- **1. IDYLLE DU NORD -** Needed her only run of the year and was tenth in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 January. Could be the surprise package of the race
- **2. INFINI DU TRY -** On a long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 17 June. Can contest the finish
- **3. HELIOS DES RACQUES -** Best when fully barefoot and was runner-up last time out in Class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Not fully unshod this time but can contest the finish
- **4. GIORGIO DU VIVIER -** In good form and was a winner at Mons last time out over 2840m on 16 July. Tougher task this time but can play a minor role
- **5. HIMEROS DU DOLLAR -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 July. Capable of better and is not out of it on best form
- **6. GREFFIERS FLINOIS -** Disappointing form of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 16 June. Needs to do bit more to win

HIMEROS DU DOLLAR (5) faulted last time out but is capable of contesting the finish when smart. INFINI DU TRY (2) did not run too badly last time out and this is another to consider.

- **3. LAMKELZE DE NIEL -** Showed improvement when runner-up last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 25 March. Returns from a break but does have a winning chance
- **4. LOYAL DU CHENE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 9 July. Not out of it
- **5. LUDO DU MURRIER -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Laon on 23 June. Best watched for now
- **6. LA STAR -** Showed improvement to win second start, in Class G at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 12 May. Can follow up

- **4. HOLLYWOOD TORINO -** Kept to harness racing this year and was 9th last time out in Class E at this course over 1800m on 9 July. Can earn some money back under the saddle
- **5. HELITE ELEVEN -** Only modest of late and was 6th last time out in a Class G harness race at Enghien over 2875m on 10 July. Can contest the finish

- **4. JESS D'HERTALS -** Unreliable but was runner-up last time at Ostende over 2300m on 8 July. Can contest the finish

Summary: JUSTICE DE JOUDES (7) has finished 2nd twice and 4th three times in her last 5 starts, so wouldn't be winning out of turn. She deserves a reward for that consistency but will need to bring her A-game to thwart the challenges of JESS D'HERTALS (4), with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm, and JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT (5) who finished 2nd last time out and enjoys racing at this venue. JAVA DU MONCEL (6) has proven references at this level, so she shouldn't be underestimated either.

- **3. JAGUAR BOURBON -** Returned to form with a Class E win at Segré over 2700m on 30 June. Tougher task this time but is not out of it
- **4. JOG DE JAVIE -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class E at Segré over 2700m on 15 July, In good form before that and has a place chance
- **5. JACK DU CAUX -** Disappointing form this year and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 6 July. Did better last year and has a winning chance
- **6. JOURNAIO DU ROI -** Has struggled of late and was 11th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 27 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **7. JARDIN D'ERABLE -** Only modest of late and was 7th last time out in Class E at this course over 2700m on 21 March. Needs to do a bit more to win

Summary: A case can be made for most of these five-year-old geldings but it could pay to take a chance on JEKILL ROCQ (1) ahead of JACK DU CAUX (5). The consistent former is ideally positioned at the start while the latter is eased in grade after a last-start disqualification and shouldn't be hastily condemned. JACKPOT JOMUNA (10) blows hot and cold but would be dangerous to discount. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC (8) and JETLAG HOPE (12) have the form and experience to make their presence felt too.

- **4. INDIC -** Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Vire over 2700m on 1 July. Can go one better this time
- **5. HILTON DU HOULET -** Has won his last four starts, with the latest being in Class E at Montieren-Der over 3025m on 7 July. Can stretch winning sequence to 5
- **6. IDEFIX JIHEM -** In fair form and was 5th last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 3 July. Capable of making the frame
- **7. GENIALISSIME -** Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 8 July. Can earn some more money
- **8. IRINA DE MONTCEAU -** Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 10 July. Others are preferred
- **9. HOMMAGE DU TRIO -** On a long losing run but has been a runner-up in his last two starts, with the latest being at this course over 2700m on 9 July. Be right there at the finish once again
- **10. INSIDE MAN -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Arras over 2900m on 30 June. Capable of earning some money

Summary: HILTON DU HOULET (5) has impressed in rattling off four consecutive victories and looks good value to extend his winning sequence. He is, however, likely to be kept honest with HOMMAGE DU TRIO (9), after finishing 2nd in back-to-back outings, and INDIC (4) expected to acquit themselves competitively/play leading roles. JIHEM (6) and GENIALISSIME (7) make most appeal of the remainder.

- **3. FESTIVAL D'ORIENT -** Has lost the way and was tenth in his last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2850m on 13 July. Others are much preferred
- **4. HERCULE DE LEAU -** Showed improvement when runner-up last time out in Class D at Vincennes over this distance on 28 June. Can contest the finish
- **5. HELENCIO -** Unreliable but was third last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 7 July. Not out of it
- **6. GREGOR -** At the top of his game and pulled off a hat trick when scoring in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 6 July. Deserves the utmost respect
- **7. GAROU DU CHENE -** Returning from a lengthy break and was 6th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 October. Likely to need this run
- **8. HURRICANE CARTER -** Has increased the winning sequence to 13, with the latest win in Class D at Enghien over 2850m on 6 July. Can win again
- **9. FRICHTI -** Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 6 July. Others are preferred

Summary: A potential match-race awaits. HURRICANE CARTER (8), undefeated for more than 2 years now, and recent hat-trick scorer GREGOR (6), whose 3 wins have been more impressive than the one before, are likely to fight for victory. HERCULE DE LEAU (4) appeals most of the remainder and should complete the podium positions ahead of HELENCIO (5), with HIPPOCRATE DU TRIO (1) best of the rest.
