- **1. HELICIO BELLO -** Makes just 2nd appearance in this division after coming 5th of 10 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Takes on some battle-hardened elements here but nevertheless seems good enough to make first 5
- **2. ICARE DE LA DORETE -** 4th in a Vittel amateurs event before coming 3rd of 12 in a 3150m Abbeville Class E last weekend. Seldom delivers in the day's configuration and not a priority
- **3. IBRAHIM DU RIB -** Makes first amateur appearance after trotting 5th of 9 in an 1800m Class D at La Capelle early-July. Makes 50th start with a realistic chance of getting that maiden monkey off his back
- **4. HOLD UP MESLOIS -** Fast-finishing 3rd of 9 in an amateurs Class G over course and distance late last month. Is ideally-placed in front and looks the pick of the field
