- **1. DELIRE -** Returned from a 4-month absence to finish an encouraging 4th in a 1300m Saint-Cloud maiden on 27 September. Would've tightened up since and should have more to offer
- 2. SPRING HEART Unplaced (9th) in a course-and-distance handicap on 17 September but finished on the podium in consecutive 1400m maidens before that, so shouldn't be hastily condemned
- **3. VEGA -** Absent since finishing 4th in an 1800m maiden at Le Croise-Laroche on 20 April. Not taken lightly on her reappearance with the scope for further improvement
- **4. SHA TIN** Runner-up in a 1600m maiden at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September in her second start on French soil. Could have more to offer over this shorter distance
- **5. CHIVERE -** Consistent filly overdue a maiden win, having finished 3rd in 3 starts and 2nd on 4 other occasions including consecutive recent outings the latest over 1300m at Saint-Cloud on 27 September
- **6. AMABATI -** Sommerabend debutante trained by Jean-Marie Beguigne and to be ridden by Malone Favriaux whose 2,5kg allowance will come in handy

Summary: CHIVERE (5) has been hard to win with and become costly to follow but she only narrowly missed out last time on victory last time, so she is given another chance to belatedly open her account. She will, however, have to be wary of DELIRE (1), who acquitted himself well on his reappearance and should improve to play a leading role. SHA TIN (4) and experienced SPRING HEART (2) have also revealed sufficient means to fight for a spot on the podium.

- **2. GANT -** Runner-up on debut last year over 1200m but unplaced in 3 starts this term, the latest (5th) over 2000m at Varsovie in Poland on 17 August. Debuting on French soil for Henri-Alex Pantall
- **3. JUNEBERRY -** Placed (3rd) in a 1900m Listed race on her French/stable debut at La Teste in August and didn't go unnoticed when 4th in a 1600m turf maiden at Chantilly on 26 September. Keep safe
- **4. ARGENCES -** Well-beaten 6th of 14 on debut in a strung-out field on this course over 1600m on 17 September. Ought to have gained from that experience
- **5. TOPY'SIM -** Failed to build on the promise of her debut 4th at Dieppe when only 5th although not disgraced in a 1600m turf maiden at Chantilly on 26 September. Can do better
- **6. QUEEN OF NIGHT -** Returned from a year's absence when 12th in a 2000m Saint-Cloud maiden on 20 September. Would've tightened up with the benefit of that comeback run and remains open to improvement
- **7. SKY THE STARS -** Placed twice in 4 appearances in Poland but finished unplaced (6th) in both starts on French soil, the latest in a 2000m Saint-Cloud maiden on 9 September
- **8. LADYHILL -** Didnt go unnoticed when 6th on debut at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m last month but she made no impression when 10th of 11 in a 1600m maiden at Chantilly on 26 September. Needs to improve
- **9. REKHALE -** Cloth Of Stars gelding from the stable of Alessandro & Giuseppe Botti. Giovanni Sias takes a handy 3,5kg off
- **10. ENNAMORATA** Machucambo debutante trained by Jean-Marie Beguigne and to be ridden by Marie Velon, who takes 1,5kg off the back

Summary: Absent since his eye-catching debut in a very strong field in October last year, GAMESTARS (1) is of particular interest on his much-anticipated reappearance. Listed-placed maiden JUNEBERRY (3) has the form and experience to challenge the selection, as does TOPY'SIM (5) who didn't finish a long way adrift of that rival last time. GANT (2) appeals most of the remainder in his first outing on French soil.

