- **1. HIP HOP DE MADKER -** Disappointing since imposing at Francheville mid-July, latterly 6th of 14 in a 2650m Alençon Class D last Sunday, and can be confidently ruled out
- **2. HIROSS -** Pleasant 5th of 12 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E on 12 September. Handed a decent draw but, in this lot, will have too much to do
- **3. HAMLET DU VIVIER -** Finished a trounced 10th of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E late last month. Has a good spot behind the car but others still preferred
- **4. HAUDATIS -** 3rd of 13 in a 3025m Montier-en-Der Class F earlier this month. Has not put a foot out of line lately and even though stepping up in category, is well-drawn and worth keeping an eye on

- **8. HIDALGO DE VARENNE -** Beat HERMES DE CLOPEAU (12) to impose at Ploublay 3 weeks ago before finishing 4th of 9 in a 3100m Nort-sur-Erdre Class F a week later. Breaks wide on front row but will still generate some interest
- **9. HAIKIDO -** Won a 2700m Class F at La Capelle a fortnight ago. Fitted with pads this time though and more a minor place prospect on this occasion
- **10. HOLLYWOOD TORINO -** Last of 15 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago. Form may not be in question but his presence here is. Disregard

Stablemate LOVELY GODIVA (6) benefits from an Eric Raffin drive for the first time and will be no easy touch. Plainly close to her race, LADY DAY (3) has been handed the plum spot behind the car and will not go down easily.

- **1. MANHATTAN ROUSSAC -** 7th of 8 in a 2200m Vincennes Class C 11 days ago. Will appreciate this more even surface but still looks to have too much to do
- **2. MY NAME IS BOND -** Runner-up in both starts to date, most recently a 2200m Vichy Class E last weekend. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike for first time and will be quick to take advantage of the draw. Chance
- **3. MAESTRO DE JOUDES -** Disappointing since winning first time out, mid-July, most recently last of 8, behind MANHATTAN ROUSSAC (1), in a 2175m Vincennes Class C late last month. Eric Raffin reining but more performant options available
- **4. MYSTIC SONATO -** Solid on debut, then ran respectable 5th of 8 in a 2200m Vincennes Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys an excellent draw and will not be far off the mark if Franck Nivard assures his initial strides
- **5. MUSCLE DREAM -** Impressive 2nd on debut before coming 4th of 8 in a 2225m Ecommoy Class C 3 weeks ago. Has buckets of untapped potential and looks better than most here. Claim
- **6. MEMPHIS DE BRASSE -** Has done everything right so far, latterly 2nd of 12 in a 2000m Rambouillet Class E 3 weeks ago. Hails from a yard going good-guns and will again be expected to contest the finish
- **7. MINOS DES CHARRONS** Lost his action first time out before making amends and winning a 2200m Vichy Class F, with consummate ease, 3 weeks ago. Faulted on lone left-handed start but can pick up a cheque if he turns
- **8. MANHATTAN JIEL -** Fastest qualifier in the field that came a good 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2000m Class E at La Capelle on 8 September. Takes a notable step up in category though and may be taking on too much
- **9. MADNESS SIBEY -** Pleasing 3rd of 8 in a 2200m Caen Class F, on debut, 3 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and, despite starting on 2nd line, still looks a player
- **10. MISTER CHARLY -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2250m Class C here on 10 August and, in this category, can expect to find himself swimming against the tide

Summary: Eye-catching first time out, MUSCLE DREAM (5) was not quite as striking at Ecommoy earlier in the month, but the move to a left-handed flat track, with a good spot behind the car, may just be the key to opening his account. Etienne Dubois will nevertheless be keeping an eye on MY NAME IS BOND (2) who is plainly close to losing his maiden status, and MEMPHIS DE BRASSE (6) who moves to a hard surface with legitimate ambition. MADNESS SIBEY (9) is an interesting character that should appreciate these conditions.
