- **1. IROS DU GOUTIER -** Improved effort when third in a class F at this track over 2700m on 31 July. This time will be unshod from his hindguarters and can have a say
- **2. JADE DALAMEDA -** Well beaten 9th in a class E at this track over 2150m on 13 August. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive. Remains barefoot
- **3. ISPAHAN DE CAREL -** Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2925m on 15 August. Must be wise and if wise the stable is in good form

- **3. BAROLO ROC -** He ran well when fourth at Turin over 1600m on 27 July. Making an ambitious trip but has proven himself on our soil. Remains barefoot
