- **1. KELLE PONT VAUTIER -** Sanctioned in all 3 last month before finishing 7th of 11 in a 2700m Graignes Class F a fortnight ago, and is unlikely to cause an upset any time soon
- 2. KALIAKIE PHEDO Pleases for the most part when focused, most recently 5th in Maure-de-Bretagne race of reference. Races shod as she was at Segré and can expect to find the going tough
- **3. KALLISTE CODIE -** Sanctioned in a 2600m Class F at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre on 22 September. Has freshness on her side, and sports a revised configuration, but no more than a minor place chance
- **4. KLASSICAL WAY ACE -** In the frame in last 2, most recently 3rd of 9 in a 2400m Nort-sur-Erdre Class F 2 months ago, but in this company will guite simply have too much to do
- 5. KOUMBA DE LA NADE Out of the picture in last 2, latterly 12th of 14 in Maure race of reference, and can be confidently passed over
- 6. KARA DE LOIRON Unraced since winning a 2700m Graignes monté Class F on 10 August and has nothing going for her here
- 7. KASSIOPEE NANIE A complete write-off all year, lastly sanctioned in a 2750m monté Class E at La Capelle late-July, and can be disregarded
- 8. KELL MISS DE CAHOT Unexceptional filly that finished last but one in Maure-de-Bretagne race of reference and already looks an also-ran
- 9. KARINA JOSSELYN Considerably better than recent numbers would suggest, latterly 8th behind KOETANE D'AVRIL (12) in a 2850m Maure Class E 12 days ago. Has good references when shod and should have the measure of most
- **10. KALIE TEJY -** Was on a fine run of provincial form before faulting in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E late-September. Takes on better this time, and races with shoes on, but can still bounce back and get in on the action
- 11. KALIE GEMA Hardy element making first start since running 3rd of 9 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E late-July. Shoes on and best to hold off
- 12. KOETANE D'AVRIL Encouraging 4th of 14 in a 2850m Maure Class E 12 days ago. Shoes back on though and, while not a priority, can still make her presence felt
- **13. KITA MESLOISE -** 5th of 10 in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 6 October. Appears to have put her complications behind her and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard will only work to her advantage. First 5
- **14. KOREA -** Makes first appearance since finishing last of 11 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E early-August. Is clearly in competition mode and Mathieu Mottier will be eager to restore his filly's morale. Claim
- **15. KARLESS DANICA -** Steps marginally up in category after winning a 2500m Class F at Bihorel-lès-Rouen on 20 October. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike this time and could well repeat
- **16. KATTEGAT CITY -** 8th of 10 in a 2275m Nantes Class E last Sunday. Benefits from a good entry, has been entrusted to a leading driver, and significant improvement anticipated. Place prospect

Summary: Sent for some R&R after a pair of summer blips, the capable KOREA (14) sports front pads for her return run and, prepared for this, can return to successful ways. KARINA JOSSELYN (9) has not been firing on all cylinders recently but is better than most here and with shoes back on can start to redeem herself. Nicely-engaged at the limit of earnings, KARLESS DANICA (15) recently won at Bihorel-lès-Rouen and races unshod-behind this time, while KATTEGAT CITY (16) has been entrusted to Matthieu Abrivard.

- **1. HARRY ATOUT -** Produced a pair of good efforts at Les Andelys before faulting in a 2700m Segre Class F on 6 October. Gets on well with Hervé Jouault and, if applied, has a decent chance of fighting out the finish
- 2. HECATE DU DOLLAR Came 3rd in a Rambouillet amateur event before running 8th of 11 in a 2750m Class E at Le Pertre last Saturday. Seldom disappoints at this level when focused and will be worth retaining as an interesting outsider
- 3. ISIS DU CORTA Has not been seen out since faulting in a 3100m Chinon Class H mid-August. Has references in the amateur division but still looks out of her depth
- **4. FENOMENON -** 10th of 12 behind HAMILTON DU LUPIN (16) in a 3000m Nantes amateurs Class G 3.5 weeks ago. Out of sorts since the spring and must get his act together
- **5. INES DU MARLOU -** Takes first steps in amateur category after finishing 5th of 14 in a 3275m Saumur Class E on 20 October. On front row but others still preferred
- **6. IPANO STAR -** Useful sort making first appearance since September 2023. Shoes on and will be eased gently back into competition
- 7. FIRE OF CARLESS Has references in the amateur division but out of the picture lately and others easier to back
- **8. HALDO -** 3rd in the professional ranks before finishing 8th of 14 in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class G on 1 October. Not easy to gauge but, if focused, can play a part
- **9. IRWIN STAR -** 4th of 14, on amateur debut, in a 2850m Vincennes Class G on 1 October. Benefits from a front-row break and can play a leading role
- **10. FREGATE HAUFOR -** Twice 4th before finishing 7th of 13 in a 2775m amateurs Class G at Les Sables on 20 September. Incurs the penalty but has won twice in the amateur category here and must not be overlooked
- **11. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE** Failed to deliver when 7th to HAMILTON DU LUPIN (16) in a 3000m Nantes amateurs Class G 3.5 weeks ago. Imposed 3 months ago, at this level, for her driver and even from back line looks a player
- 12. HALAFOLY ROBSEN Capable in this category but has not been seen out since running 14th of 15 in an amateurs Class F here last June, and will need the run
- 13. HAVE A LOVE Returns to the amateur ranks after finishing last of 12 in a 2150m Enghien claimer a fortnight ago. On second line, shod, and chances limited
- **14. IMPERATRICE HEDEN -** Ran 3rd in the professional ranks here before coning 2nd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 4 October. Clearly back at his best and, despite the handicap, still looks a serious proposition
- **15. GRACE DE MAI -** Disappointing for some time, latterly 9th of 11 in a 2850m Class F at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin on 13 October, and has no realistic chance
- **16. HAMILTON DU LUPIN -** Made no bones about winning a 3000m Nantes amateurs Class G on 7 October. Trainer could not have wished for better conditions and, with the experienced Poirier back in the bike, can win this

Summary: Well-engaged and winner here in the professional ranks before confirming in the amateur division at Nantes next time, HAMILTON DU LUPIN (16) will be reined by Michel Poirier again and is in with a realistic shout of pulling off the 3-timer. He will nevertheless feel the heat from IMPERATRICE HEDEN (14) who has done nothing but improve over recent weeks, and the ideally-entered, and reconfigured, IRWIN STAR (9) who put on a fine show at Vincennes a month back. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE (11) disappointed behind the favourite at Nantes last time but she has already won for her driver this term.
