unreliable and is best watched for now
- 7. LOOK OF LOVE** - In good form and was runner-up in class C at Mons over 2300m on 30 December. Barefoot this time and has a place chance
- 8. JOLYDOLE** - Disqualified in class D at Nantes over 3000m on 17 January. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 9. PICTURE PERFECT** - Victorious in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. On an impressive winning streak and can score again
- 10. JOY JENILOU** - Finished 9th in class C at this course over 2700m on 21 December. On a long losing streak and needs major improvement to win
- 11. JADE DE CASTELLE** - Not disgraced when 7th in class C at this course over 2700m on 15 December. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 12. JOMA OV** - Finished 5th in class C over this course and distance on 18 January. Could earn some minor money
- 13. MARY ANN LANE** - Disqualified in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Yet to win since November 2023 and others are preferred
- 14. JOLYSTAR GEDE** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Might play a minor role
- 15. JOIA DU CITRUS** - Unreliable and was 7th in class C at this course over 2700m on 21 December. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 16. JAMAICA** - Finished 9th in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 22 January. Capable of better and could play a minor role

Summary: A sound winner at this course on 16 January, DIABEL (1) could have more to offer and it is interesting to see Eric Raffin keeping the partnership. She gets a tentative vote to follow up with another success. Stablemate to the selection, DADA DEL RONCO (2) posted a very encouraging comeback run on 1st January and should come on for the race. PICTURE PERFECT (9) is going through a purple patch and has every chance once again. LOOK OF LOVE (7) should be close to her peak form after two comeback runs. JUNE D'ERABLE (5) would have gone close last time had she kept her stride in check.