- 2. KING ZARAK Experienced colt with references/victories in the handicap and claiming categories. Needs to reaffirm after back-to-back unplaced efforts, the latest (8th) over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on 13 September
- **3. TIC TAC -** Debut winner of a 2400m Saint-Cloud claimer on 6 September. Up in class but is open to any amount of improvement
- **4. DEMPY -** Capable performer who usually acquits himself well and seldom finishes far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 2900m at Clairefontaine on 5 July not taken lightly on his reappearance
- **5. YOOX -** This well-bred colt (grandson of champion Solémia) is the top-rated runner in the lineup. Boasts solid form references, including a 1800m Listed 4th and last-start 3rd at Vichy over 1850m on 23 September
- **6. SIR SILJAN -** Game-in-defeat 2nd on debut over 2400m at Vichy on 24 September and is open to improvement with that experience to count on
- **7. LA GUERCHE -** Debut winner at Sablé-sur-Sarthe in April and maintains good form and consistency. Acquitted herself well (6th) on handicap debut in a 2000m Quinte+ event at ParisLongchamp on 12 September respect

Summary: Well-bred YOOX (5) ventures into the unknown over this marathon distance for the first time but does so with legitimate ambitions. He gets the nod ahead of SIR SILJAN (6), after an encouraging debut on French soil, and improving last-start winner CATCH FIRE (1) who steps up in class but is open to further progress. LA GUERCHE (7) ran well enough in a recent Quinté+ to suggest that she is competitive for a podium berth in a race of this nature.

- **2. THE DUBLINER -** Soundly beaten in both appearances last year, once on either surface the latest (8th) in an 1800m PSF maiden at Chantilly on 9 December. Others preferred
- **3. WINTERVOGEL** The subject of betting support on debut and acquitted himself well in finishing 4th on this course over 2400m on 25 September. Would've gained from that experience
- **4. SIR GARSING -** Improved in 2 starts after a debut 7th, finishing 3rd at Marseille-Morely in June and 4th over 2400m at Lyon-Parilly on 17 September. Attractive outsider
- **5. HANSOTTOGRUBER** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on debut over 2050m at Magdeburg on 13 July and is open to any amount of improvement on his reappearance. Dark horse
- **6. BAAL HOWARD -** Unreliable though has sparked improvement to finish 2nd in consecutive recent starts, the latest over 3000m at Saint-Cloud on 13 September. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **7. ESTONIA MOON -** Revealed early promise (finished 5th in 3 consecutive outings) but lost his way/form after a 6-month layoff. Unplaced in 4 subsequent starts, the latest (8th) over 2200m at Fontainebleau on 22 September
- **8. PUBLIC ENEMY -** He showed himself courageous in Saint-Cloud and this time will be associated with Mickaël Barzalona.
- **9. JANNAH PEARL -** Confirmed the promise of her debut 2nd over 2100m by finishing a game-in-defeat 3rd over 2000m at Chantilly on 11 May. Open to improvement on her reappearance over this extended trip
- **10. L'AMIE LARISSA -** Caught the eye on debut when staying on to finish 3rd over 2400m at Lyon-Parilly on 17 September. Will be wiser to the task
- **11. ANODYMUS -** Anodin gelding trained and owned by Jean-Christophe Bertin who has engaged Pierre Bazire to ride this newcomer. Best watched for now
- **12. BRADSHAW -** David Menuisier-trained Dubawi gelding out of champion stayer Molly Malone. Regally bred 3-year-old to be ridden by Christophe Soumillon can make a winning start to his career

Summary: Well-bred Dubawi gelding, out of Group I Prix du Cadran winner Molly Malone, BRADSHAW (12) will be all the rage on his racecourse debut and, on pedigree alone, is worth chancing to get off to a winning start. JANNAH PEARL (9) has the form and experience to expose any chinks in that rival's armor. WINTERVOGEL (3) and L'AMIE LARISSA (10) made encouraging introductions and would've come on with that experience, so they shouldn't be underestimated either.

