**1. LUNA PARK -** Disqualified at this course on 20 December. In good form before that and has a winning chance

**2. LOUISIANE KAT -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this course on 20 December. Capable of earning some money when smart

**3. L'ETOILE D'URSIN -** A bit unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class D at this course over 2175m on 14 December. Can follow up

**4. LIBERTY JOSSELYN -** Has won three of her seven starts, including last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 24 December. Big chance

**5.** LILY MARGOT - Consistent and was runner-up last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 7 October. Can contest the finish

**6. LUDIVINE -** Holding form and was fourth in Class B over this track and tip 2 December. Be right there at the finish

**7. LA VISTA HAUFOR -** Unbeaten in two starts with this shoe combination, the latest in Class D at this track over 2200m on 4 December. Can complete the hat-trick

**8. LA VIVA DE LOU -** Has disqualification issues but was third last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 20 December. Has a place chance

**9. LOUVE DE DAIDOU -** Disappointing form at this track and was 7th in Class B over this track and trip on 2 December. Might play a minor role

**10. L'ETOILE -** Unreliable and was tenth in Class B over this course and distance on 2 December. Others are preferred

**Summary:** LIBERTY JOSSELYN (4) has won three of her seven starts and should make a bold bid at scoring this lucky last race. L'ETOILE D'URSIN (3) was a good winner at this track last time out and should contest the finish again. LA VISTA HAUFOR (7) is unbeaten in two starts with this shoe combination but tackles tougher this time. LUDIVINE (6) is consistent and should not be too far away at the finish.
