- 2. KALVITA LEBEL Returns to racing right-handed after running 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2725m Graignes Class F late-September. Disappointing here late-August and would be preferred barefoot
- 3. KARIDY DU DOME Won last 2 races she has finished, but most recently lost her action in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle 10 days ago. Has ample ability, starts in front, and can make a big splash
- **4. KERAMIDA -** Reassuring 3rd of 10 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E 2.5 weeks ago, but has no love for Cabourg and can be passed over

- **3. LITTLE QUEEN JISCE** Debuts in the code [for 3rd trainer] after finishing last of 10 in a 2650m Pornichet Class G on 19 July, and can be confidently passed over
- **4. LAVANDE DE SIENNE -** 5th of 6 finishers in a 2800m Vire harness Class G a month ago. Has made no waves in the monté code and is not about to start
- **5. LAURIANA BELLA -** Would have finished closer than 5th of 8, behind LAREINE D'OURVILLE (8), in a 2450m Caen Class E 3.5 weeks ago had she not faulted, but Adrien Lamy will be keen to put things right. Place prospect
- **6. LOGE D'ERABLE -** Takes first competitive monté steps after finishing 7th of 9 in a 2500m Class F at La Chartre-sur-le-Loir 2 months ago, and will need the run
- 7. LADY DU PERCHE Finished 4th of 7, ahead of LOVE ME PASS (16), here late-August before finishing 6th of 8, behind LAREINE D'OURVILLE (8), in a 2450m Caen Class E 3.5 weeks ago. 4 pads fitted this time but others still preferred
- **8. LAREINE D'OURVILLE -** Left a good impression on monté debut when 4th of 8 in a 2450m Caen Class E 3.5 weeks ago, and will not be available at 48/1 this time around. First 5
- **9. LECCE MARIS -** Sanctioned, when well-supported, in a 2575m Agen Class F 10 days ago. Has merit though and should not be overlooked on first appearance under the saddle
- **10. LIBERTA DEL PHEDO -** Reassuring 5th of 11 in a 2850m Laval Class F 3 weeks ago. Will not be available at 128/1 this time, but is unlikely to be as productive either
- 11. LOVE STORY GARDEN Honest filly switching codes after running 6th of 9 in a 2400m Amiens Class F on 21 September, but still appears to be out of her depth
- **12. LOLA D'AMOUR** Has 2 races under her belt since the break, latterly last of 9 in a 2600m Savenay harness Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has shown solid harness ability and François Lagadeuc looks to be onboard a live chance
- 13. LUBIE DE LARA 6th of 10 in a 2725m Lisieux harness Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Sports 4 pads for ridden debut and is unlikely to let the side down
- **14. LILI GUILLERVILLE -** Last but one in a 2150m Enghien Class E, when preparing for this, 2.5 weeks ago. Has yet to disappoint here and has a realistic chance of losing her maiden status
- **15. LIBERTY D'OURVILLE -** Unremarkable filly that faulted in a 2900m Challans harness Class E last Sunday, and returns to the discipline with limited ambition
- **16. LOVE ME PASS** Returns to the ridden code after finishing 6th of 7 in a 2275m Nantes harness Class E last week. Benefits from a fine engagement and must be considered a respectable podium prospect

Summary: Solid in her first two appearances under the saddle, both of them at Cabourg, LILI GUILLERVILLE (14) returns to the discipline, with Paul Ploquin back in the saddle, and can open her account. He will still want to be wary of monté debutante LOLA D'AMOUR (12), who switches code after having shown potential under harness, and the tricky LAURIANA BELLA (5) who is significantly better than her recent Caen result would suggest. LOVE ME PASS (16) has demonstrated decent aptitude for both disciplines and Marius Durville will be eager to take advantage of the good entry.
