- **1. HAVANA QUICK -** Very unreliable and was tenth last time out in Class G over this course and distance on 2 August. Others are much preferred
- **2. HYPTIS -** At the top of his game with two wins in the last three starts, including last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 24 July. Be right there at the finish
- **3. GHALAL DE VANDEL -** Showed some improvement when 5th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 21 July. Could play a minor role
- **4. GLADIATOR DE NIMES -** Unreliable this year but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 22 July. Has a place chance
- **5. HAMILTON SEVEN -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 22 July. Ran well in his penultimate start and has a winning chance
- **6. HADAYA VISAIS -** Has struggled all year and was 7th last time out in Class G over this track and trip on 2 August. Needs major improvement to win

- **10. GALLIANO DU DESERT -** Disappointing form this year and was 9th last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 22 July. Others are preferred
- **11. GAMIN DU SABLIER -** Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 15 July. Capable of following up if in the same mood

- **6. JOKER DU MIDI -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Aix-les-Bains on 29 July. Needs major improvement to win
- **7. JOY MARGOT -** Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 17 July. Has a winning chance

- **4. KENNY PEARL -** Unreliable all year but did run well last time out when runner-up in Class E at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 29 July. Capable of going one better when in the mood
- **5. KATSOUKA -** On a very long losing run and was 8th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 4 August. Did better in her penultimate start and is not out of it
- **6. KLUSAZ -** On a very long losing run and was 12th last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 20 July. Capable of earning some minor money
- **7. KING'S DAY -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 20 July. Better this distance and should contest the finish

- **5. ICAP DU GOUTIER -** Unreliable but did run well when a runner-up in Class E at Carpentras over this course and distance on 14 May. Might play a minor role returning from a break

- **4. IMUVRINI -** Disappointing last run when 5th in Class G over this track and trip on 21 July. Has a winning chance
- **5. JAGUAR DU LOISIR -** Battling to regain winning form but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 27 July. Capable of making the frame

- **4. KRUNCH BOCNEUF -** Disappointing form this year and was 6th last time out in Class F at this course over 2650m on 2 August. Capable of making the frame
- **5. KANDY DU MIDI -** Has had 31 starts without a victory and was disqualified last time out at this course on 2 August. Others are preferred

- **4. HARDI FOSSAVIE -** Not easy to trust and was disqualified last time out at this track on 21 July. Did win twice here earlier this year and is not out of it
- **5. IVANHOE MADRIK -** Disqualified in his last four starts, with the latest being at this track on 2 August. Best watched for now
- **6. IVANHOE RENKA -** Disappointing of late and was 8th last time out in Class G over this course and distance on 21 July. Others are preferred