- 2. PARTIR Consistent filly with sound references on rain-affected ground. Showed her form and well-being with a good 4th on a 1900m Listed race at La Teste on 30 August
- **3. MAIA STAR -** Won 2 of 3 starts earlier this year but finished a well-beaten 7th over 2100m at Saint-Cloud last month (13 September) on her return from a 5-month absence. For another day
- **4. GALAXIE VEGA -** Belatedly opened her account with a wide-margin 1600m success on this course on 17 September. Unknown quantity over this distance
- **5. WINTER SNOWFALL -** Capitalised on a significant drop in class when bouncing back to winning ways over 2400m at Craon on 23 September. Has more to do back in this grade/company
- **6. SHIFFRIN -** Experienced at this level with references in Group races, including a Group III victory as a 2-year-old. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th in a 2100m Listed race ParisLongchamp on 1 September
- **7. ZORA -** Ultra-consistent performer with sound references and form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a 2100m Listed race at Strasbourg on 15 September. Attractive outsider
- **8. HAPPY SAXON -** Won on her seasonal reappearance at Chantilly in May and finished 2nd in a 2000m ParisLongchamp Listed race in June. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a 2100m Listed race at that venue on 1 September
- **9. WITH STARS** Consistent performer with sound references in conditions races but showed limitations at this level when unplaced (8th) in a 2100m Listed race ParisLongchamp on 1 September. Headgear removed

Summary: Group III Prix de Psyché runner-up ULURU (11) sets the standard and is the horse to beat. However, SELEMIAH (1) is on a steep upward trajectory and could pose a threat with further improvement expected of her. JULICA (12), disappointing at La Teste during the summer, retains sufficient means to make her presence felt in a race of this nature, so shouldn't be discounted. GALAXY VEGA (4) completes the shortlist although several others are capable of getting into the picture.

- **2. REVENTADOR -** Proven at this level and dangerous back over the distance of his latest success at ParisLongchamp in this category on 13 June. Held his own (5th) in a 2500m ParisLongchamp handicap on 12 September
- **3. BLACK WALL -** Last-start winner of an 1800m handicap at Salon-de-Provence on 9 September. Carries a 3,5kg penalty returning to the claiming category
- **4. RIYAK -** Won an 1800m handicap, beating SIM CARD (1), at Clairefontaine in August and has run well in defeat at this level in both subsequent starts the latest (3rd) over 1800m at Chantilly on 3 October. Respect

REVENTADOR (2), who caught the eye at ParisLongchamp last time out, isn't incapable of making his felt either.

- **3. NOUR AYA -** Took advantage of a drop in the weights/ratings to finish 2nd in a minor 1500m Class 4 conditions race at Vannes on 21 September with this headgear refitted. Must build on that improvement to have a say
- **4. SINSINSIN -** Consistent performer in his native Belgium but has struggled in France. Returns for another crack on French soil after a reassuring 2nd in a 1500m PSF handicap at Mons on 10 September unlikely

- **3. CHALDERO -** Unplaced in all 8 appearances, the latest (10th) in a 1900m PSF handicap at Deauville on 22 August. The return to turf and booking of Mickaël Barzalona catches the eye
- **4. HURRICANE LIGHT -** Lost his way/form recently racing without blinkers (4 starts) after winning a track-and-trip handicap in May unplaced (7th) in a 2000m Vichy handicap on 23 September. Headgear refitted and back on his last-winning mark
- **5. FASTER -** In good form and physical condition, having finished 3rd in 3 consecutive recent appearances twice in handicaps over this course and distance, the latest on 25 September. Candidate for success
- **6. GOLDEN BEACH -** Inconsistent but undeniably capable hard-knocking handicapper. Blotted his copybook when 11th in a course-and-distance handicap on 25 September but shouldn't be hastily condemned dark horse
- **7. TOPINAMBUR -** Unreliable but capable handicapper who seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Finished 3rd in a 1600m Layon-Parilly handicap on 17 September but headgear worn that day is dispensed with

- **3. SADALBARI -** A 13-start maiden with sound references and sufficient means to make his presence felt, after a good 4th in a 1500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 25 August. Alexis Pouchin retains confidence in him
- **4. NOBLE AMBER -** Honest hard-knocker and last-start winner of a course-and-distance handicap on 25 September. Remains competitive for victory under a 3kg penalty
- **5. THE TIME** Has made no impression in back-to-back handicap appearances recently, the latest (11th) over course and distance on 25 September. Others preferred

Game frontrunner HEATHERWOOD (9), course-and-distance winner UN PLUS UNE (7), and SADALBARI (3), even as a maiden, have shown enough to be competitive for a spot on the podium.
