- **2. JAVA DU BAS BOSQ -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class F over this course and distance on 9 March. Has won over this track and trip and deserves some respect
- **3. JOLIE AGATHA -** Struggling to find best form and was 6th last time out in a Mounted race claimer at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 February. Others are much preferred
- **4. JOHANNA DE BRETT -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 16 March. Others are preferrred
- **5. JERSEY BLEUE -** On a long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 7 March. Likes this track and trip and can contest the finish

- **4. JIOSCO DES CHASSES -** Has disqualification issues but did show improvement when 5th last time out in Class E over this track and trip26 February. Could make the frame
