He liked the Polytrack and can follow up but tackles elders. LT ALEXANDER has shown improvement of late and deserves respect. WILLIAM THE FIRST showed improvement last time out and could do even better this time. COASTAL PATH has not been showing his best of late but can contest the finish. PASHTUNWALI picked up a 5 point penalty for his last win but can follow up if in the same mood. WIND SOCK likes this track and is not out of it. GREAT TIMES is also capable of getting into the mix of things.

Stable companion PARIS LASS loves this course and distance but is giving weight away to her rivals. SLIM JANNIE and TUSCAN GOLD are proven Polytrack performers who are contenders for Smith. EVIES FIRST has the ability and would not be a surprise winner of this race. COOL WINTER is one of a couple of Alan Greeff-trained runners and has stable jockey Richard Fourie riding, so could be the best of his runners.

It is a very open race and we will need to go very wide in the exotics. ALLENDE is unreliable but can contest the finish. ELLA'S DELIGHT is speedy and could be dangerous. DEMIGOD is well-drawn and capable of a strong finish. BYTHELITEOFTHEMOON likes the Polytrack and can contest the finish. ANGELSEA and COLORAMA are both in good form and capable of running well again.
